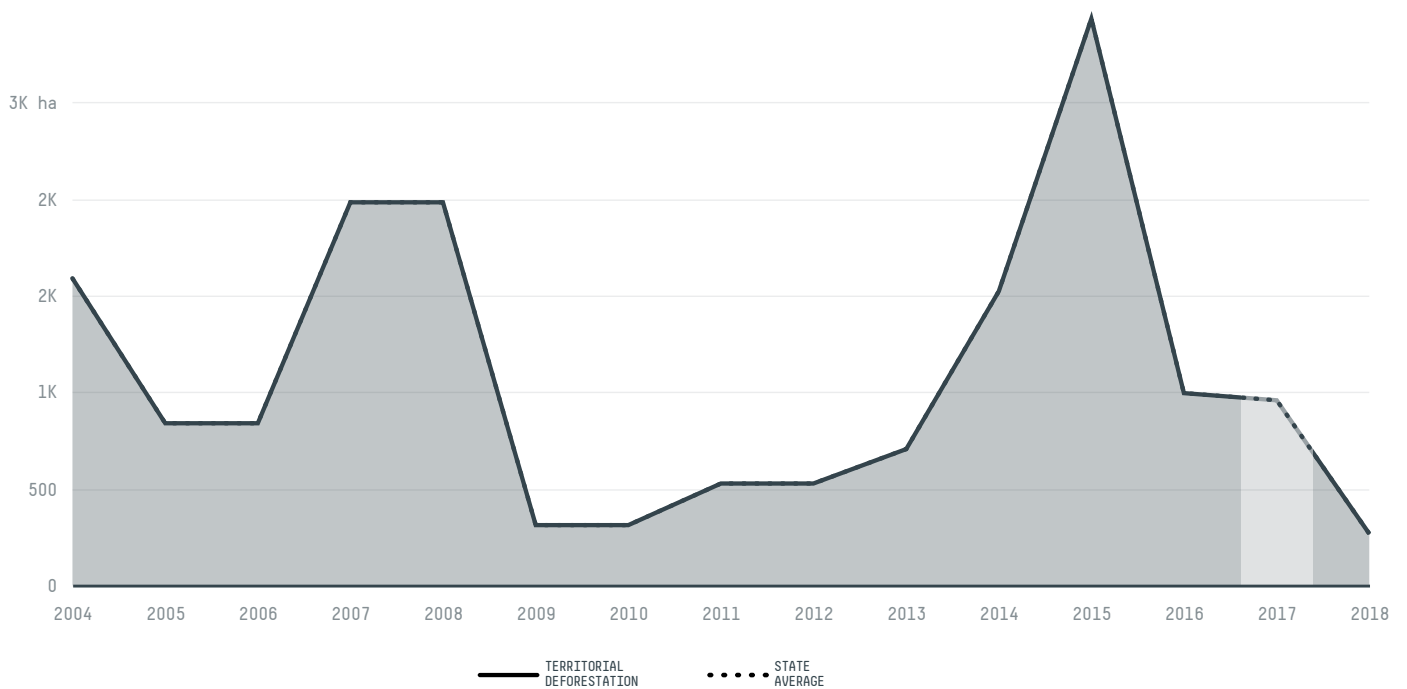

In 2017, Tabocas Do Brejo Velho produced 240 t of corn occupying a total of 500 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2020th in Brazil in corn production.
