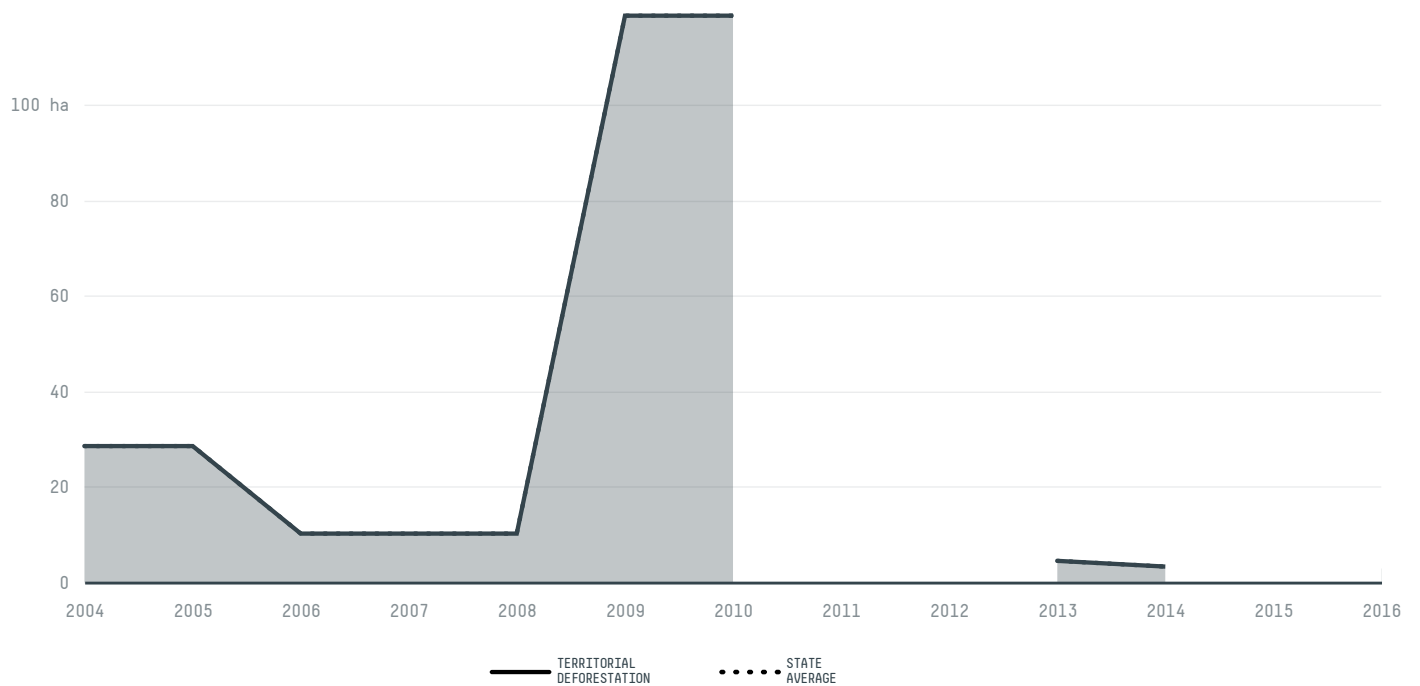
AREA PRODUCTION OF CORN CORN LAND

In 2017, Santo Amaro produced 108 t of corn occupying a total of 80 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2128th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Santo Amaro was Proquigel Quimica, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Japan.

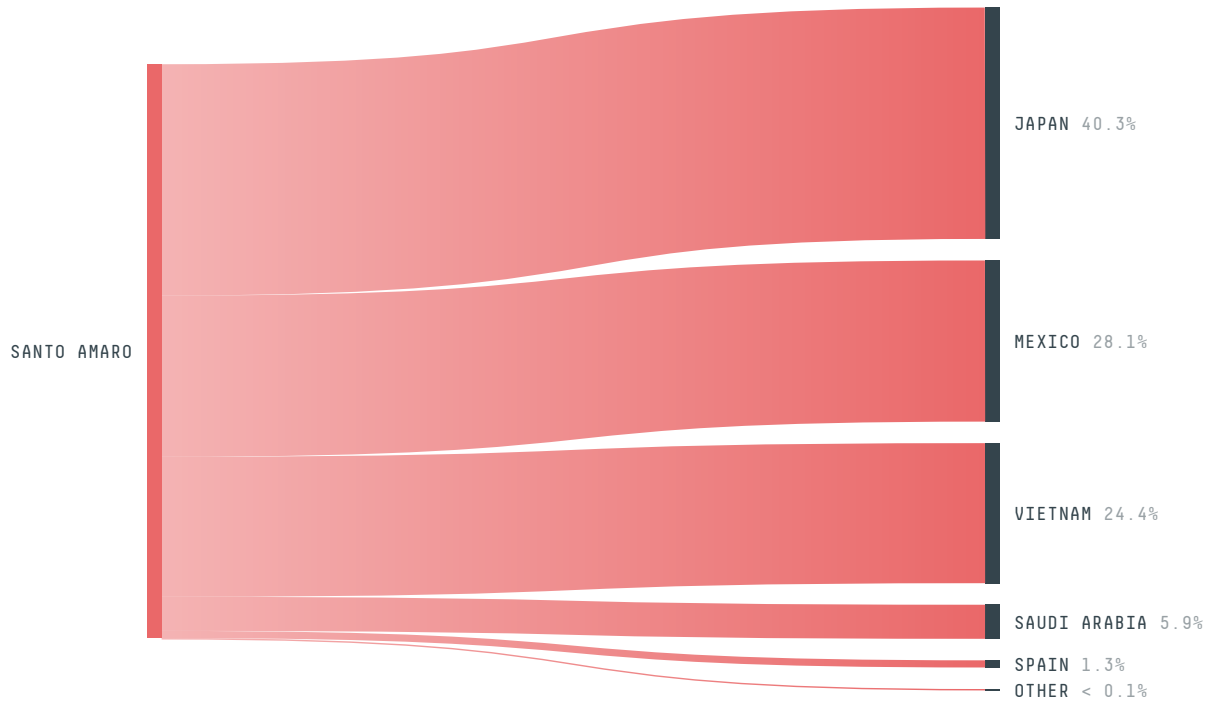
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SANTO AMARO
