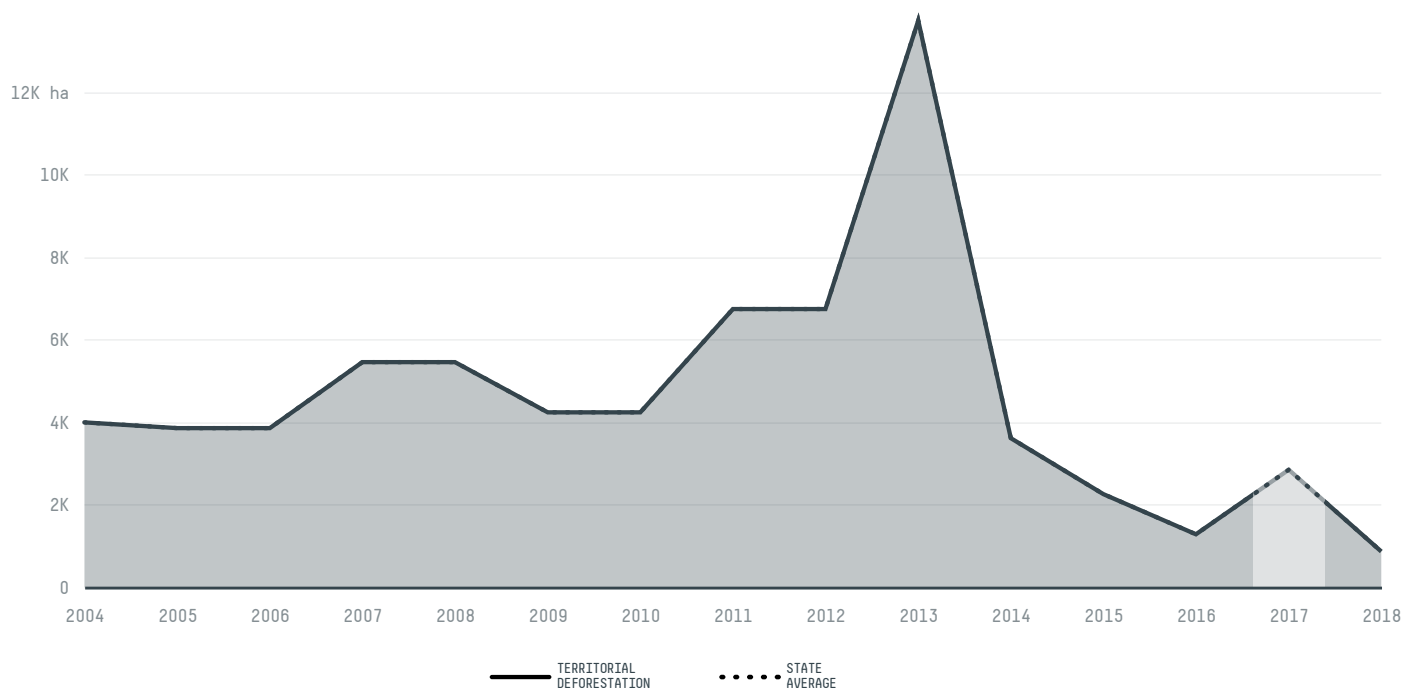
AREA PRODUCTION OF CORN CORN LAND

In 2017, Luis Eduardo Magalhaes produced 103,833 t of corn occupying a total of 19,481 ha of land. With 0.07% of the total production, it ranks 172nd in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Luis Eduardo Magalhaes was Gavilon, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

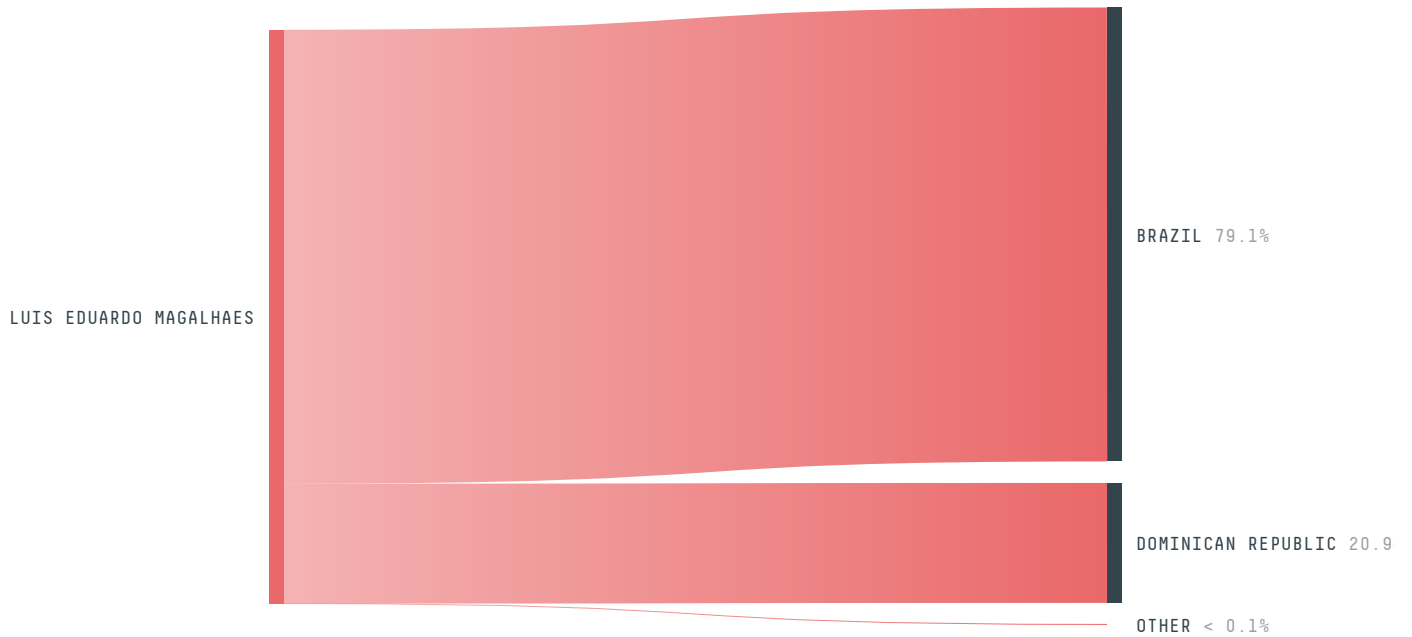
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF LUIS EDUARDO MAGALHAES
