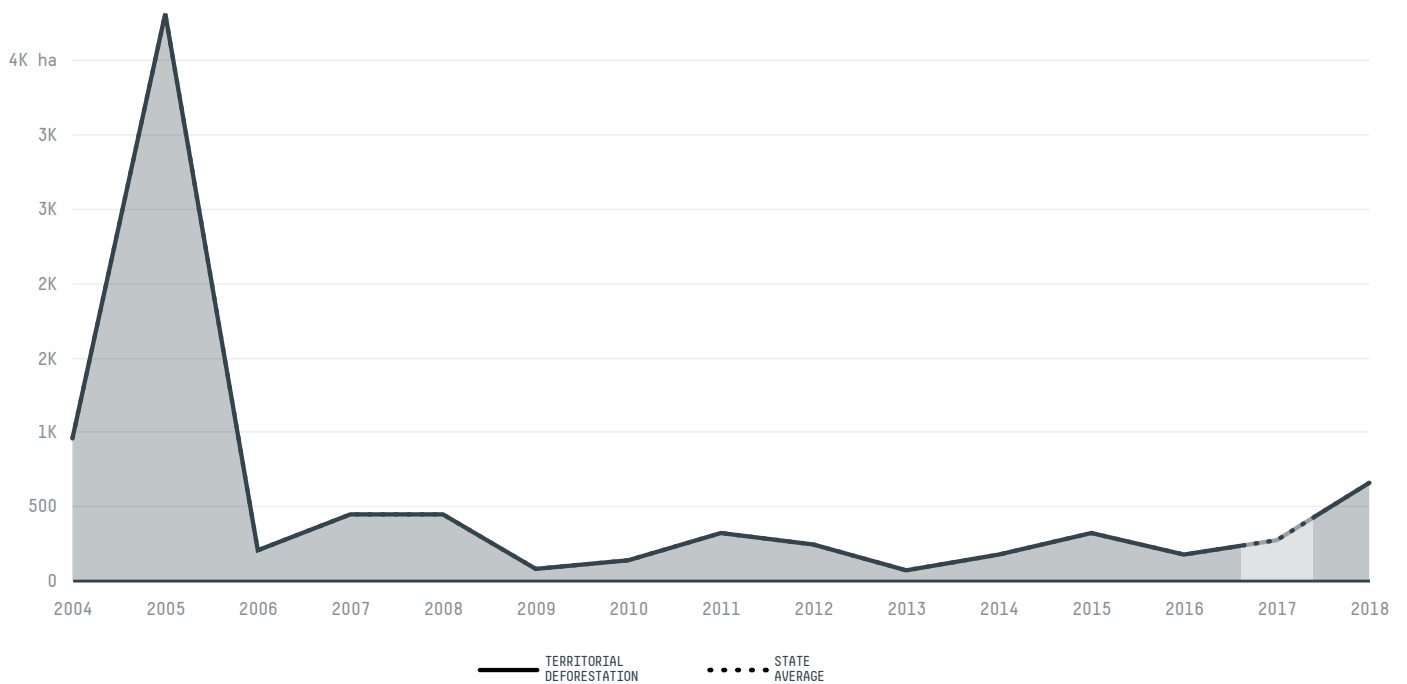
In 2017, Corumbiara produced 144,360 t of corn occupying a total of 30,075 ha of land. With 0.09% of the total production, it ranks 118th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Corumbiara was Cargill, which accounted for 74.4% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.

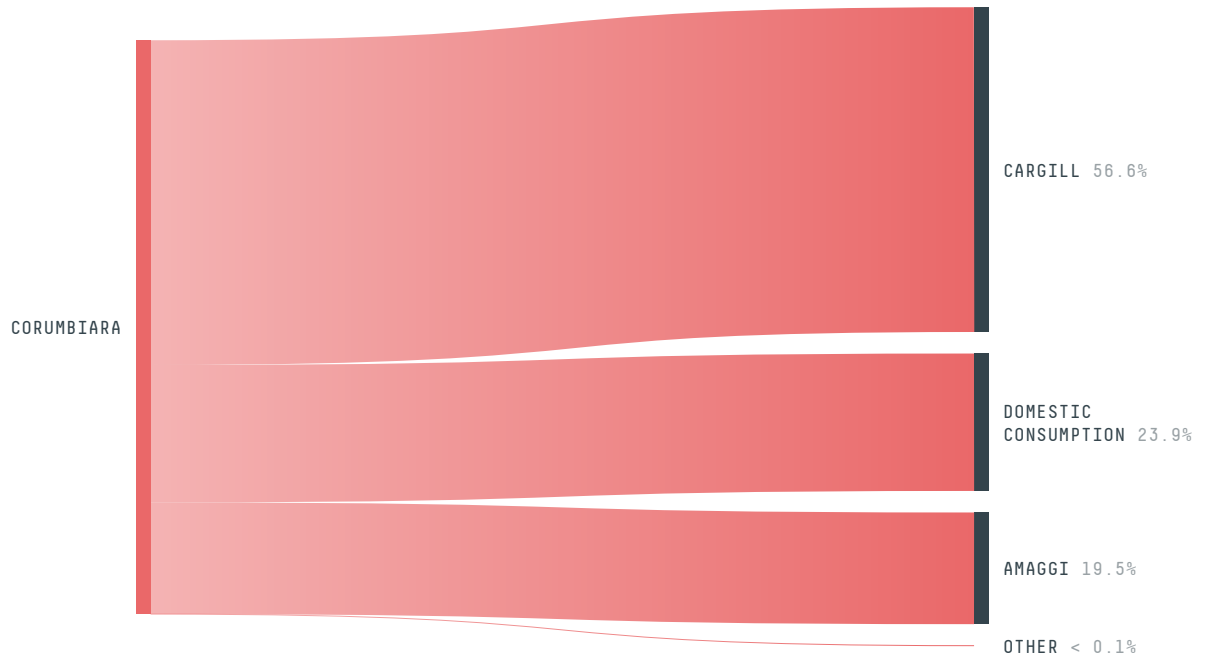

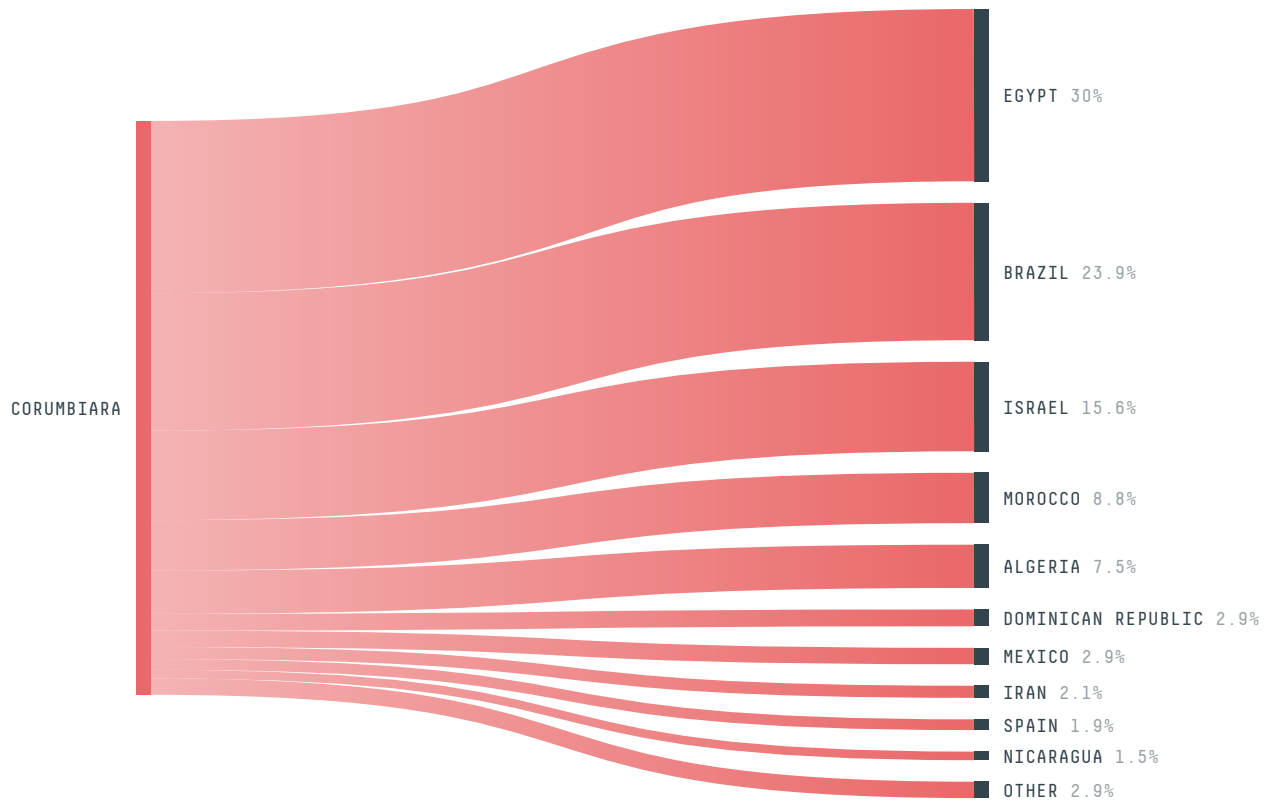
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CORUMBIARA
