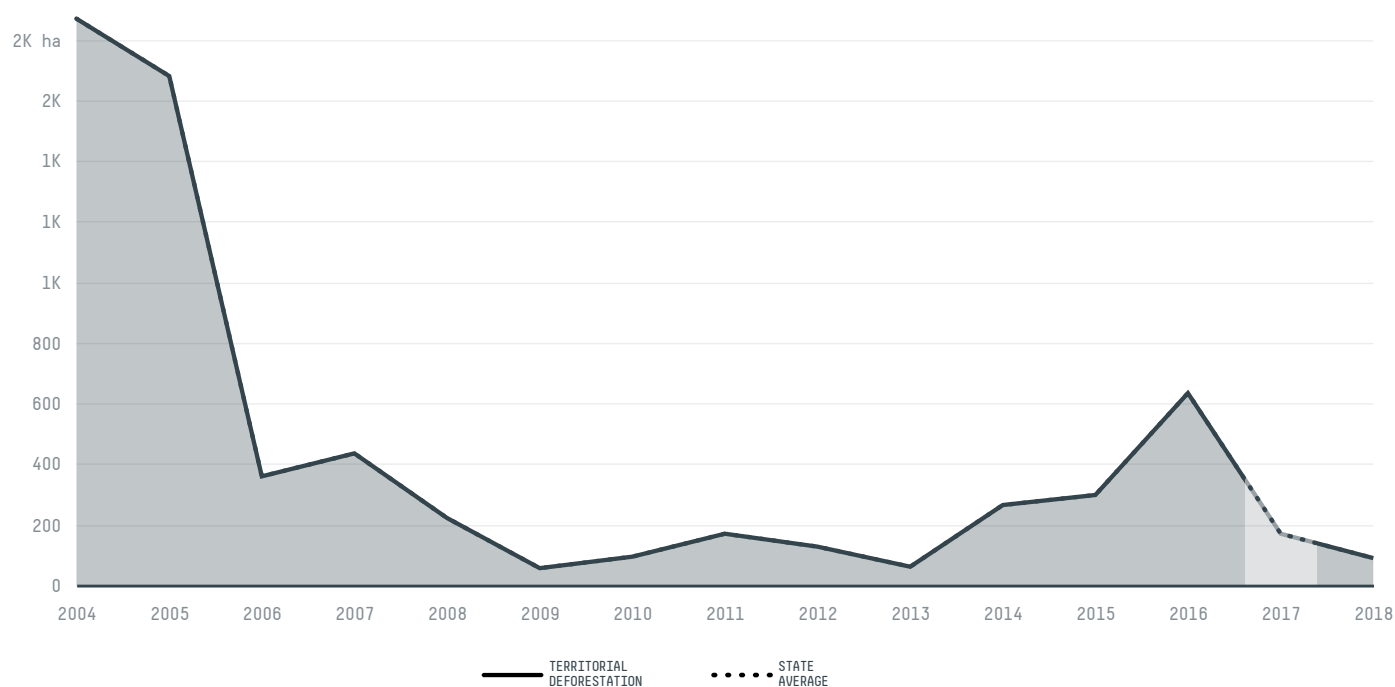
AREA PRODUCTION OF CORN CORN LAND
2,783 km² 105,760 t 22,033 ha

In 2017, Cerejeiras produced 105,760 t of corn occupying a total of 22,033 ha of land. With 0.07% of the total production, it ranks 170th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Cerejeiras was Cargill, which accounted for 74.4% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.

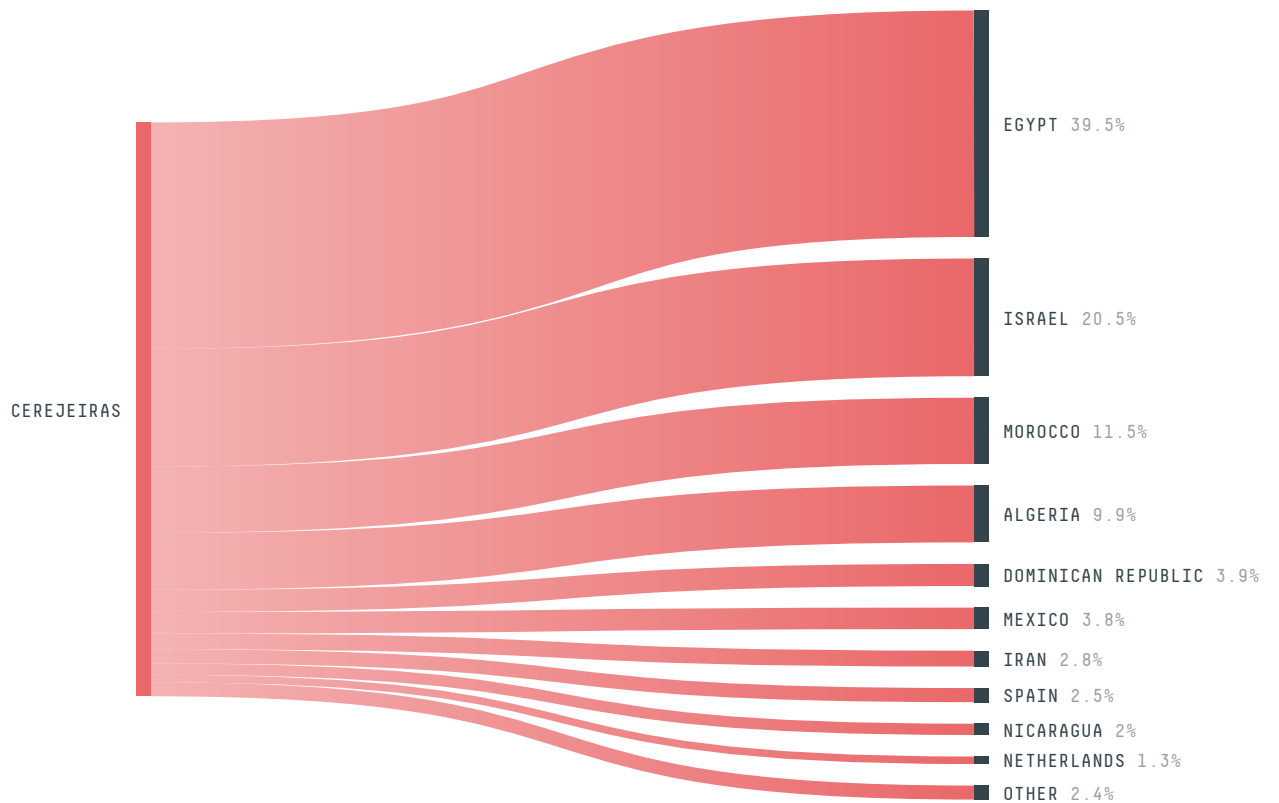
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CEREJEIRAS
