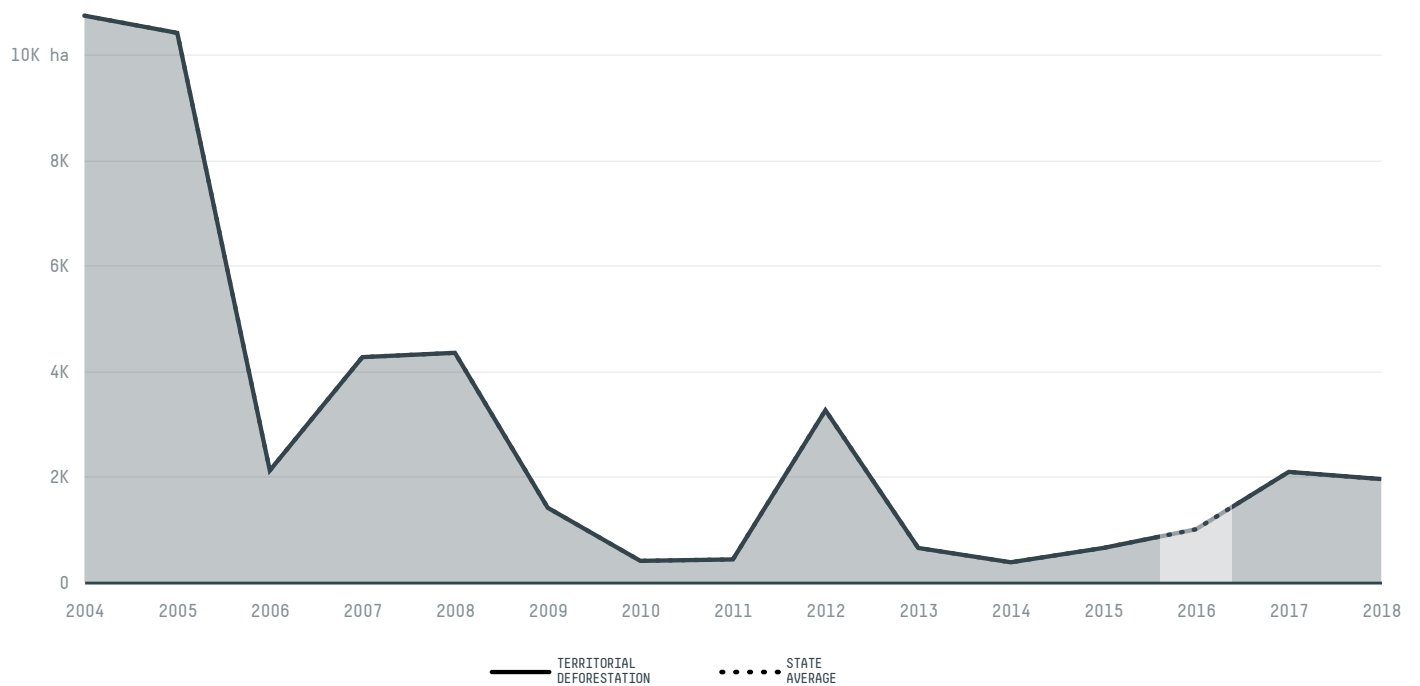

In 2016, Pimenta Bueno produced 853 t of corn occupying a total of 474 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1537th in Brazil in corn production.
