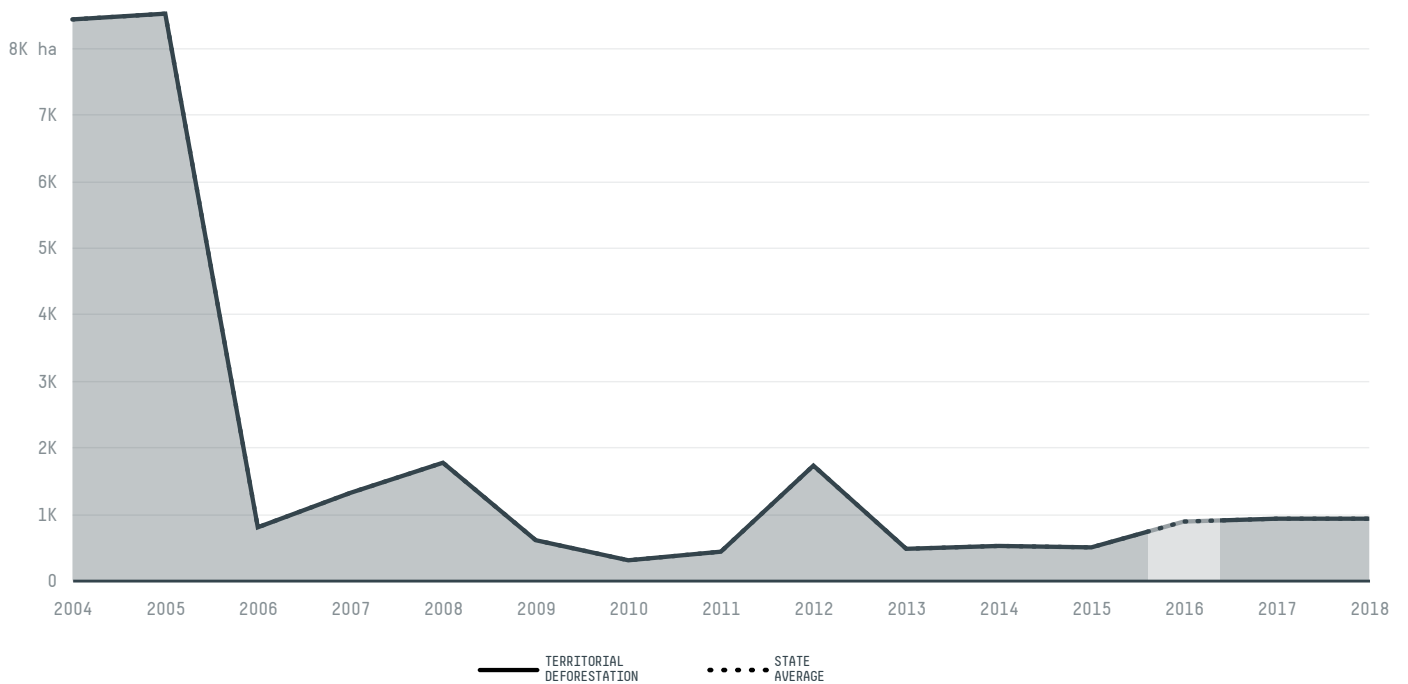

In 2016, Chupinguaia produced 72,216 t of corn occupying a total of 12,056 ha of land. With 0.07% of the total production, it ranks 164th in Brazil in corn production.
