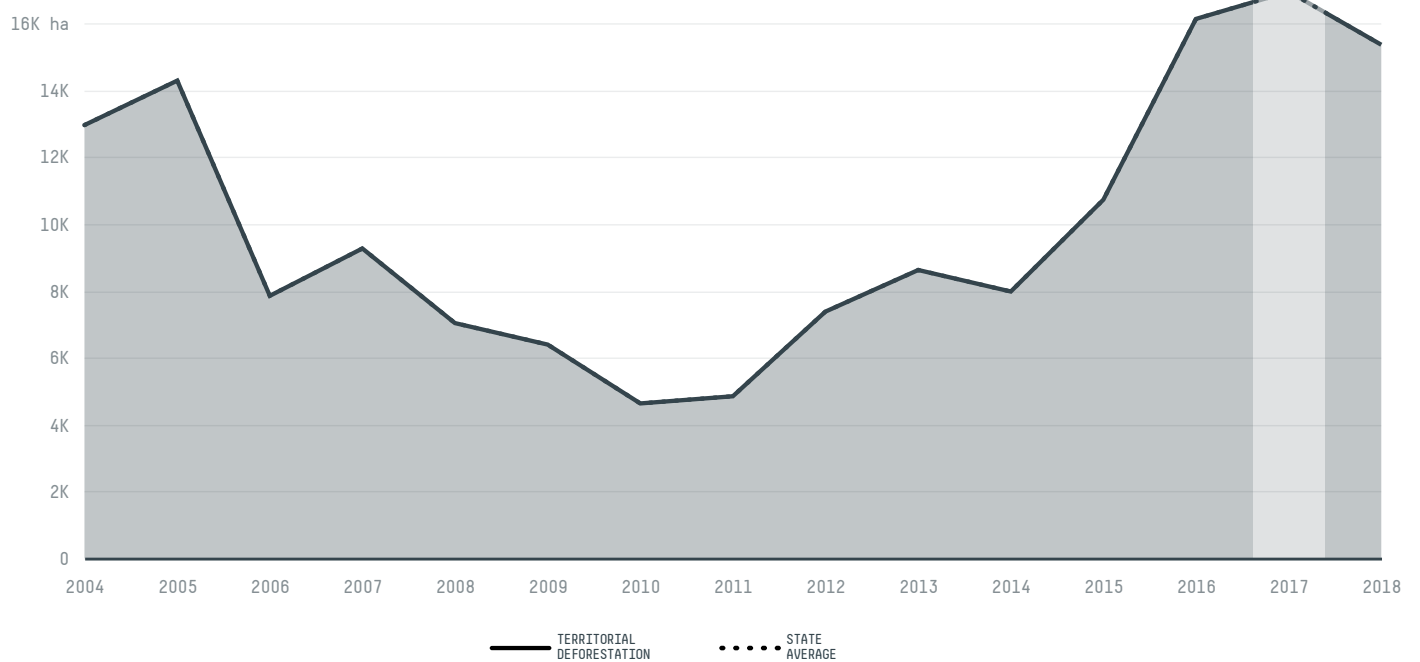

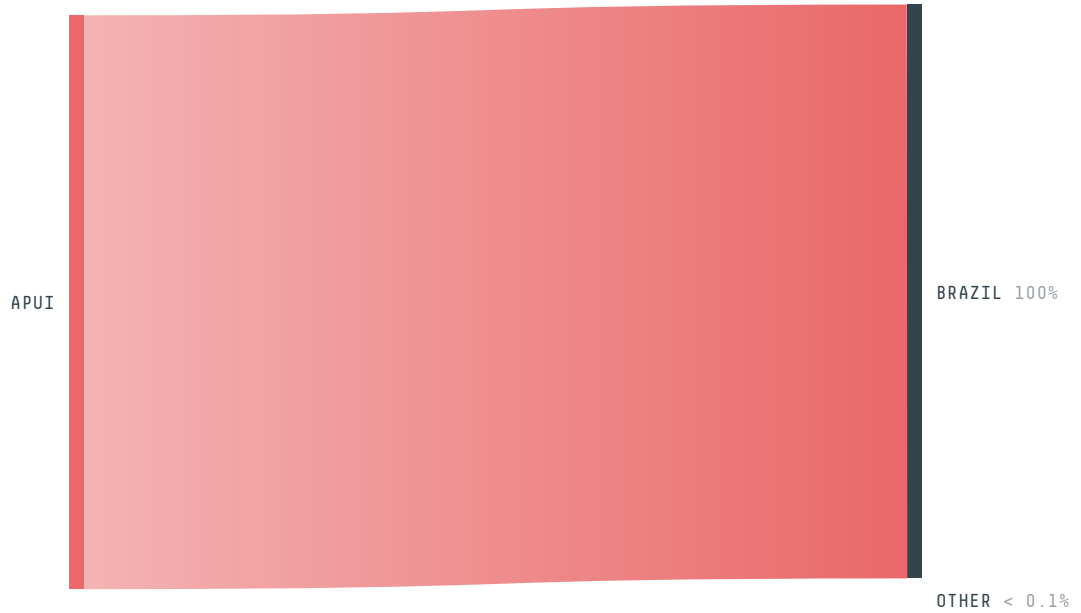
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF APUÍ
