
In 2017, Canutama produced 216 t of corn occupying a total of 27 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2039th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Canutama was Big Trading E Empreendimentos Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.




## **DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CANUTAMA**
