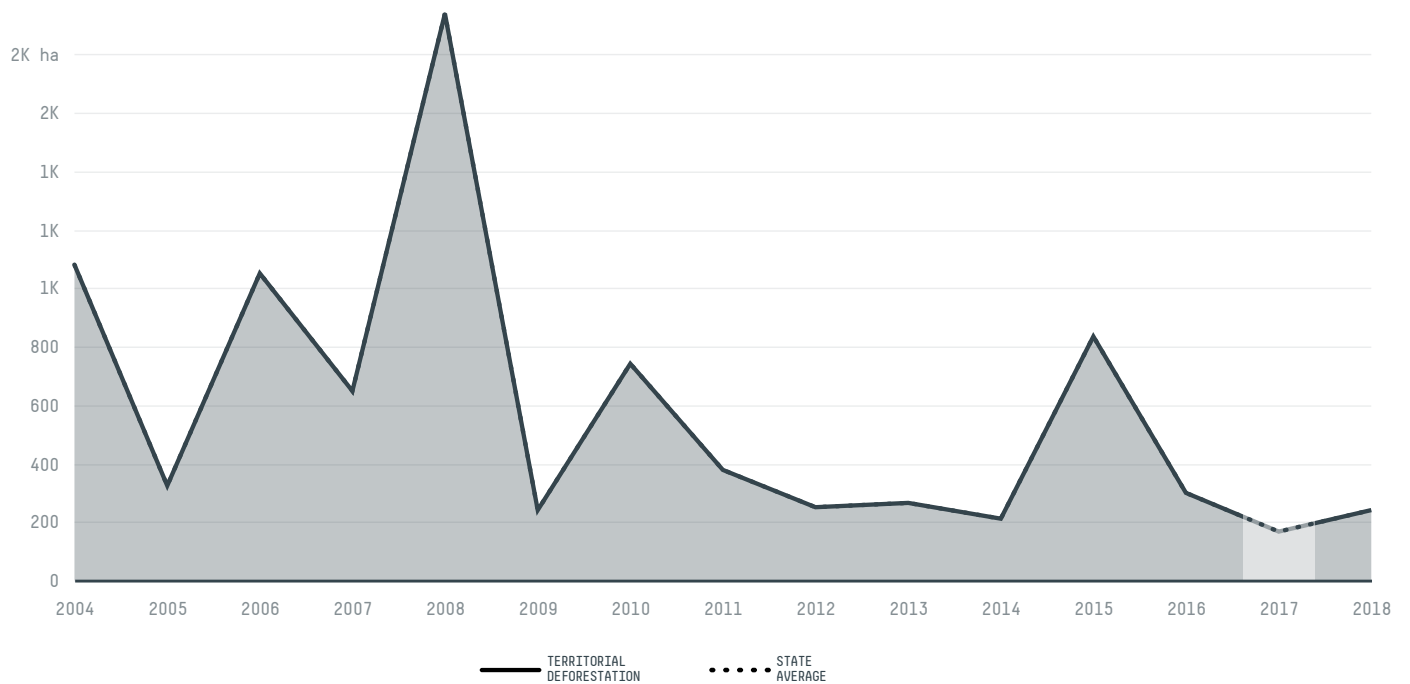

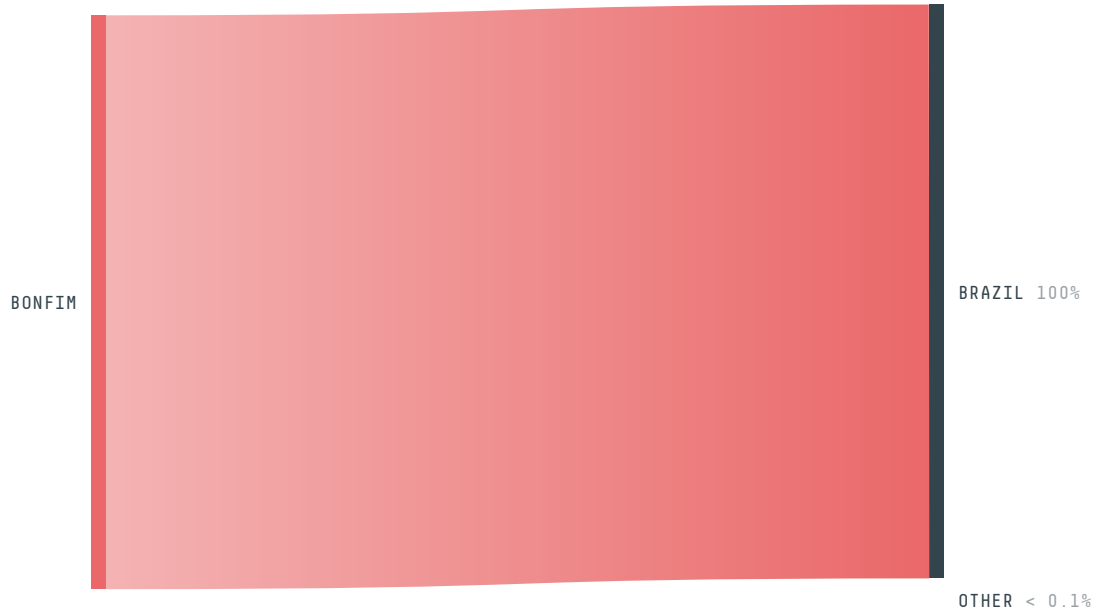
### DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BONFIM
