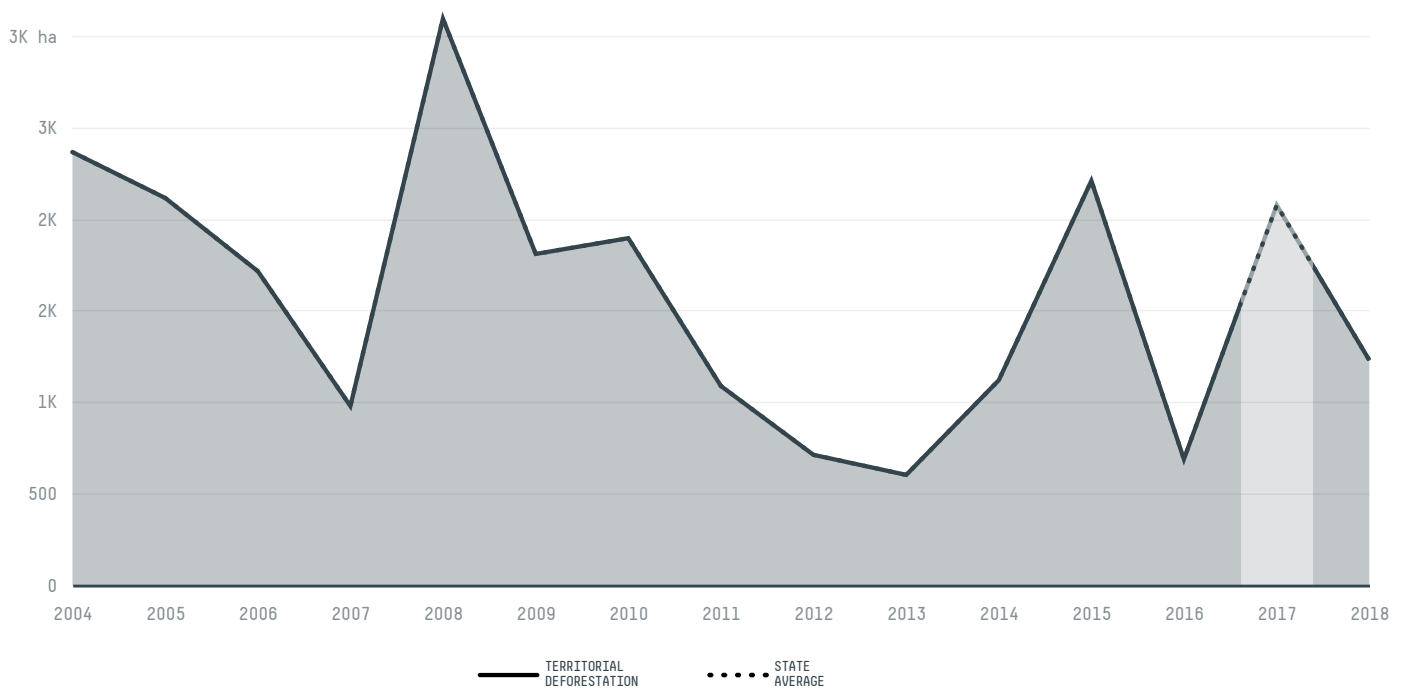

In 2017, Santarem produced 61,500 t of corn occupying a total of 15,000 ha of land. With 0.04% of the total production, it ranks 285th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Santarem was Cargill, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

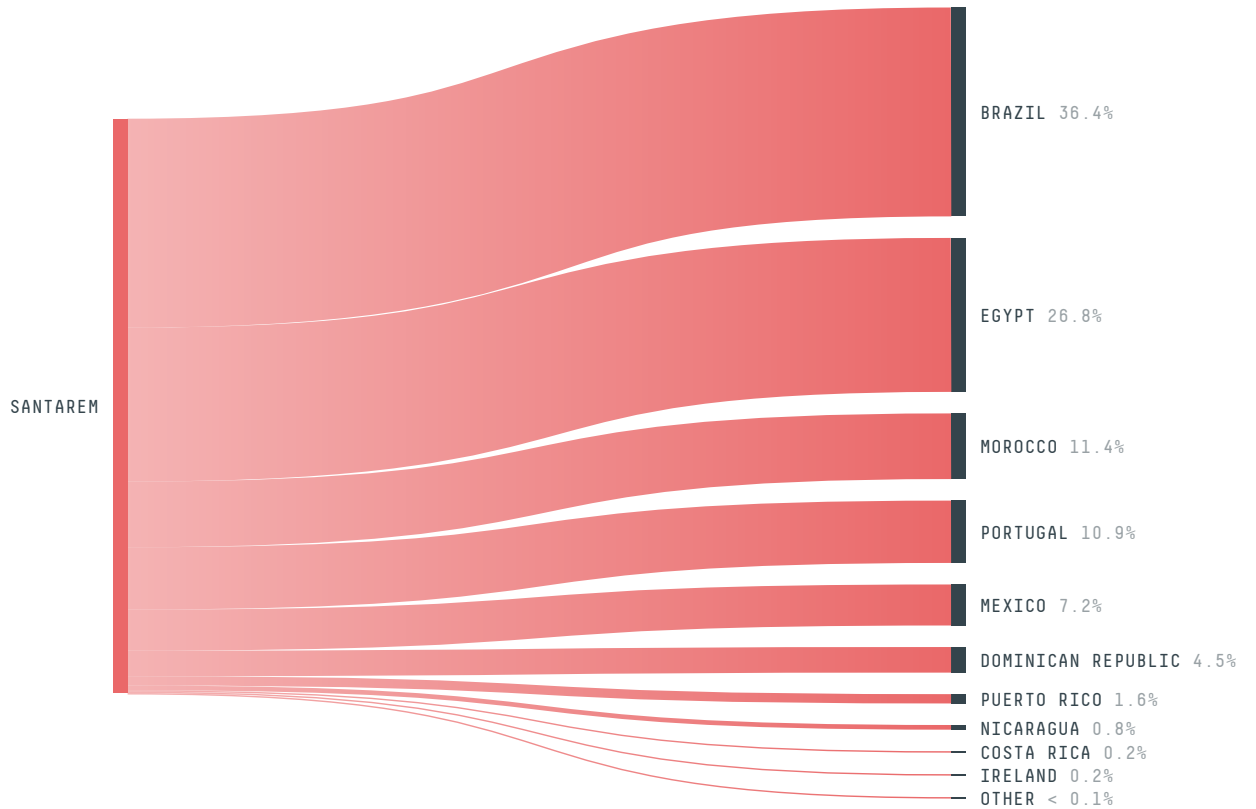
### DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SANTAREM
