In 2017, Quixeramobim produced 378 t of cotton occupying a total of 350 ha of land. With 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 65th in Brazil in cotton production. The largest exporter of cotton in Quixeramobim was Industria E Comercio De Racoos Golfinho Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Spain.
