In 2017, Malhada De Pedras produced 28 t of cotton occupying a total of 82 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 82nd in Brazil in cotton production. The largest exporter of cotton in Malhada De Pedras was Omnicotton Agri Comercial Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Turkey.




DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MALHADA DE PEDRAS
