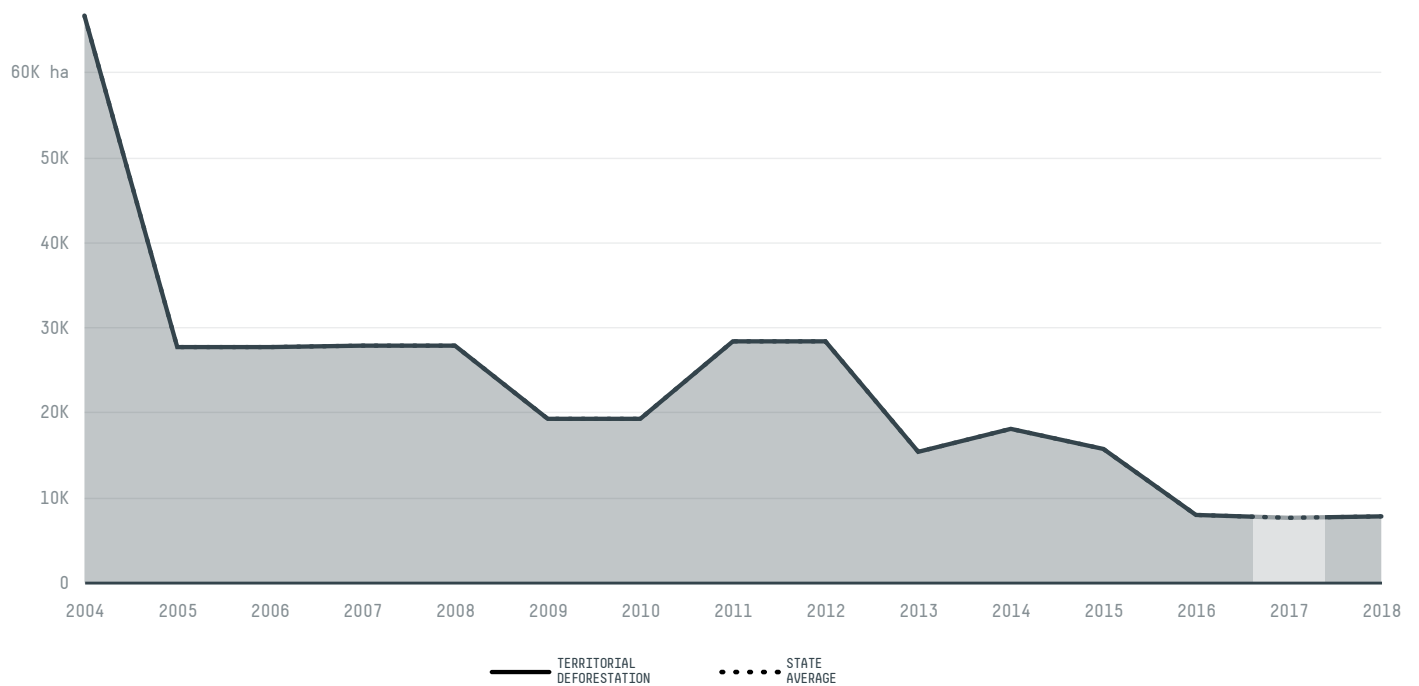
In 2017, Formosa Do Rio Preto produced 127,261 t of cotton occupying a total of 30,228 ha of land. With 1.78% of the total production, it ranks 8th in Brazil in cotton production. The largest exporter of cotton in Formosa Do Rio Preto was Cargill, which accounted for 49.1% of the total exports, and the main destination was Vietnam.

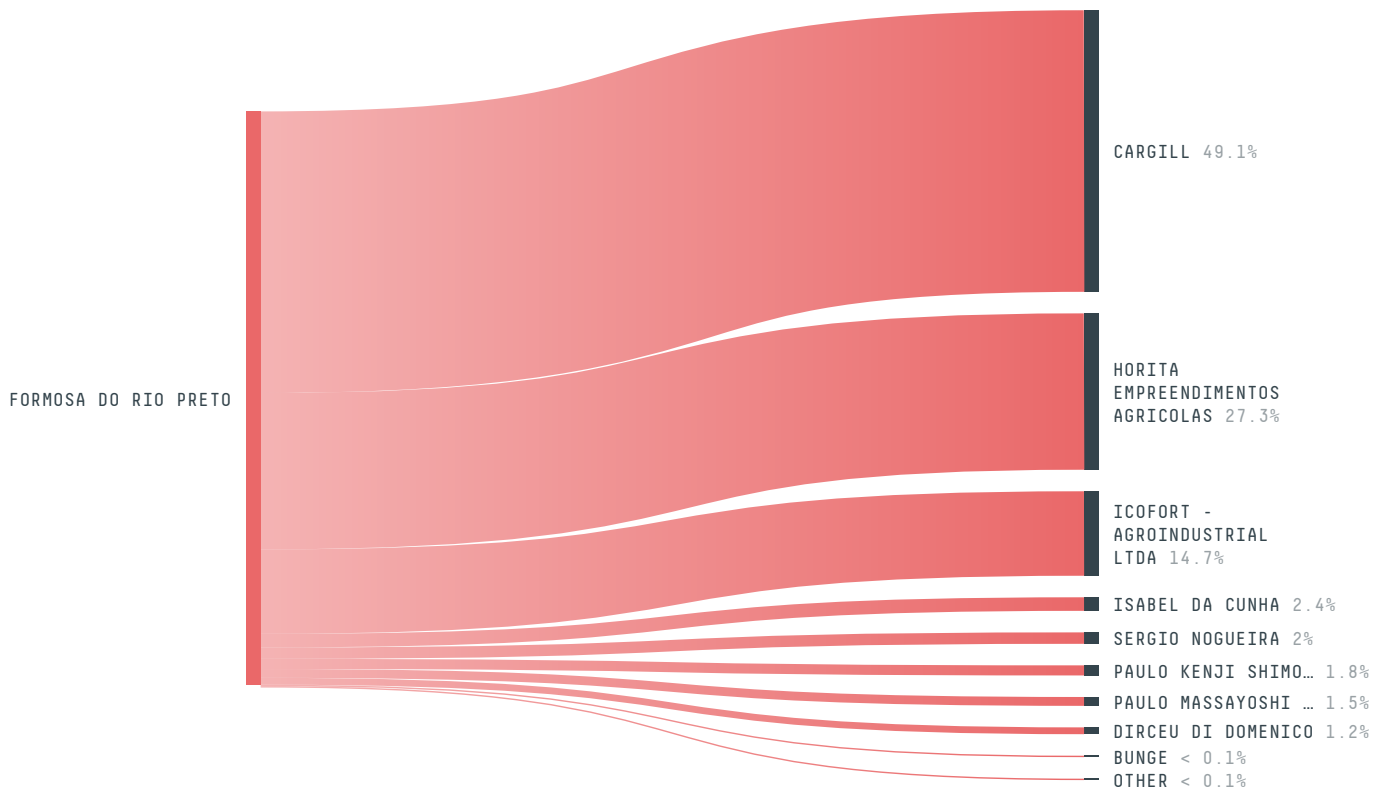

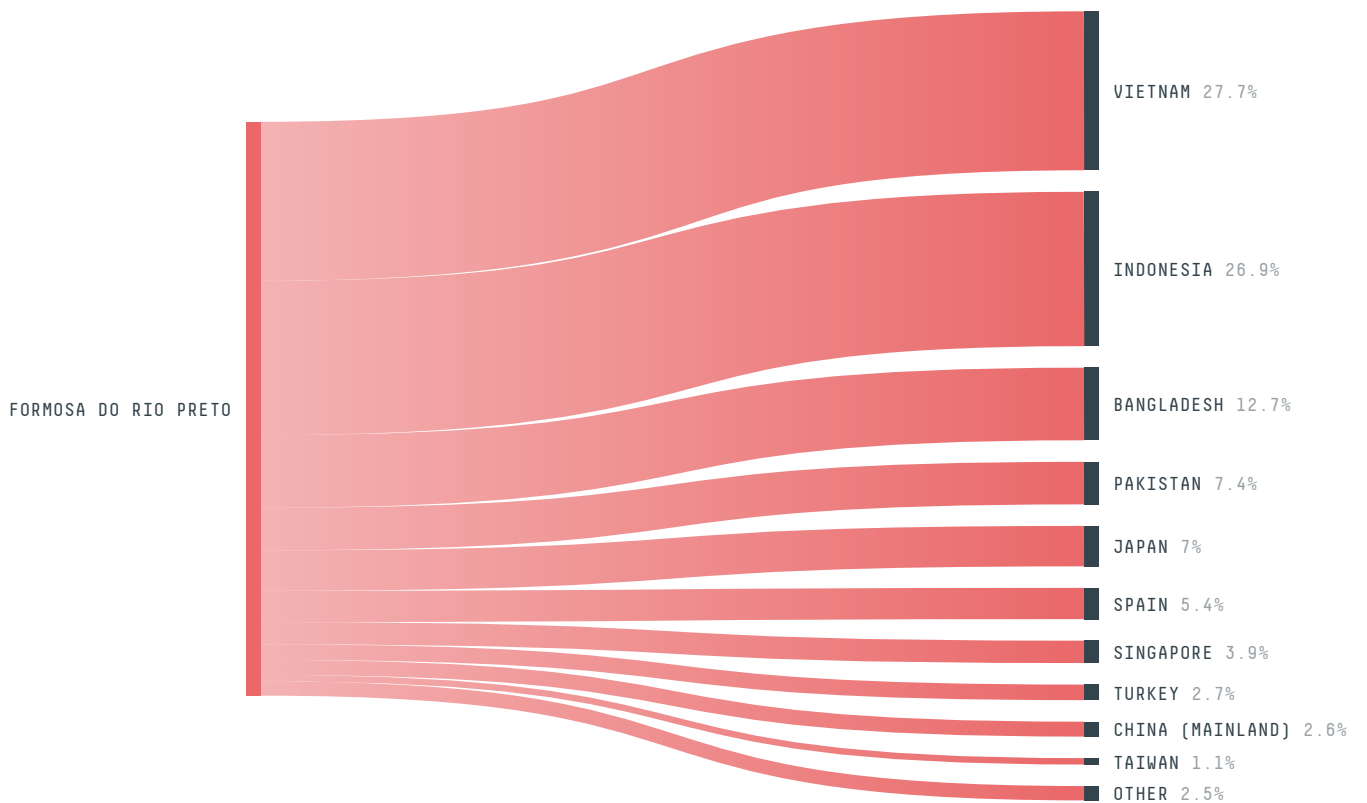
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF FORMOSA DO RIO PRETO
