The largest exporter of beef in Soure was Mercurio Alimentos, which accounted for 86.4% of the total exports, and the main destination was Turkey.

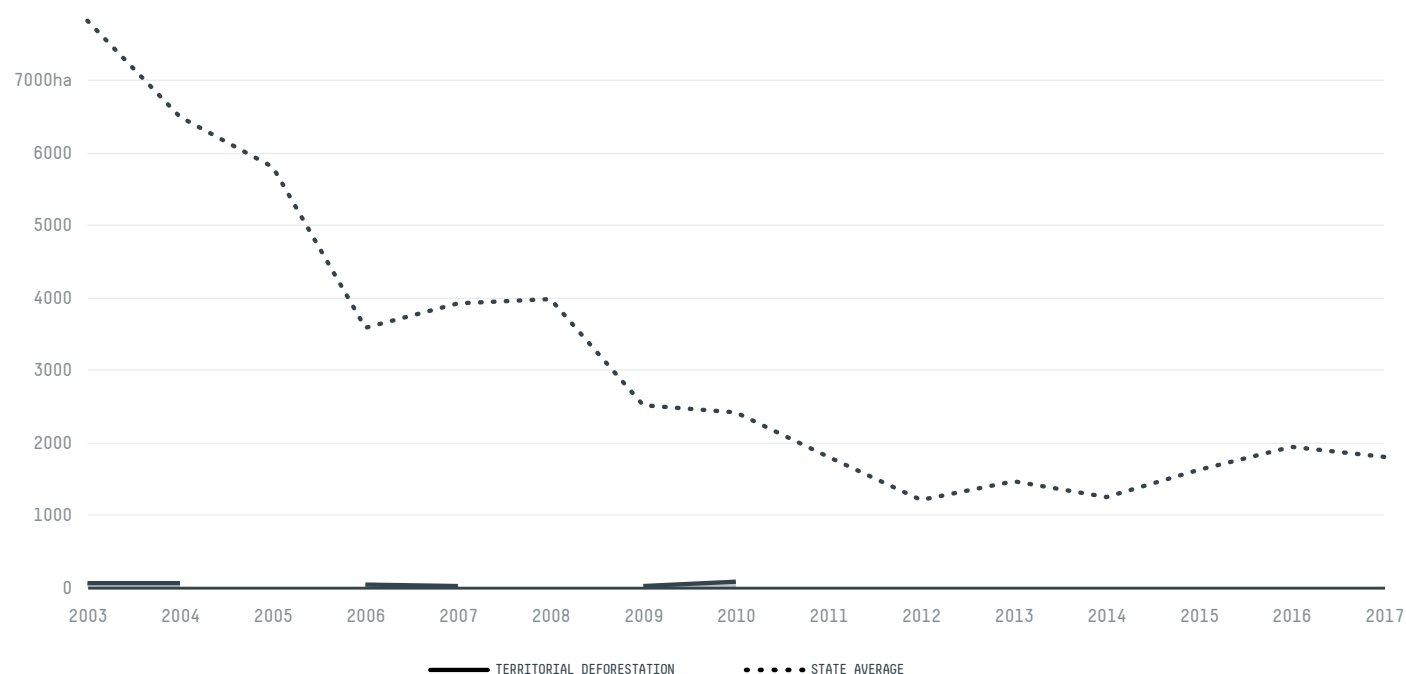
