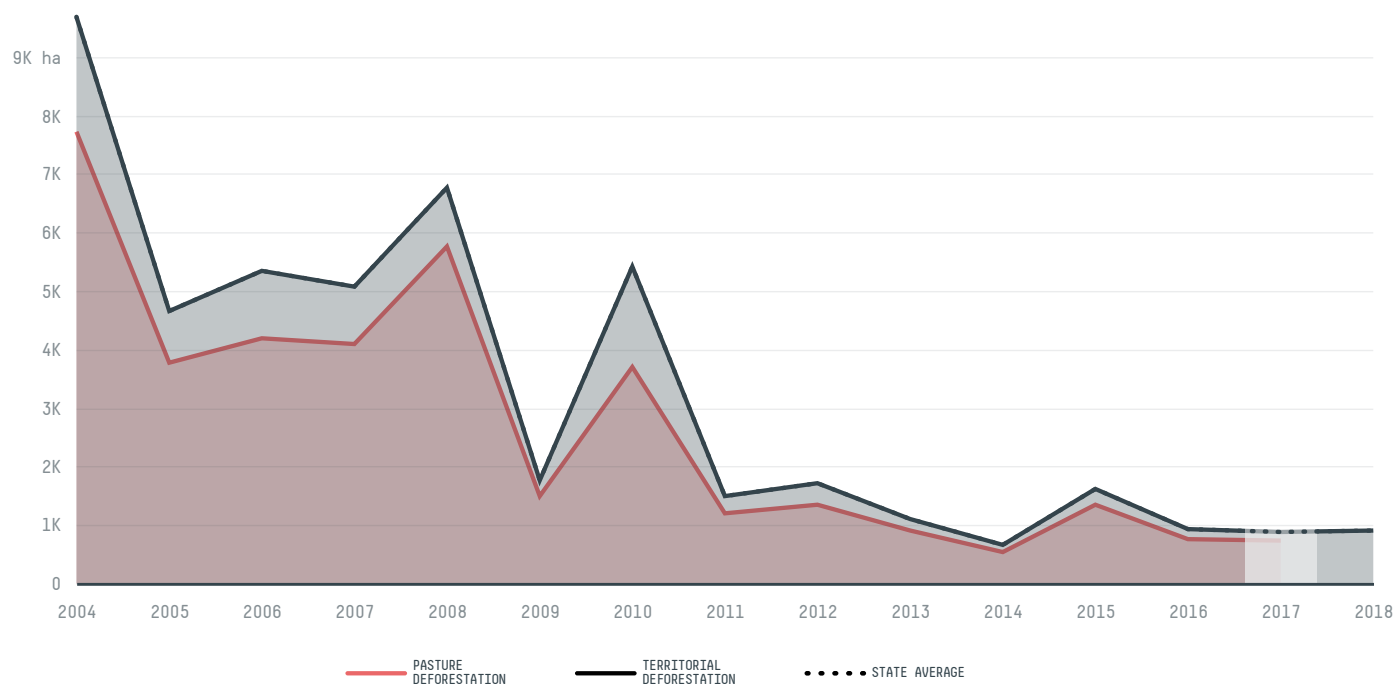

The largest exporter of beef in Breu Branco was Mercurio Alimentos, which accounted for 74.9% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

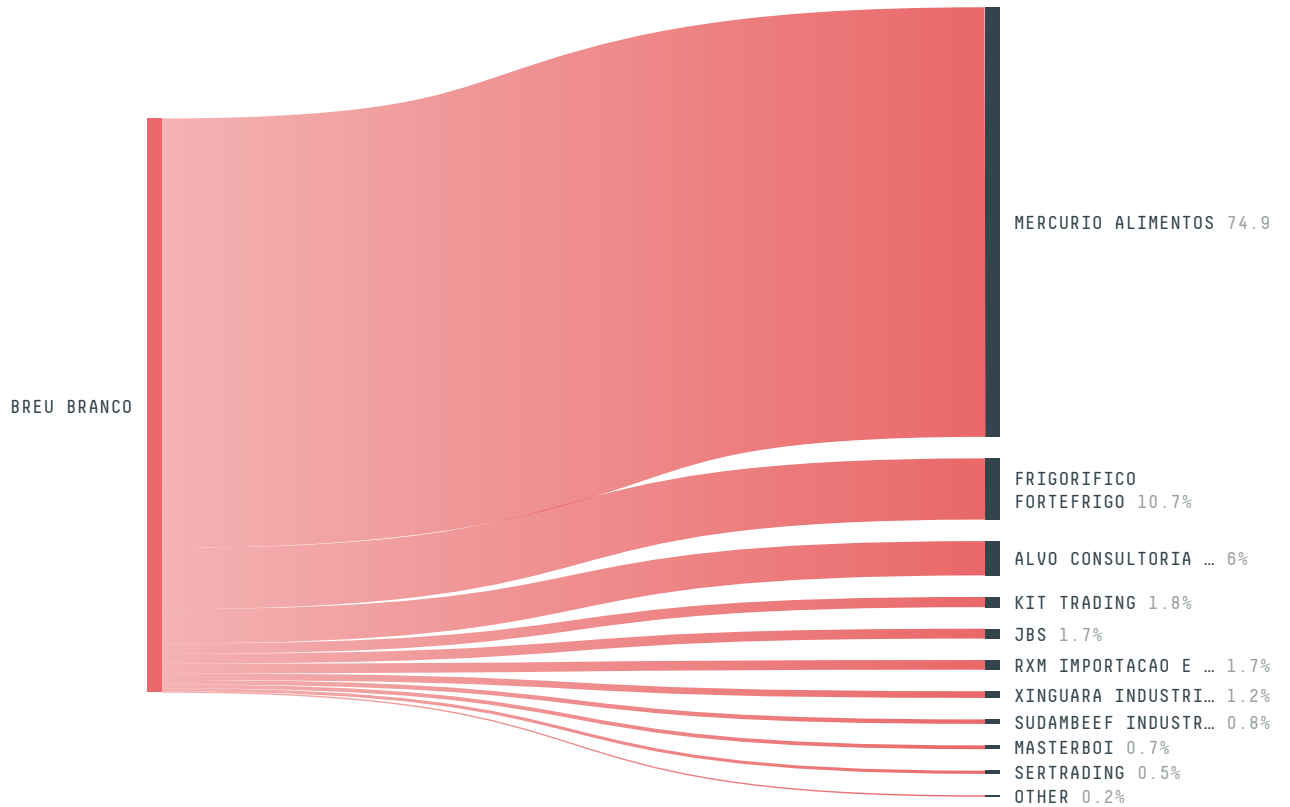

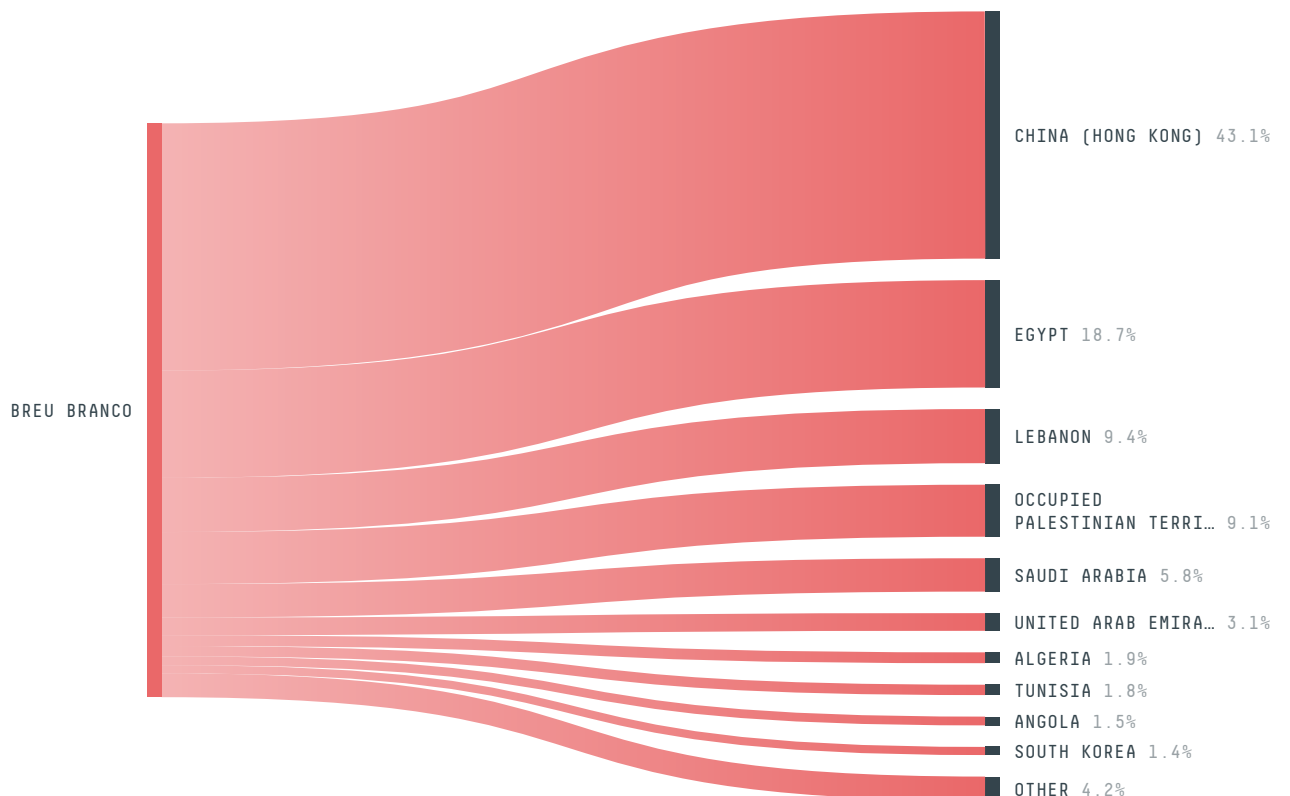
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BREU BRANCO



TOP TRADERS OF BEEF IN BREU BRANCO IN 2017

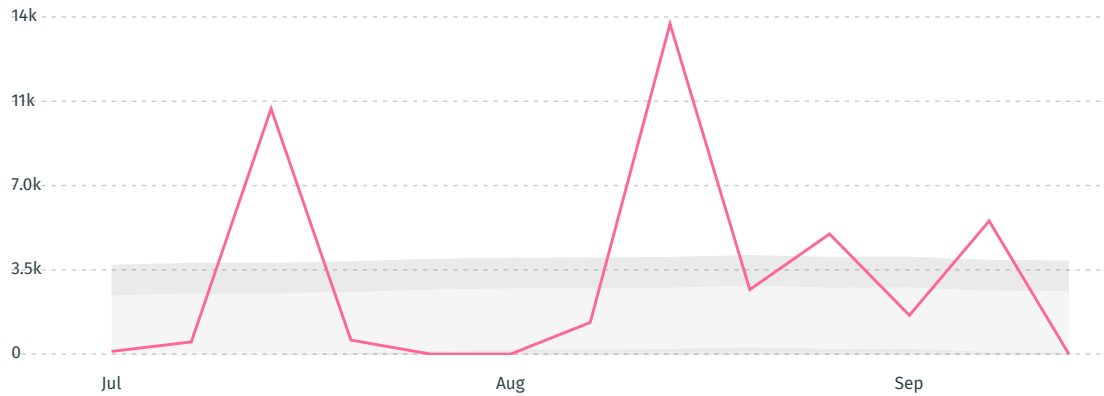


TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF BEEF FROM BREU BRANCO IN 2017
