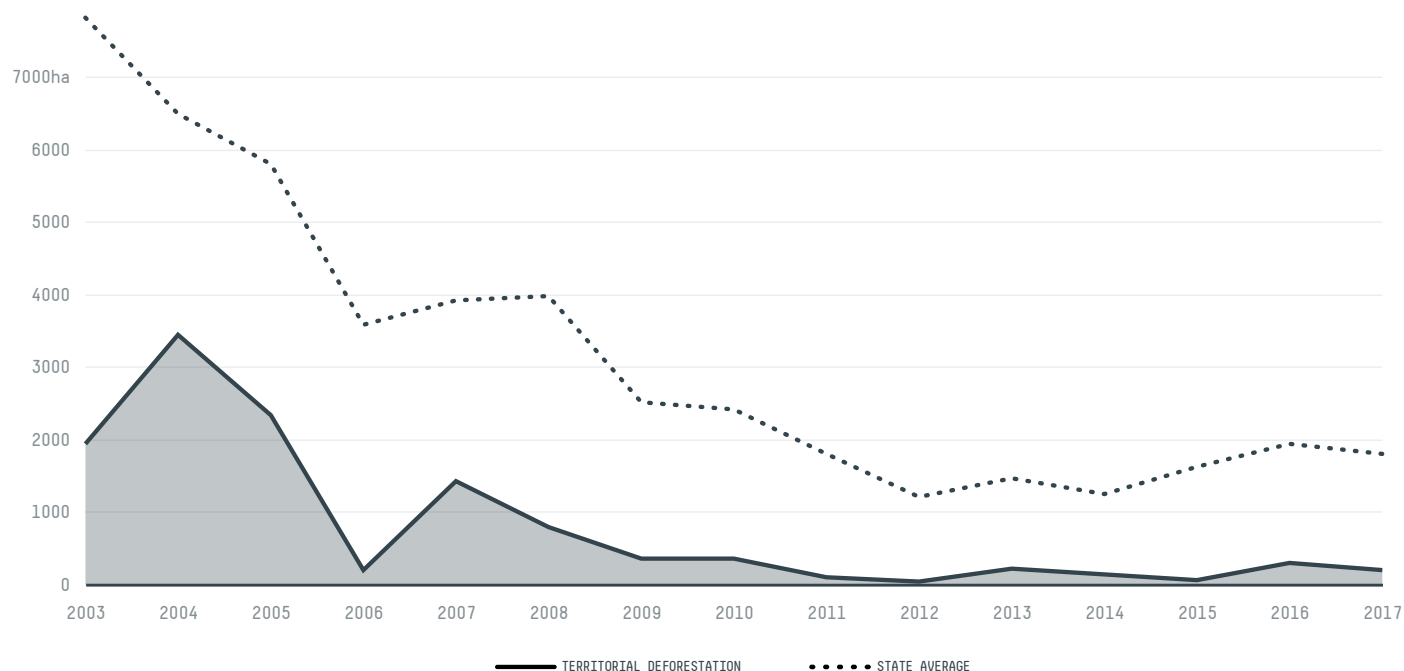

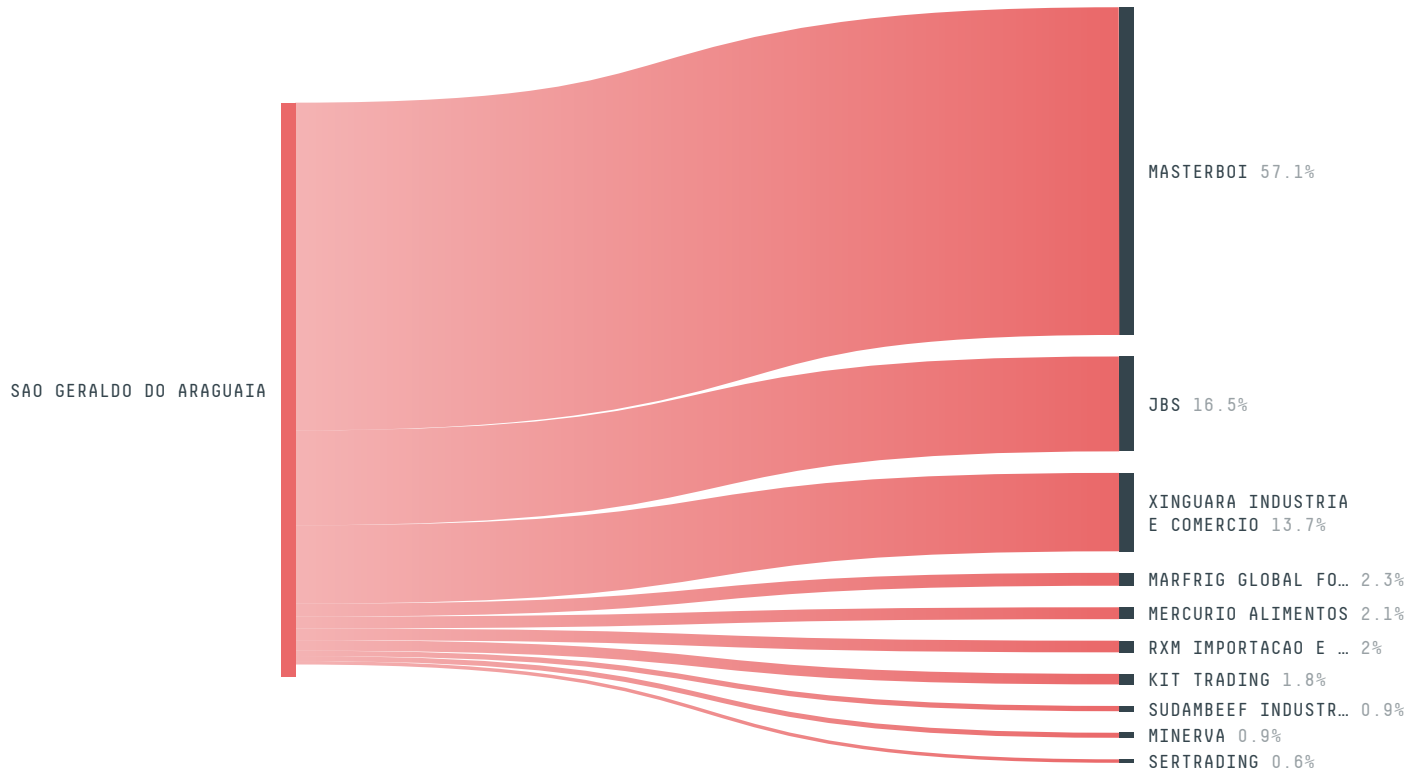

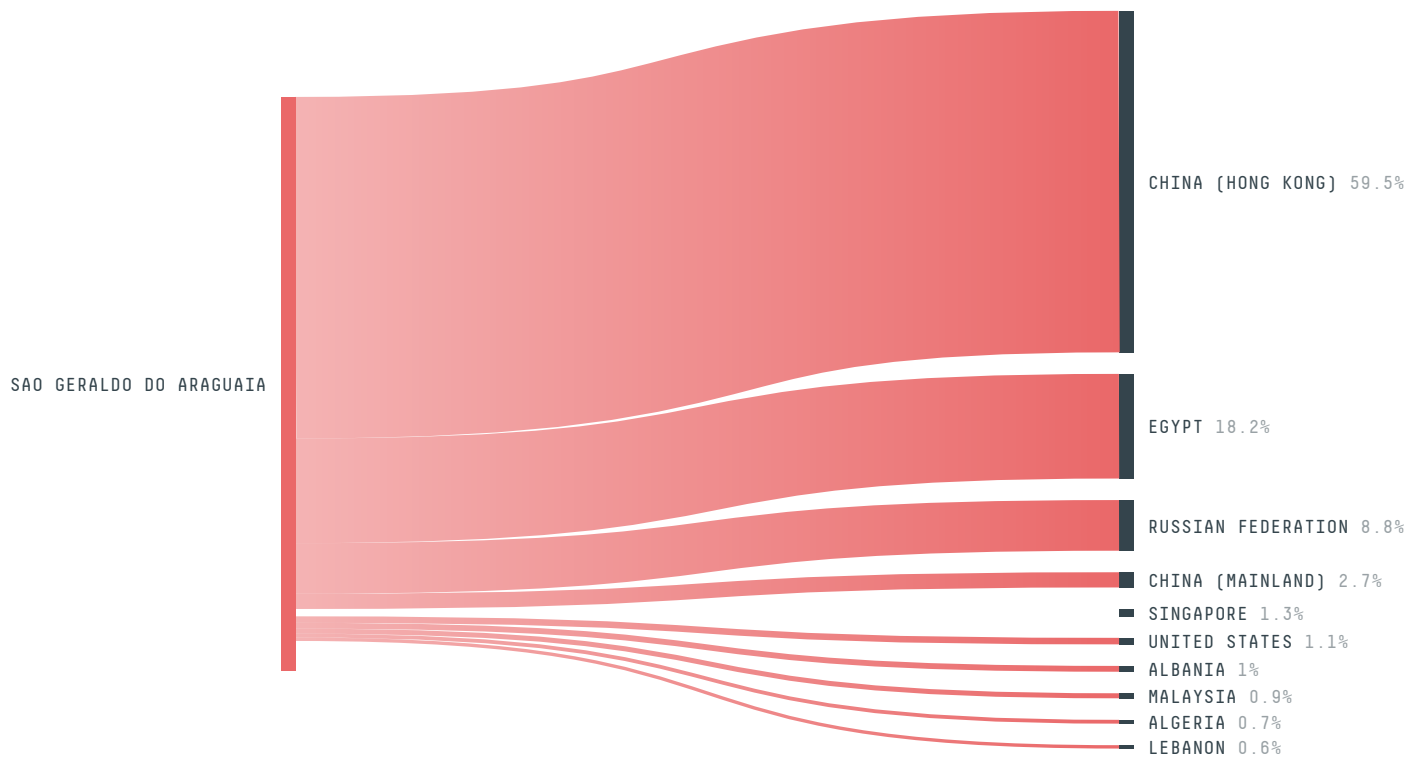
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SAO GERALDO DO ARAGUAIA
