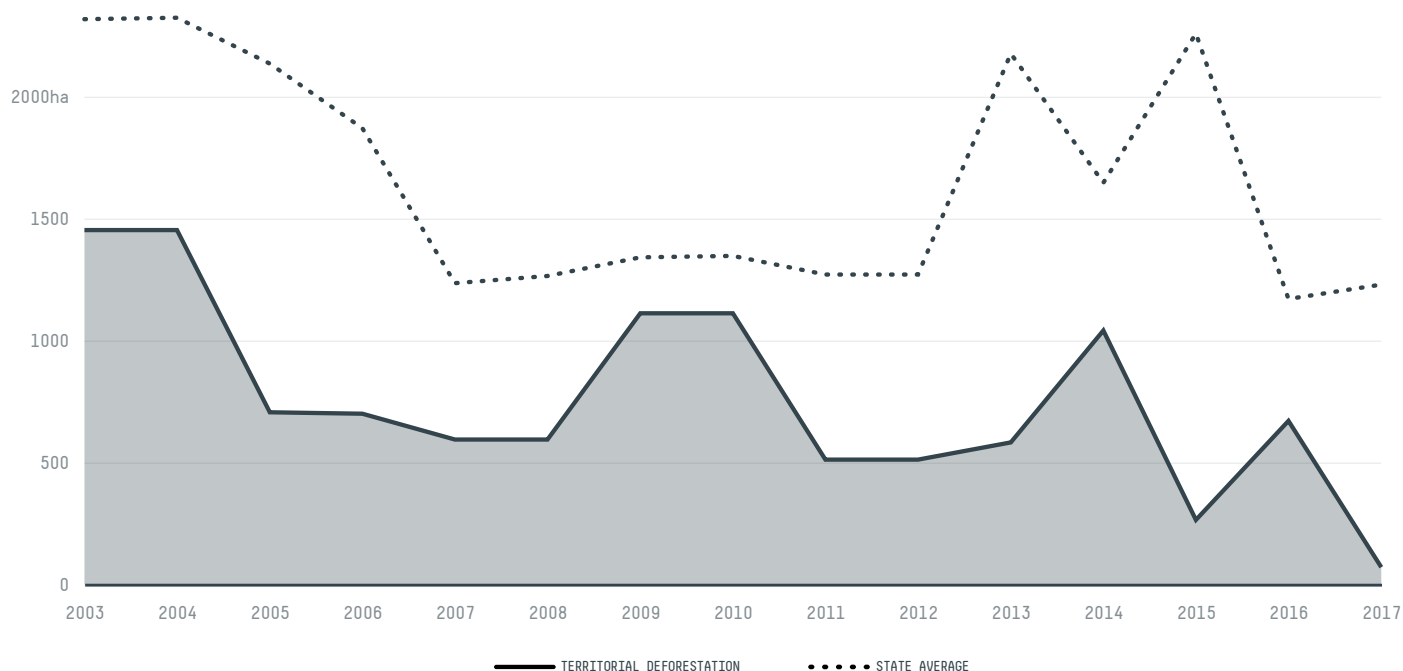
The largest exporter of beef in Brasilia Do Tocantins was Minerva, which accounted for 88.3% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

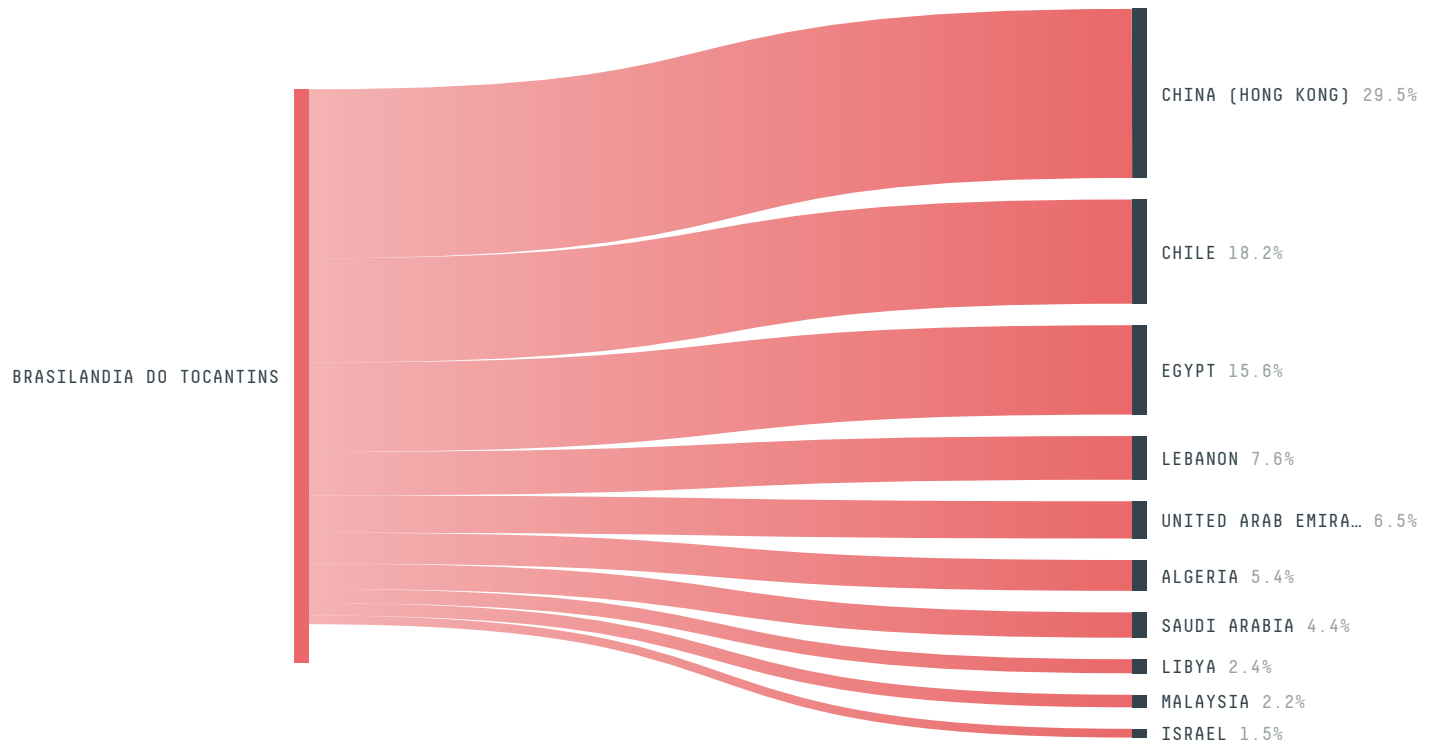
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BRASILANDIA DO TOCANTINS
