The largest exporter of beef in Couto De Magalhaes was Minerva, which accounted for 94.1% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

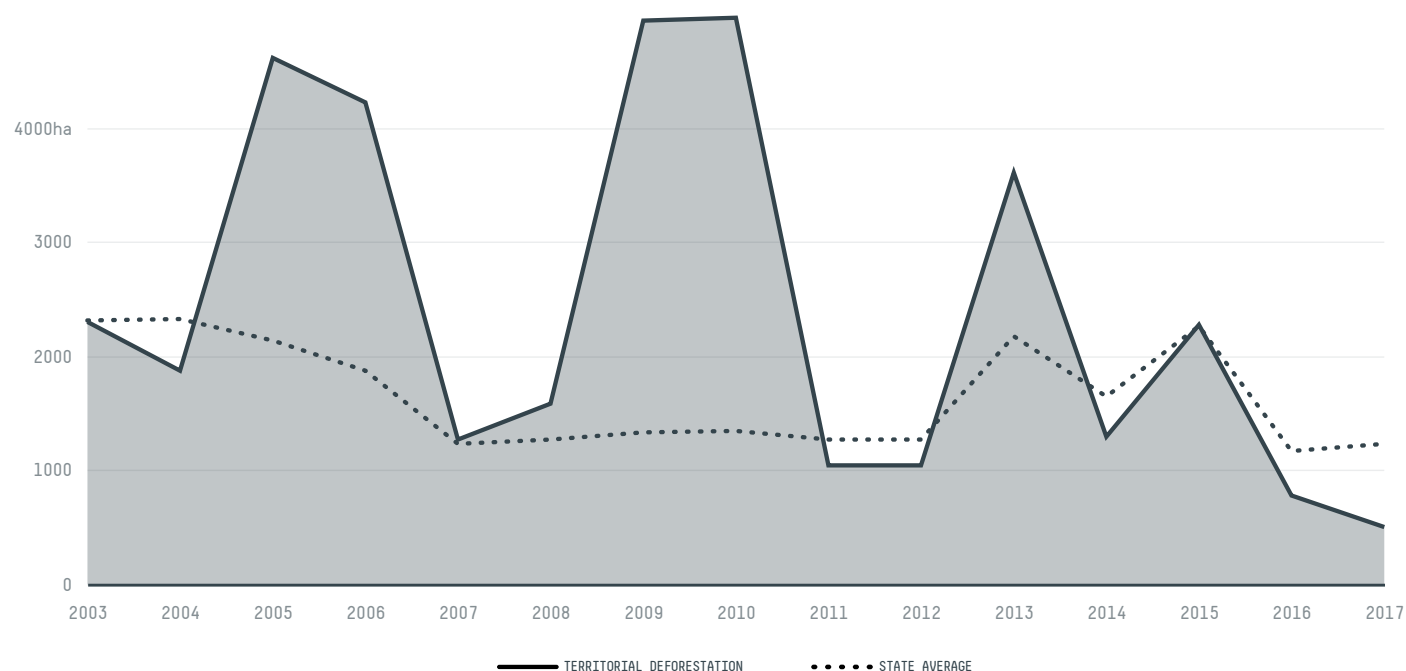

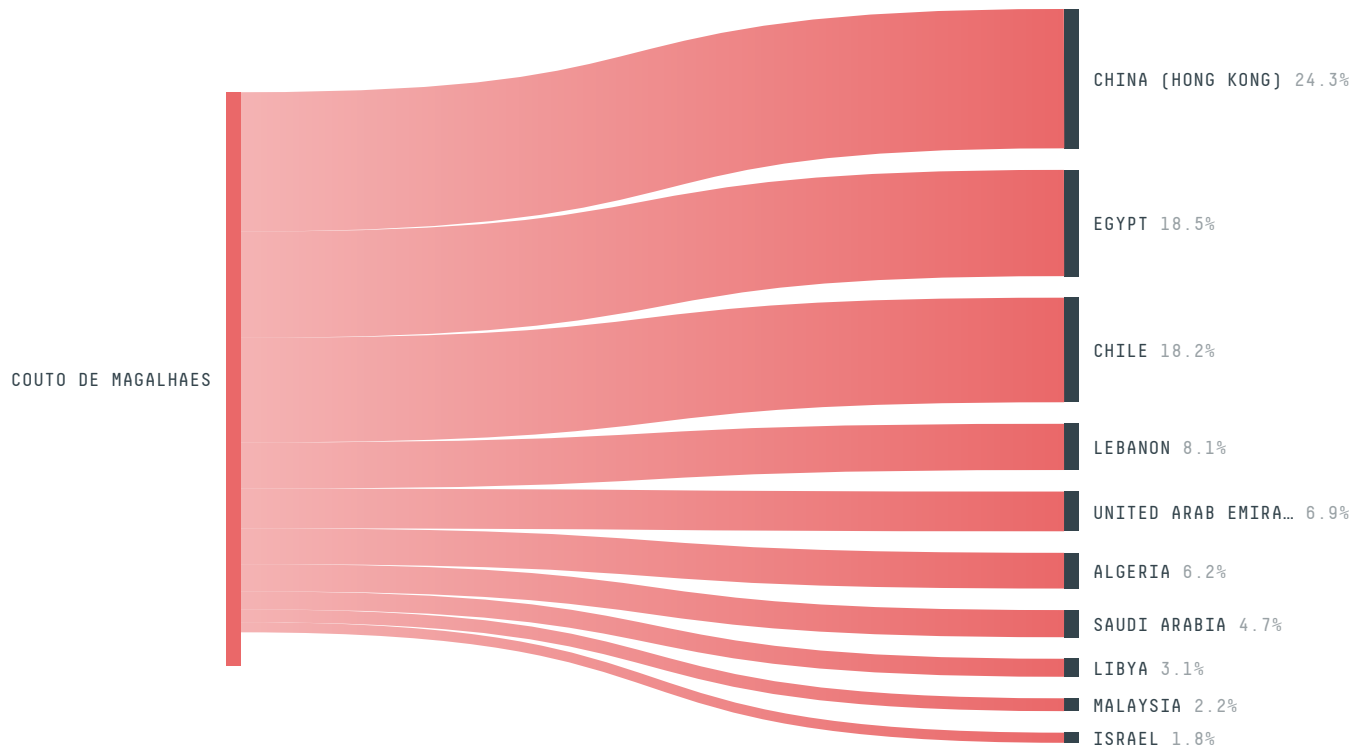
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF COUTO DE MAGALHAES
