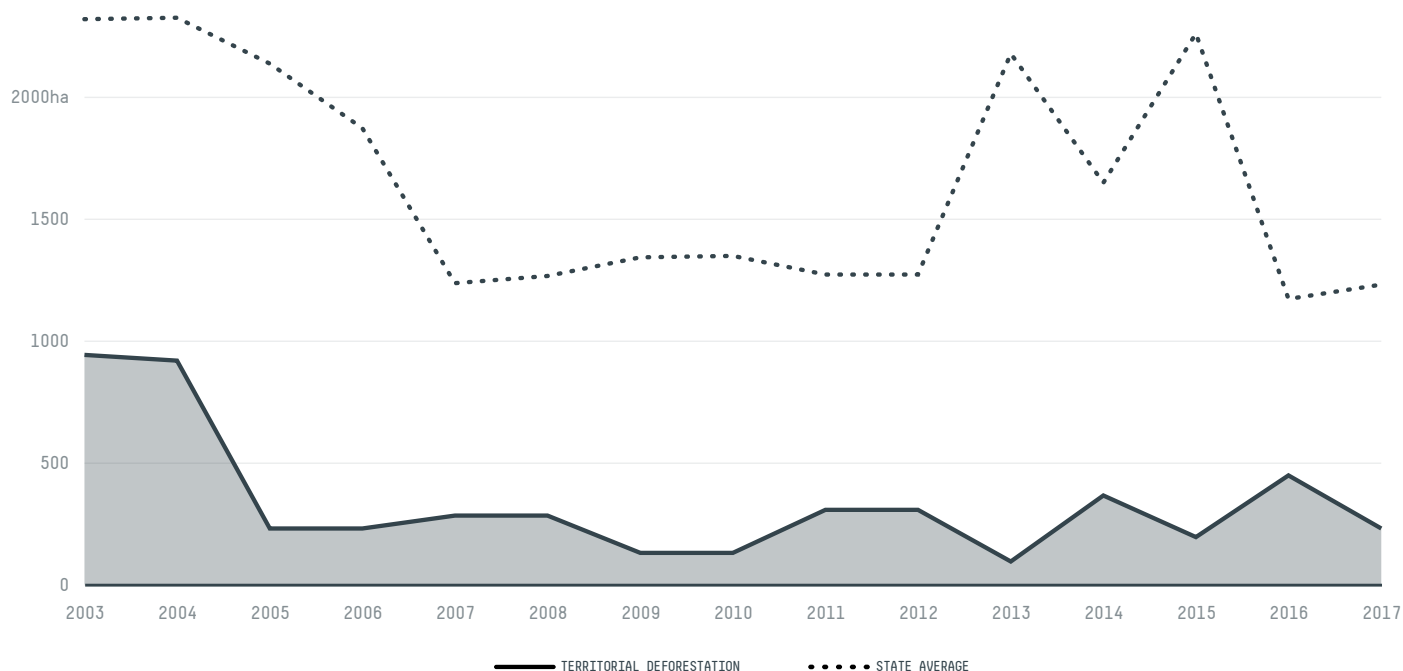

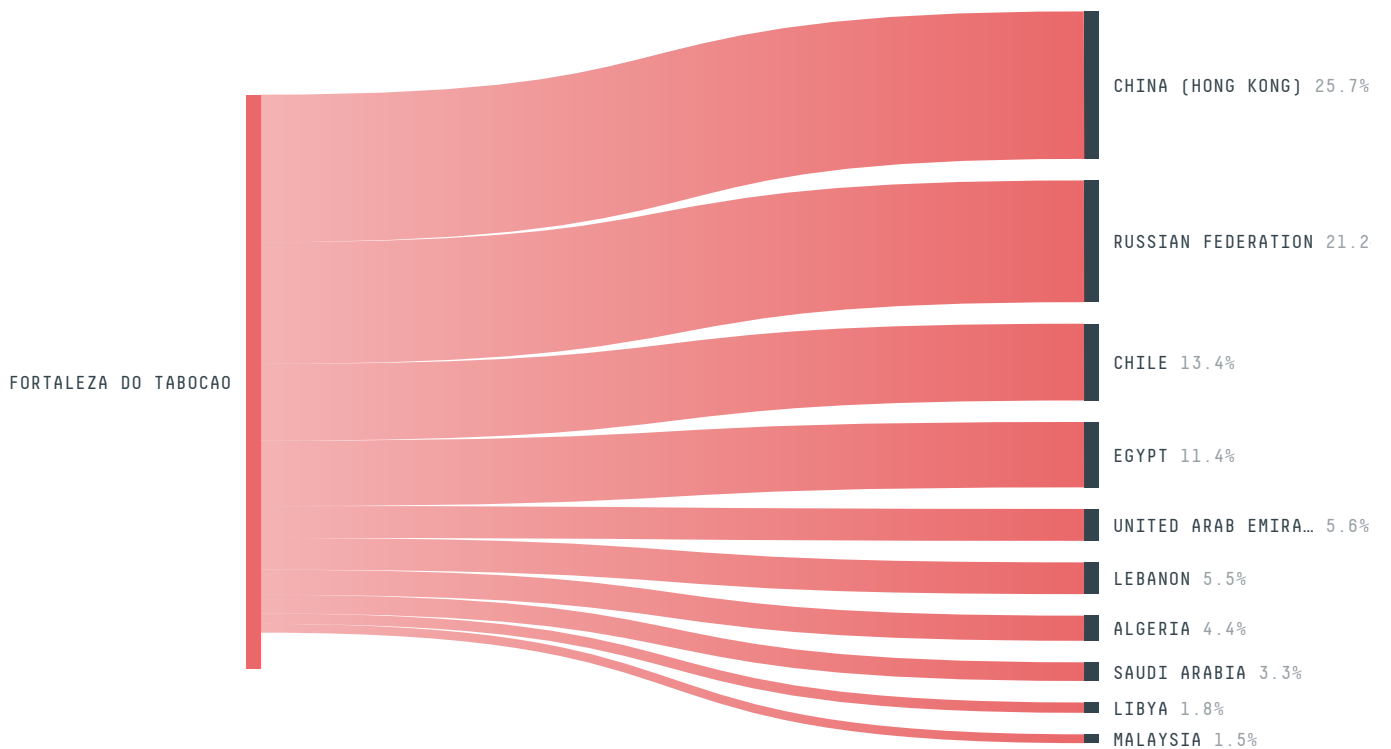
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF FORTALEZA DO TABOCAO
