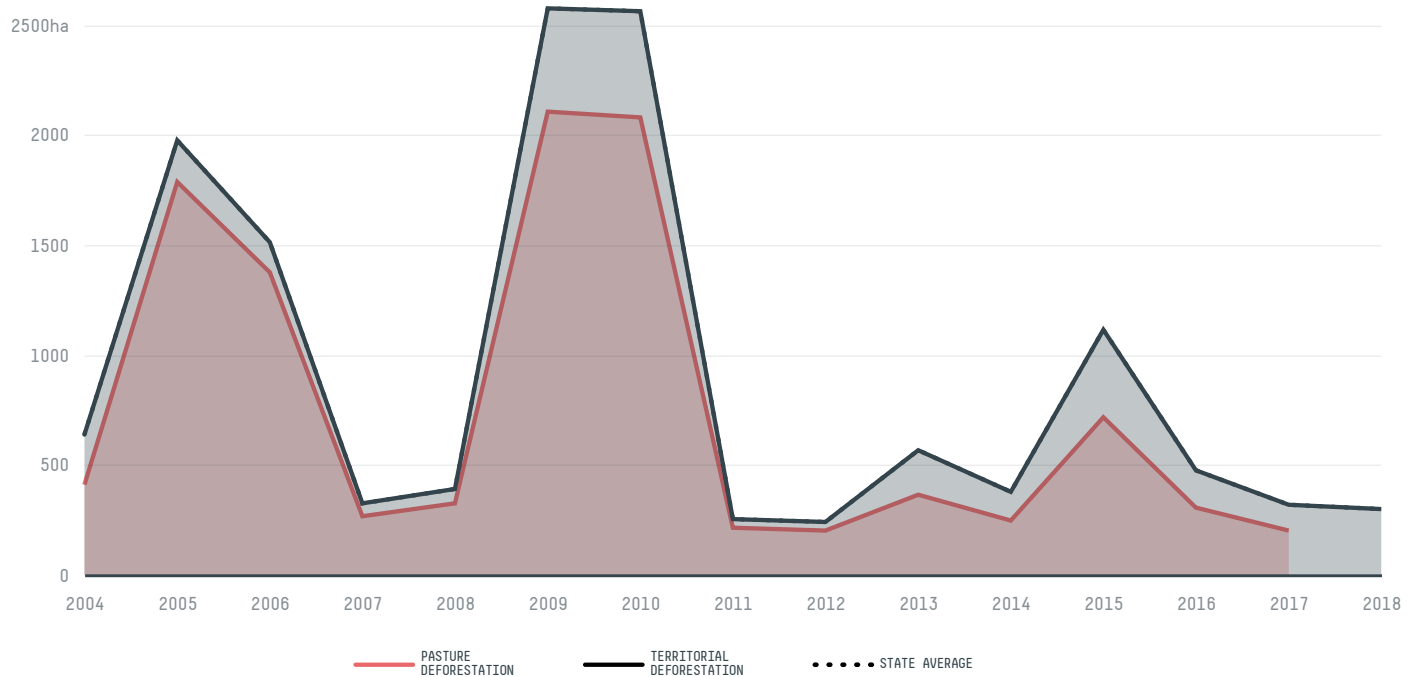

The largest exporter of beef in Pequizeiro was Minerva, which accounted for 49.2% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

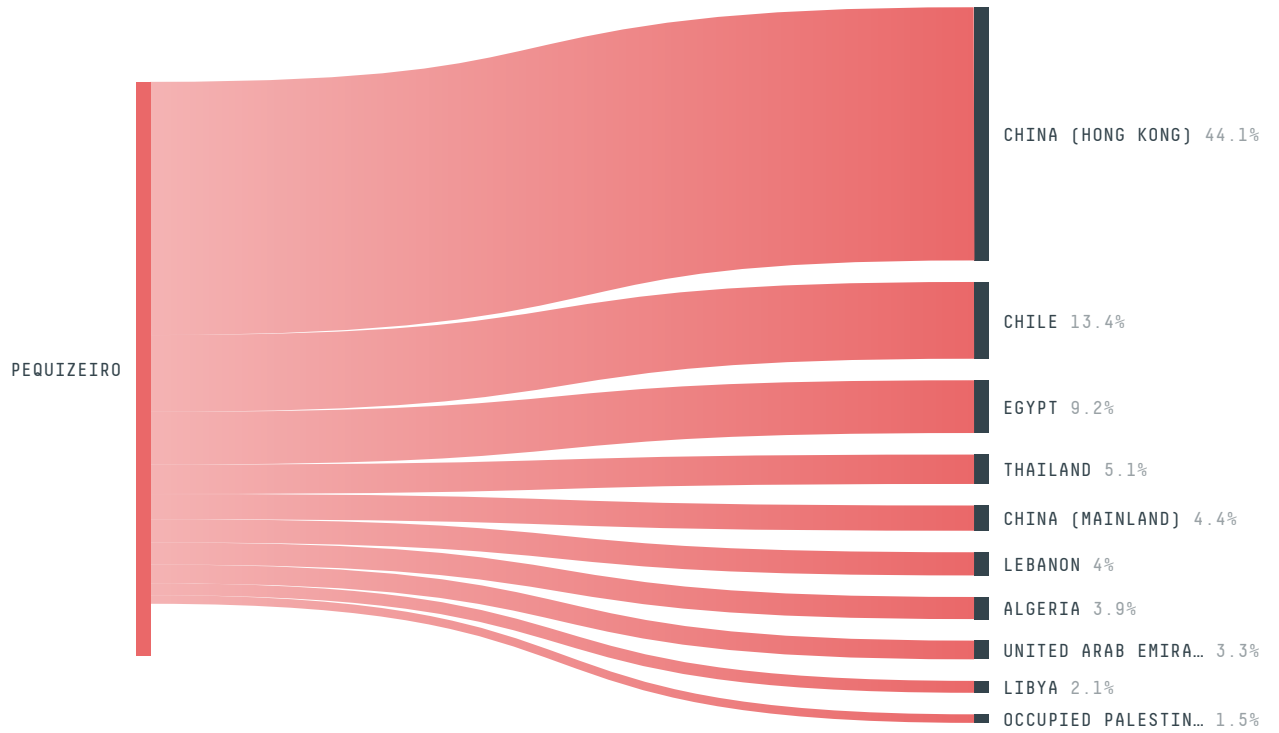

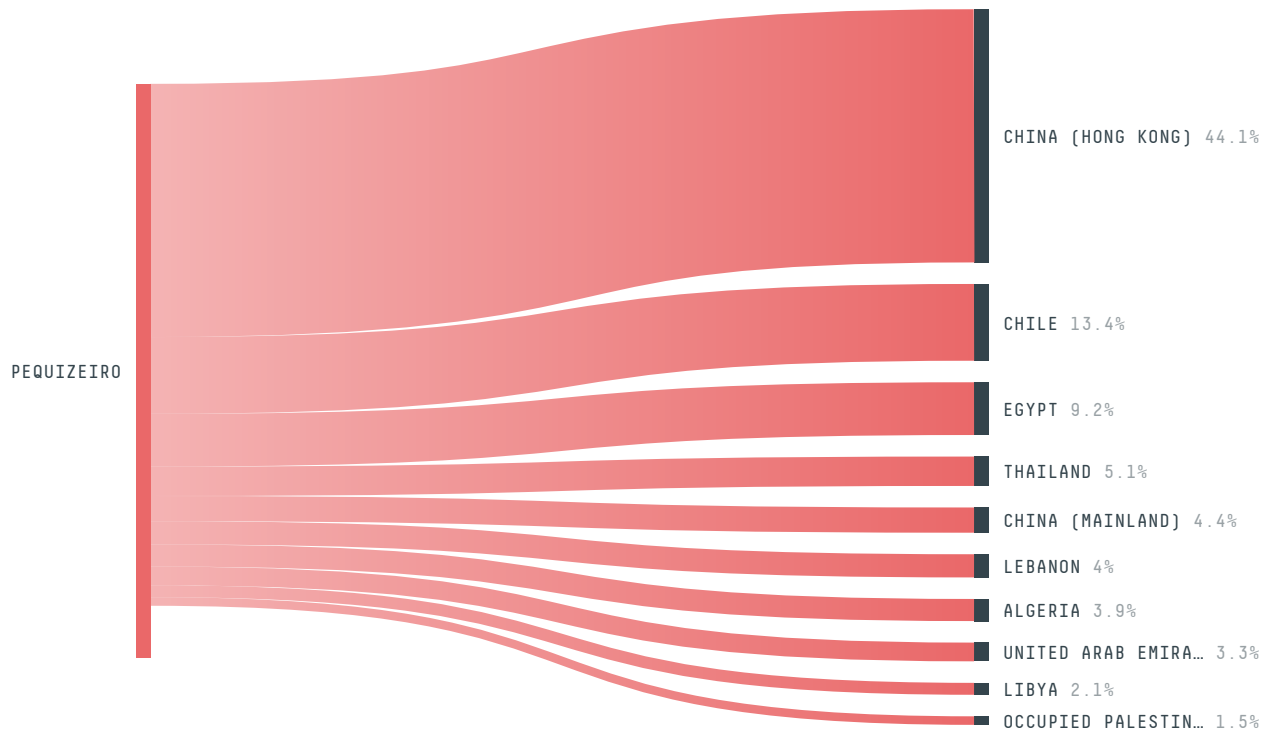
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF PEQUIZEIRO
