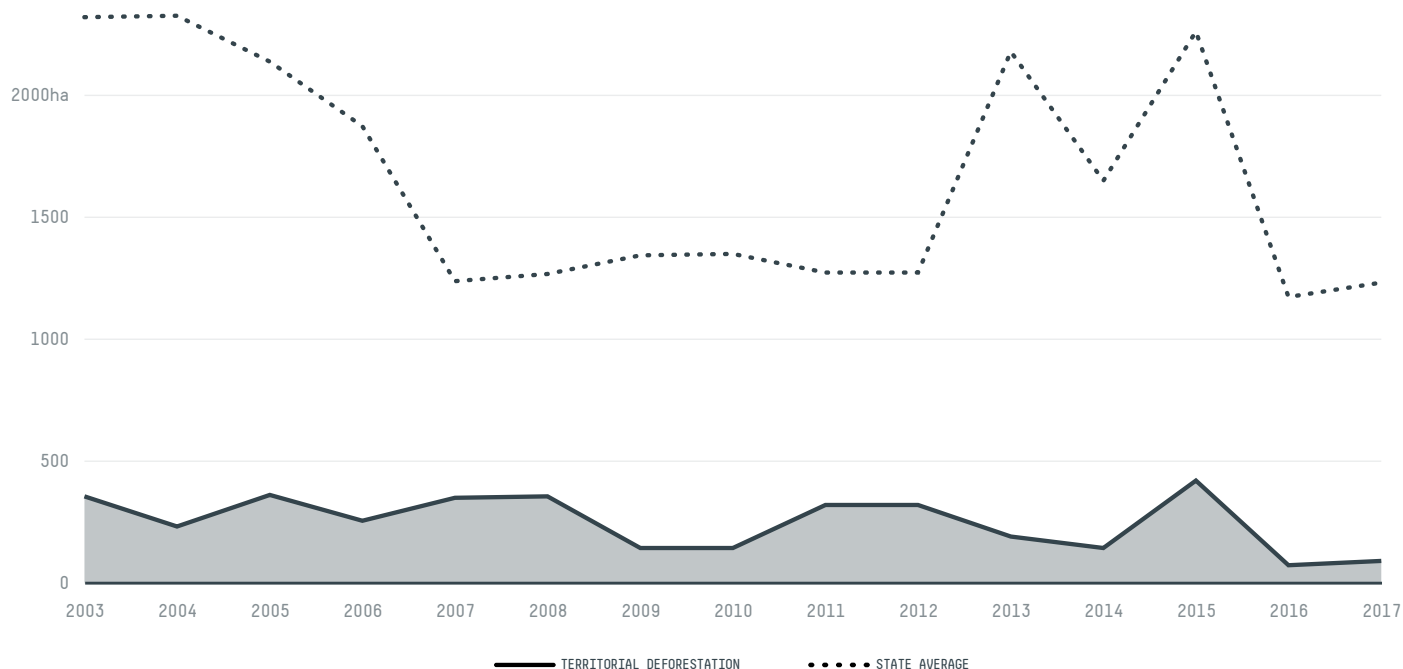

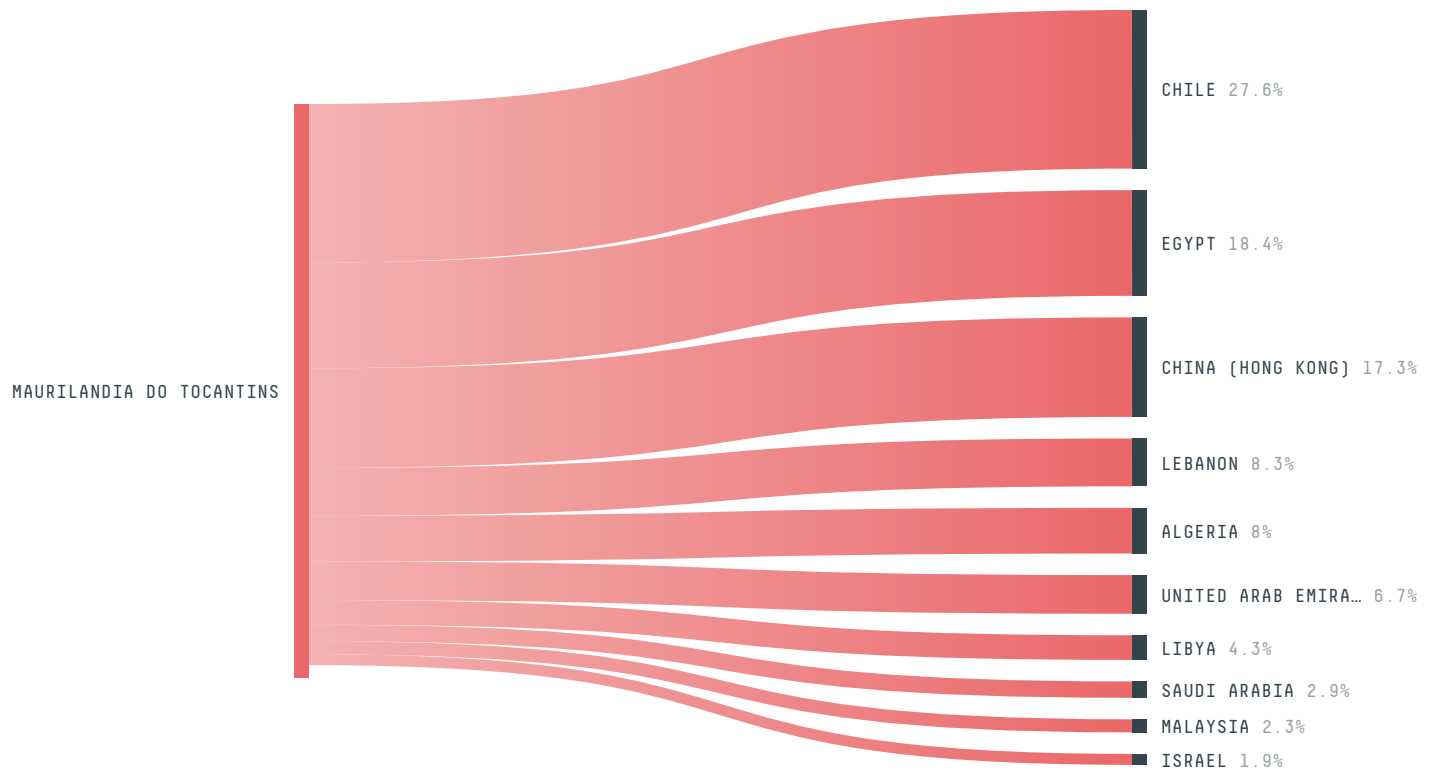
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MAURILANDIA DO TOCANTINS
