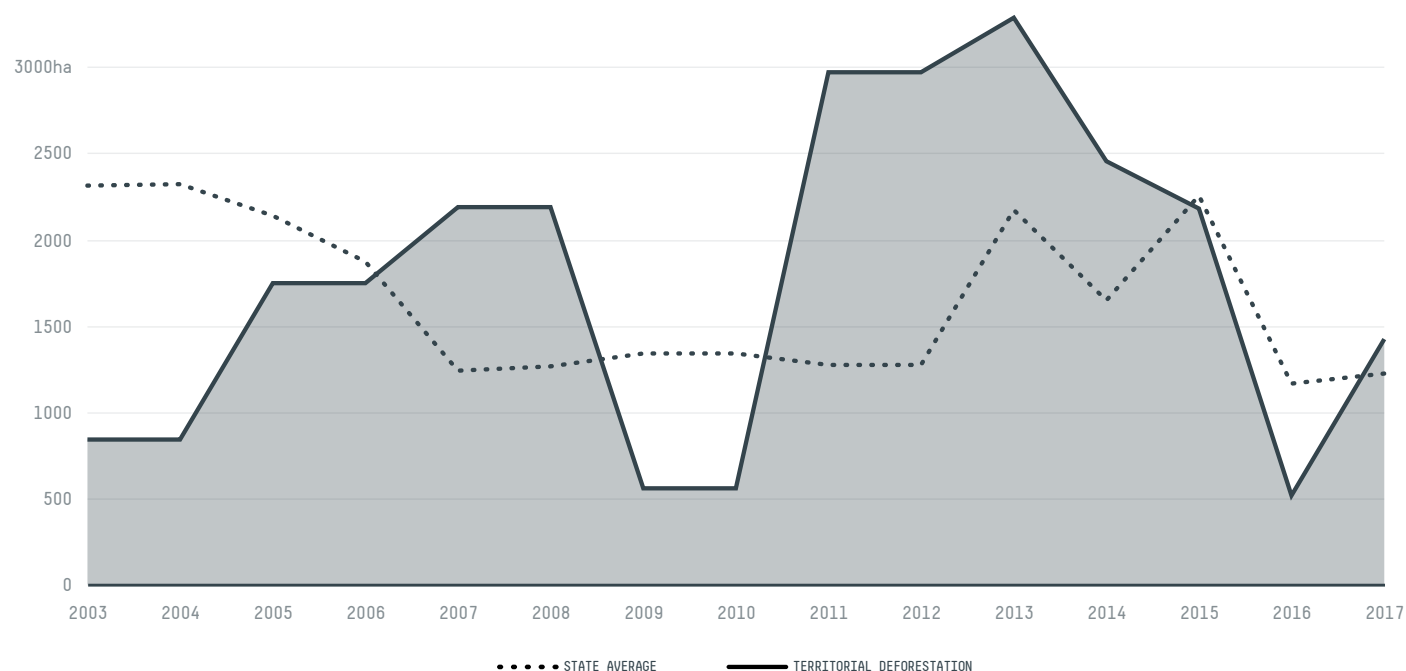

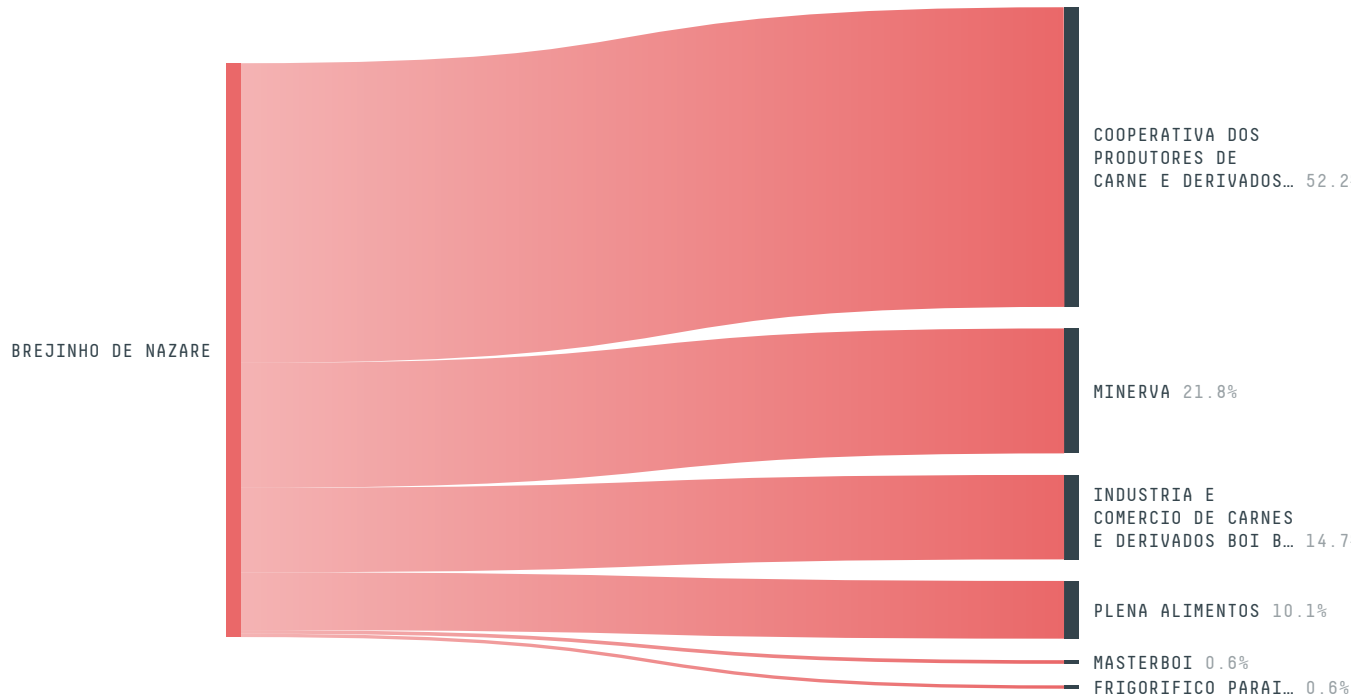

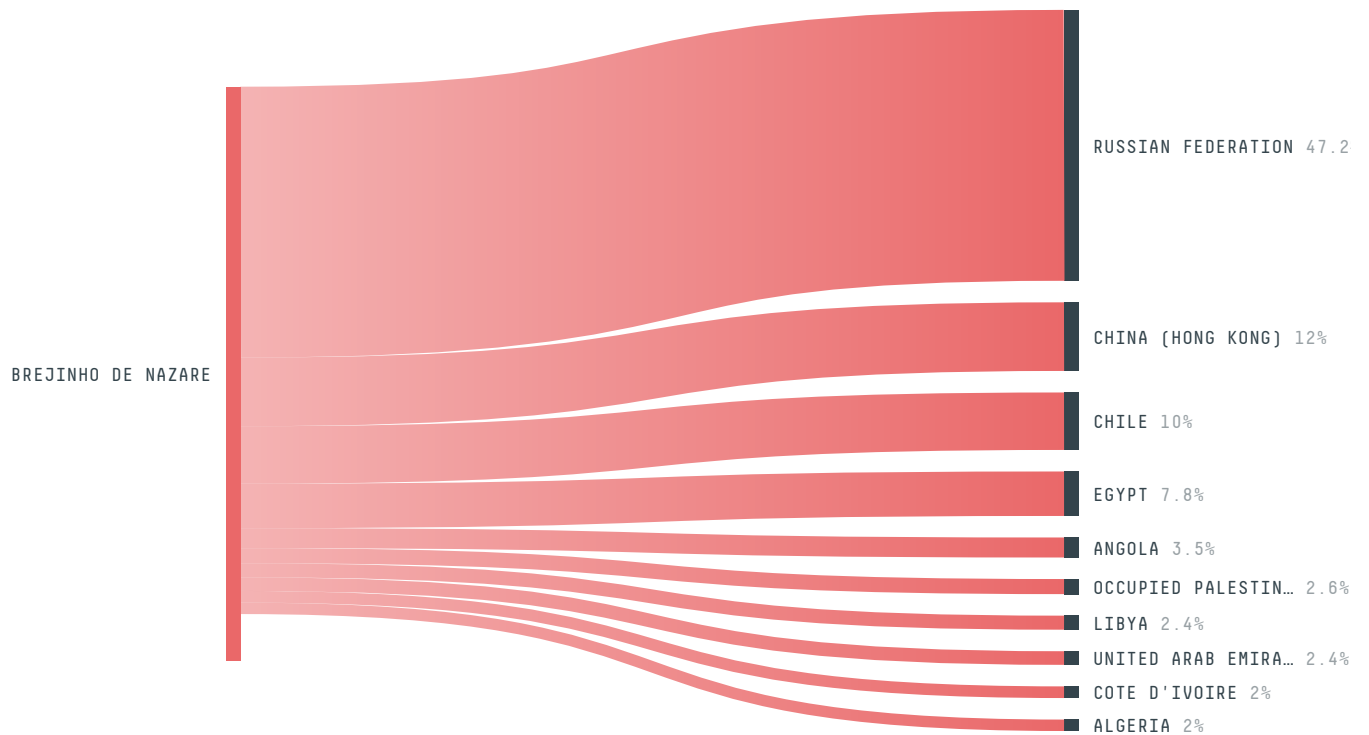
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BREJINHO DE NAZARE
