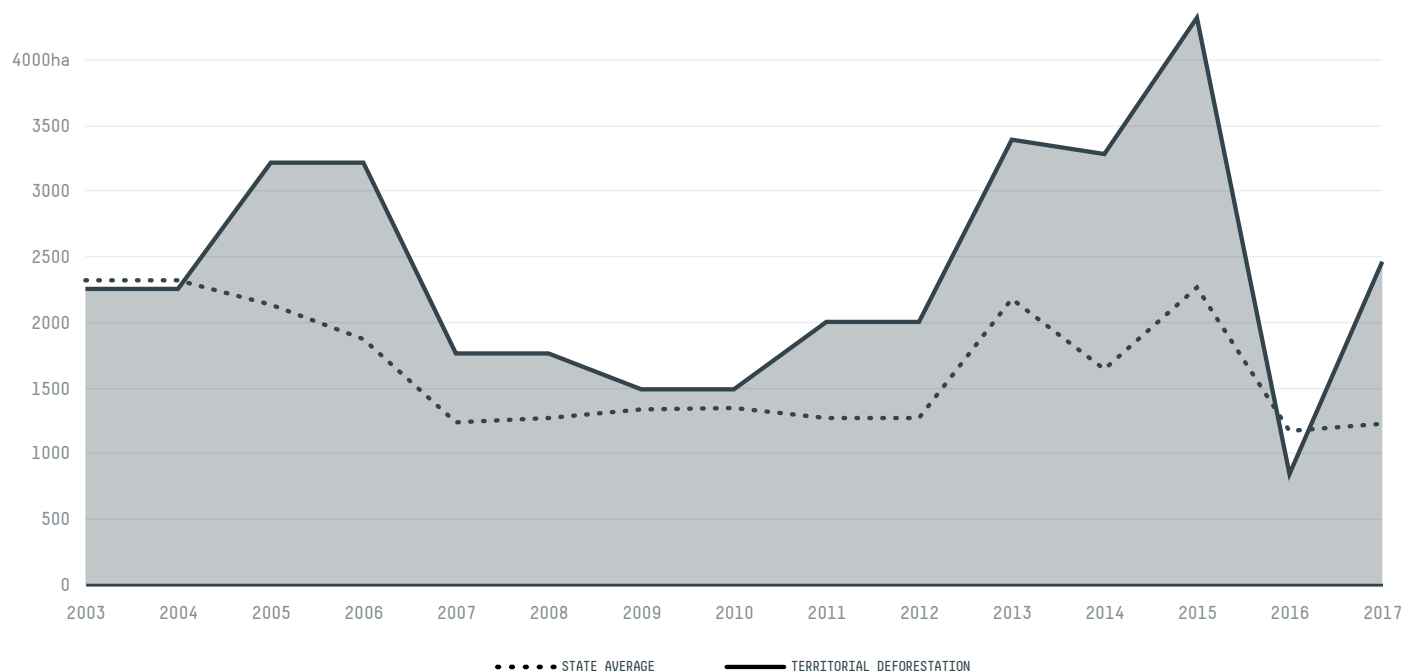

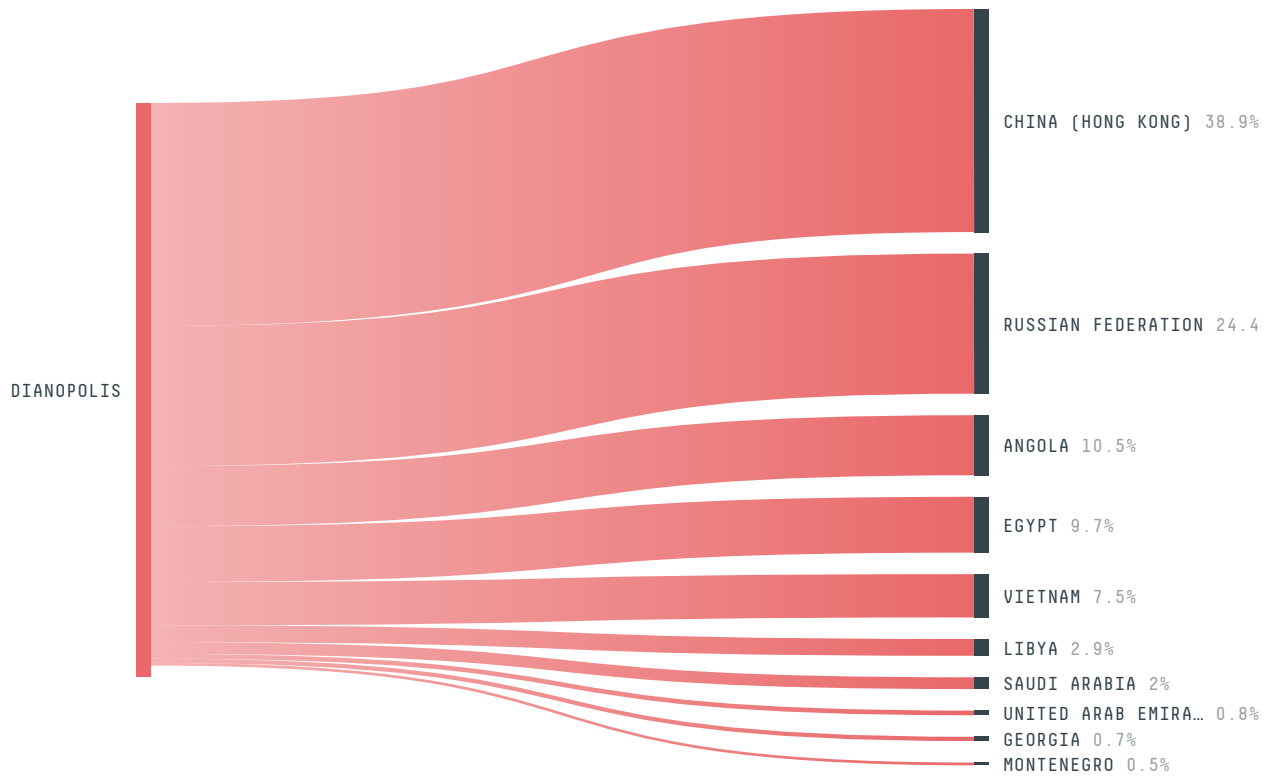
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF DIANOPOLIS
