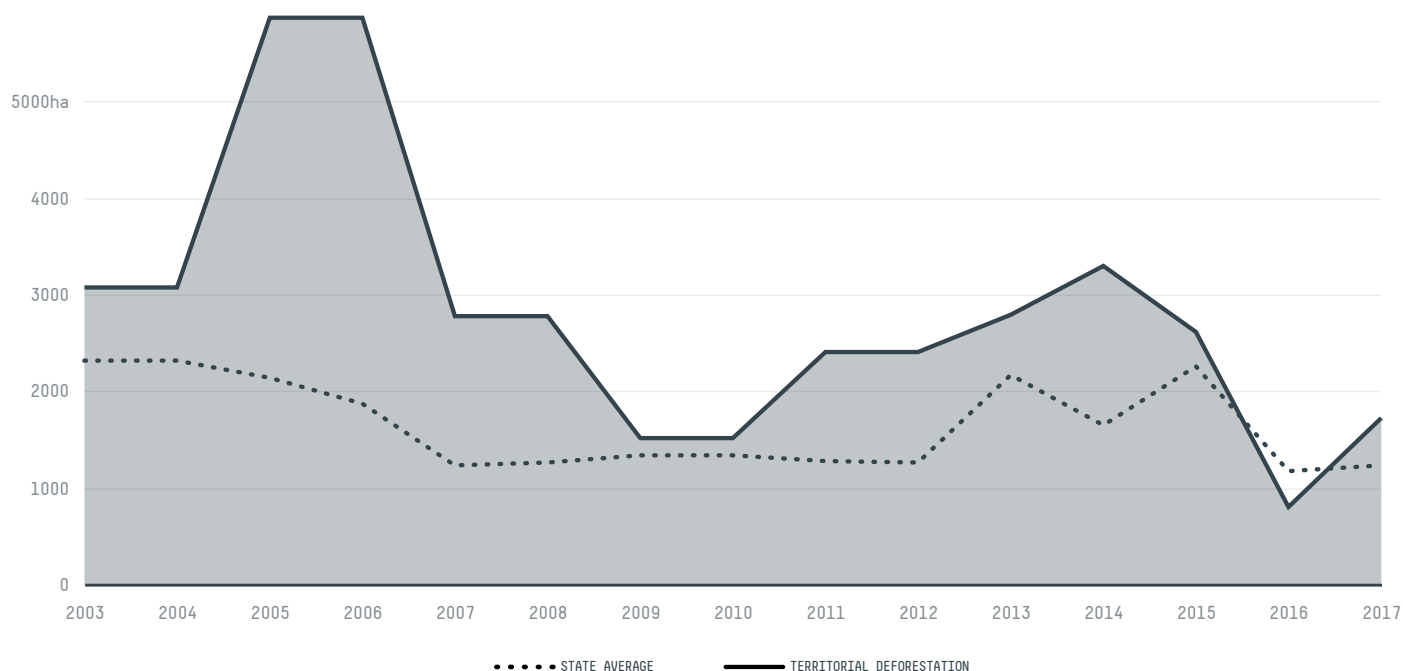

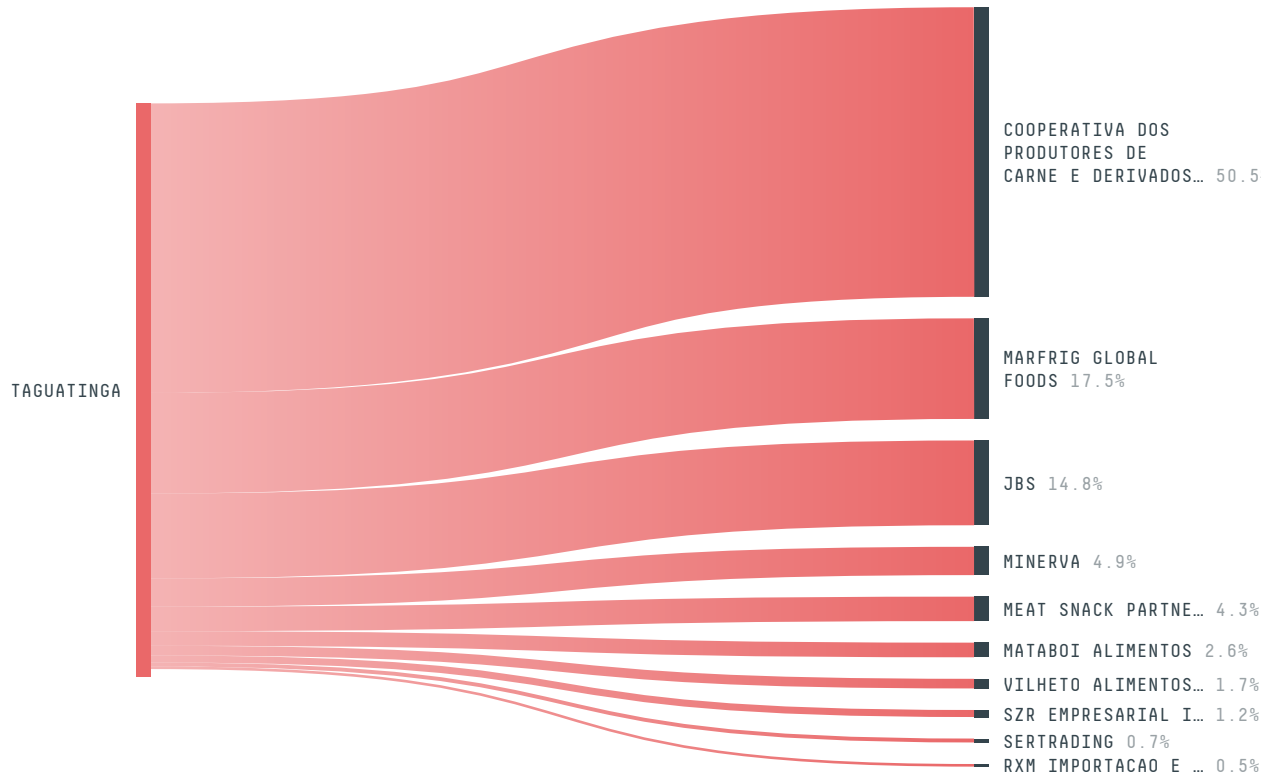

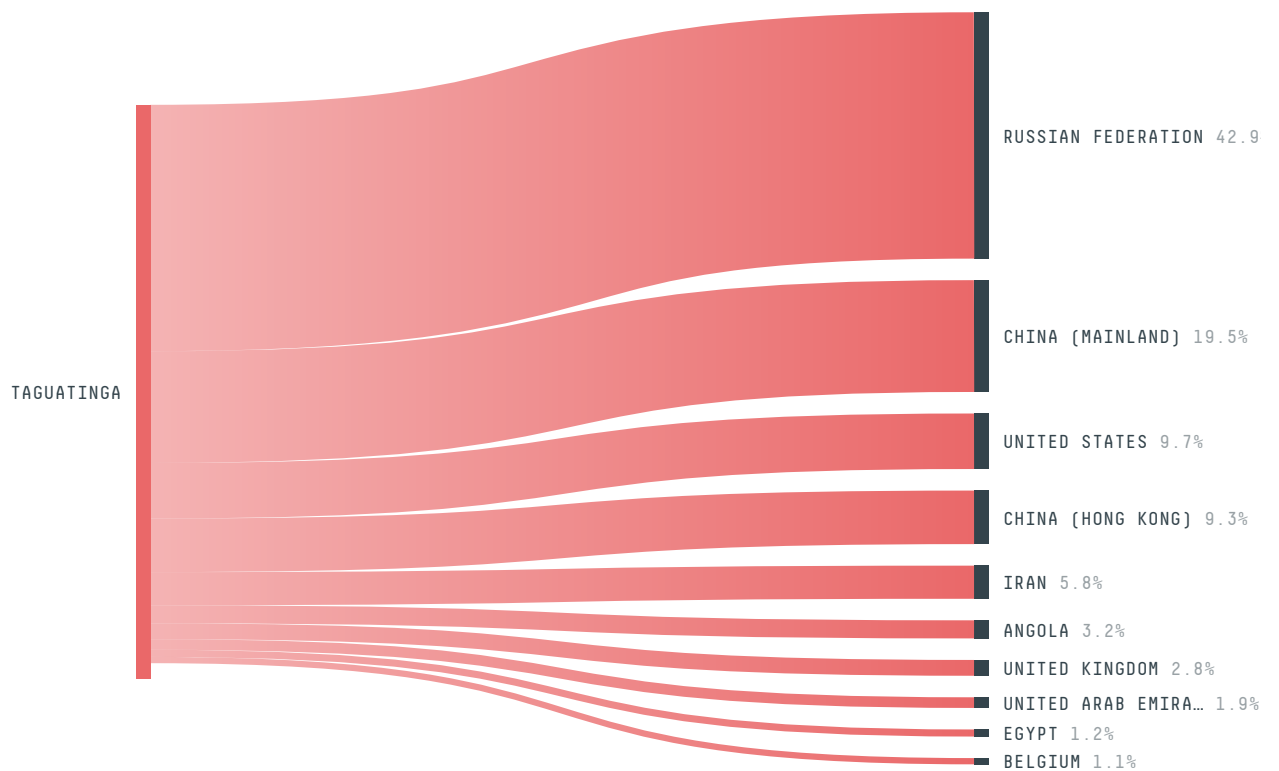
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TAGUATINGA
