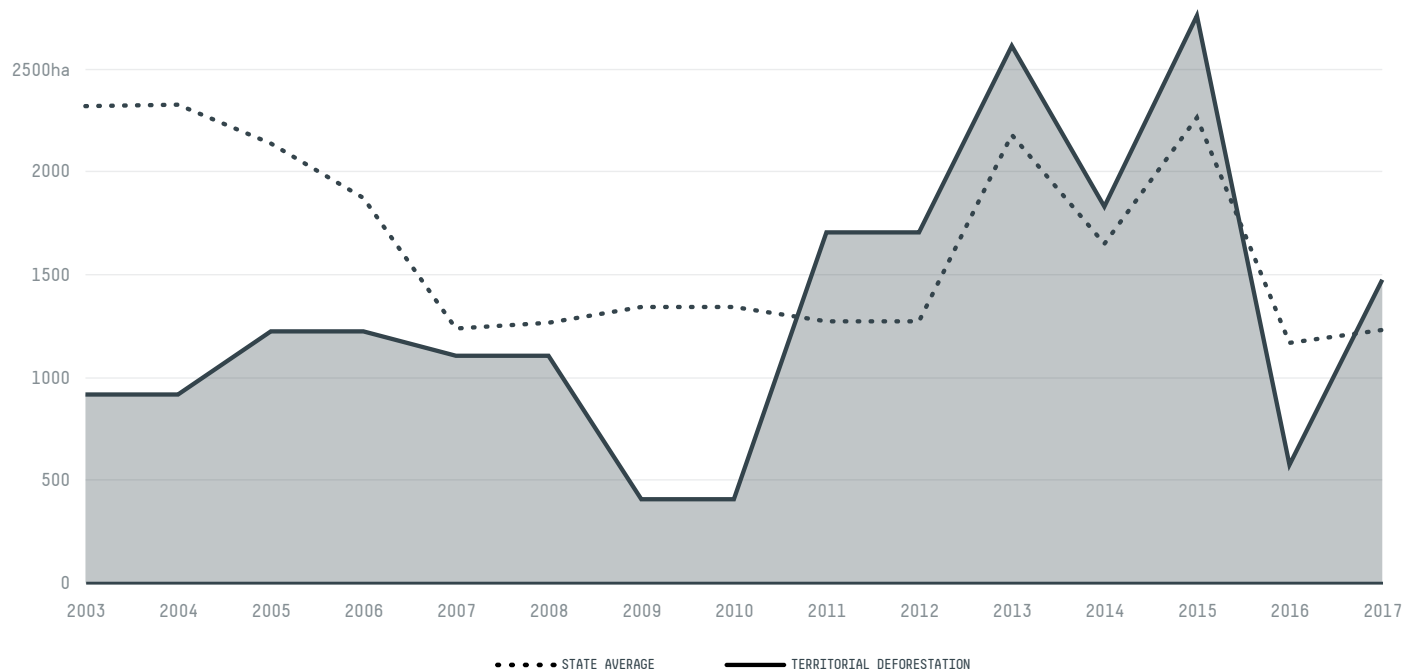
The largest exporter of beef in Silvanopolis was Minerva, which accounted for 50.2% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

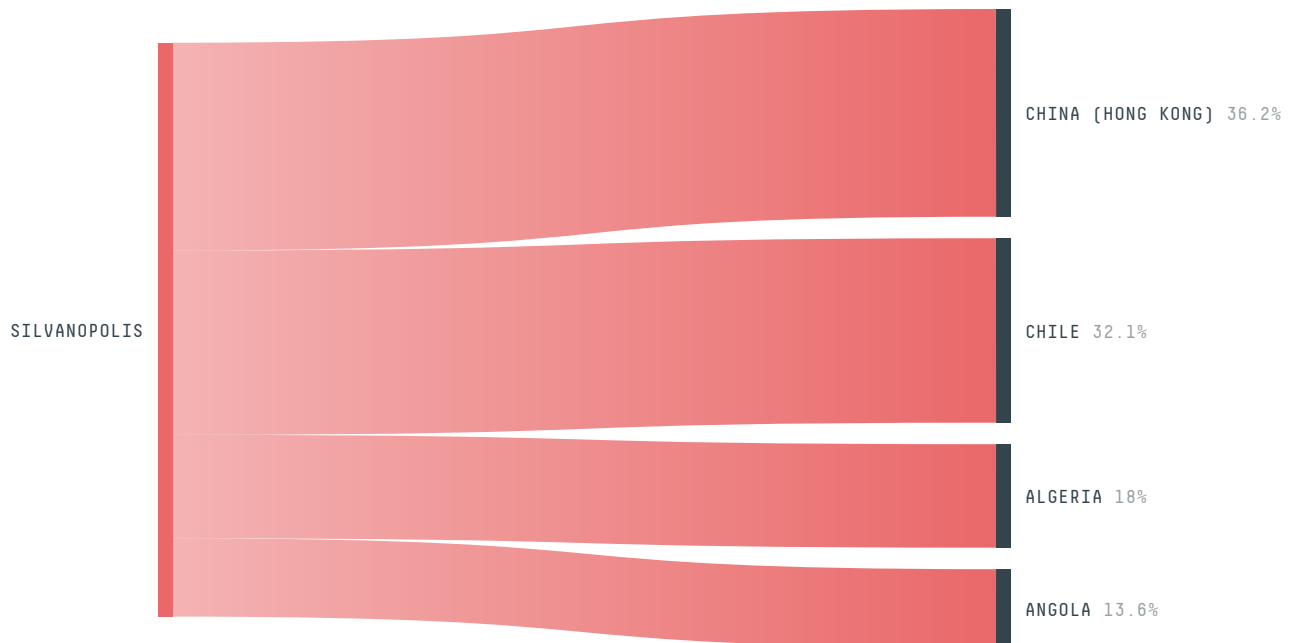
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SILVANOPOLIS
