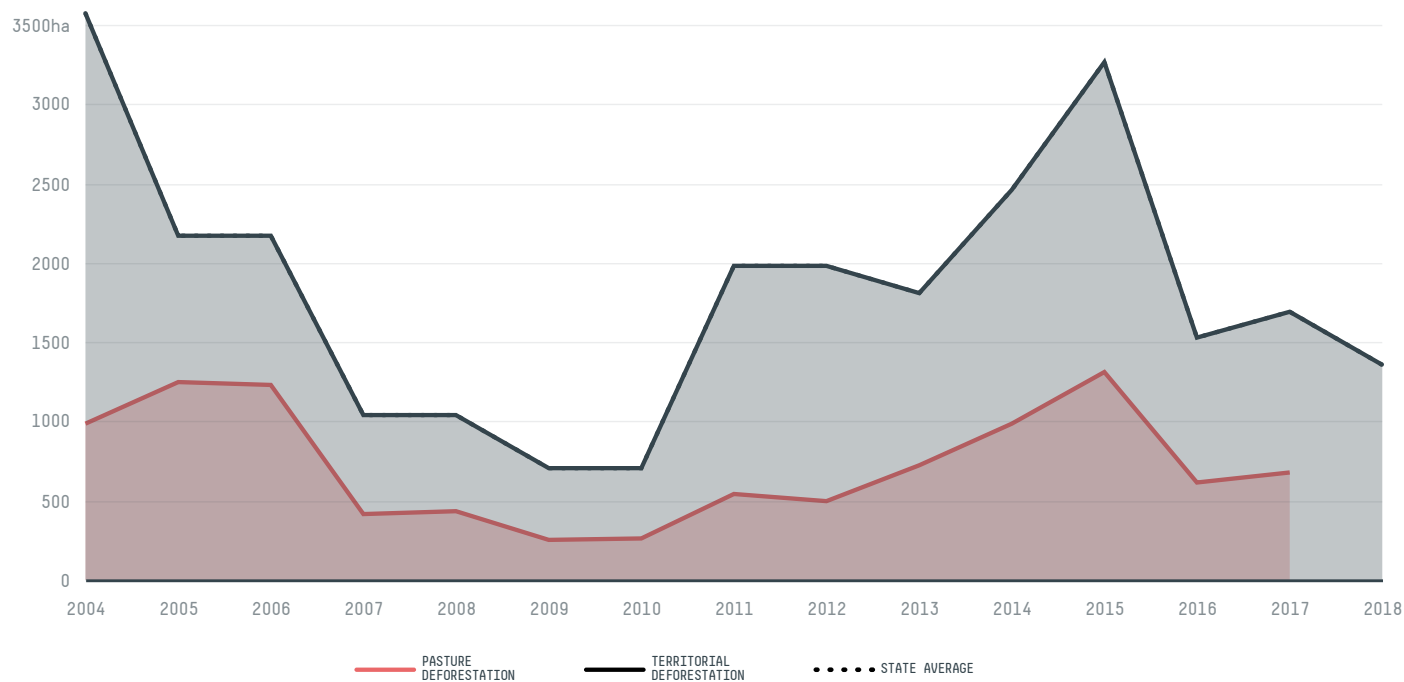

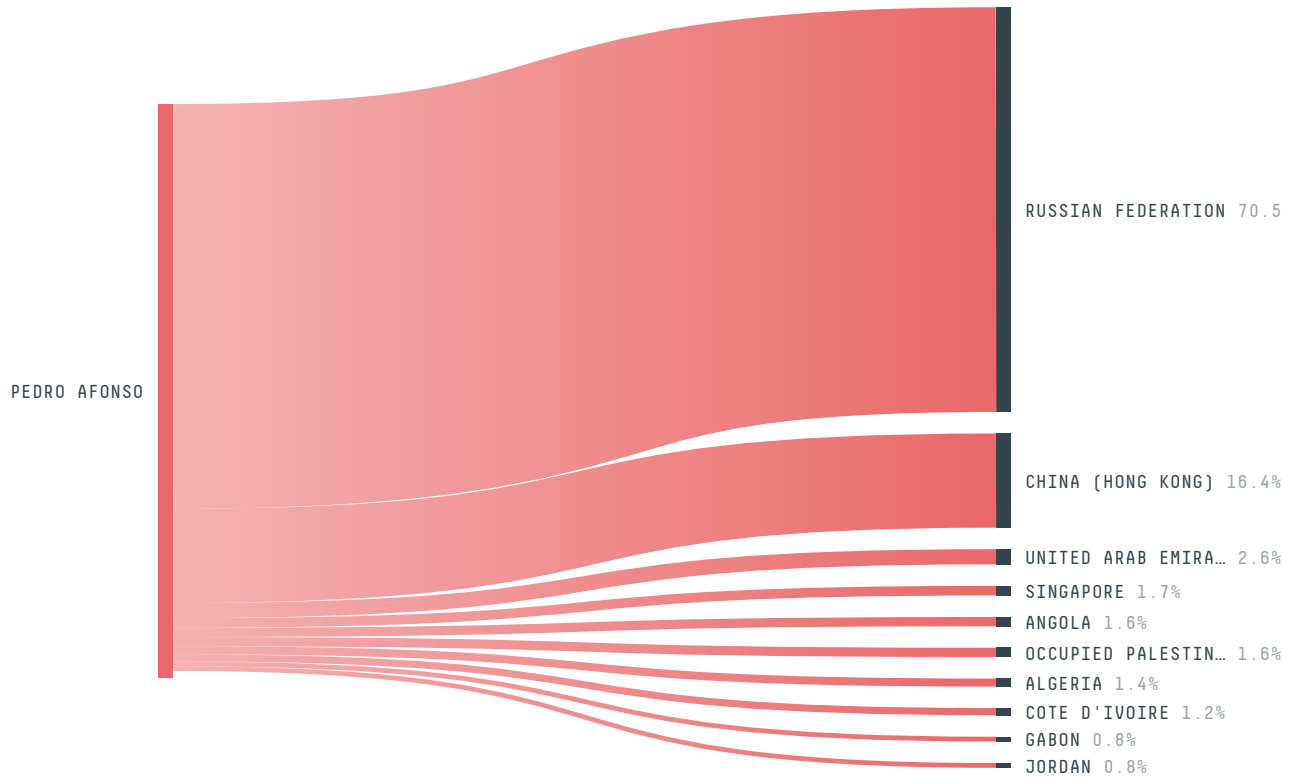

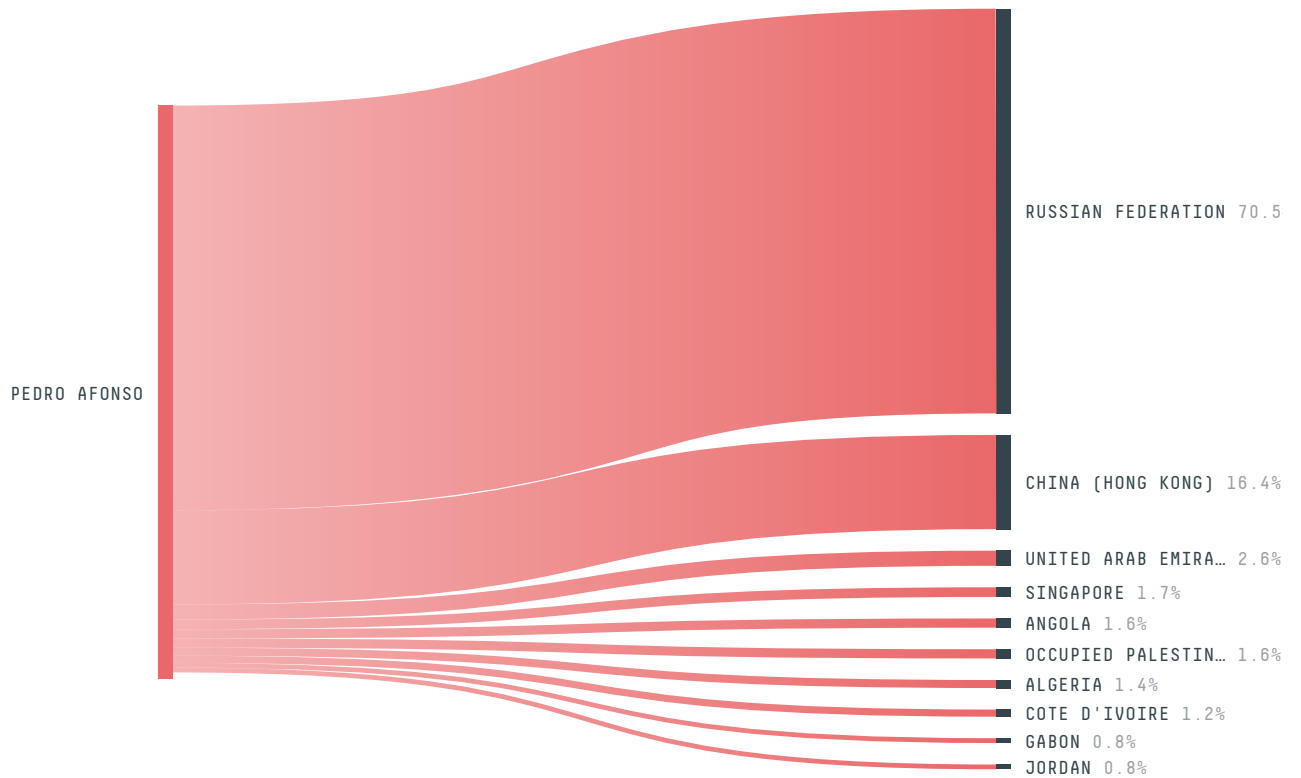
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF PEDRO AFONSO
