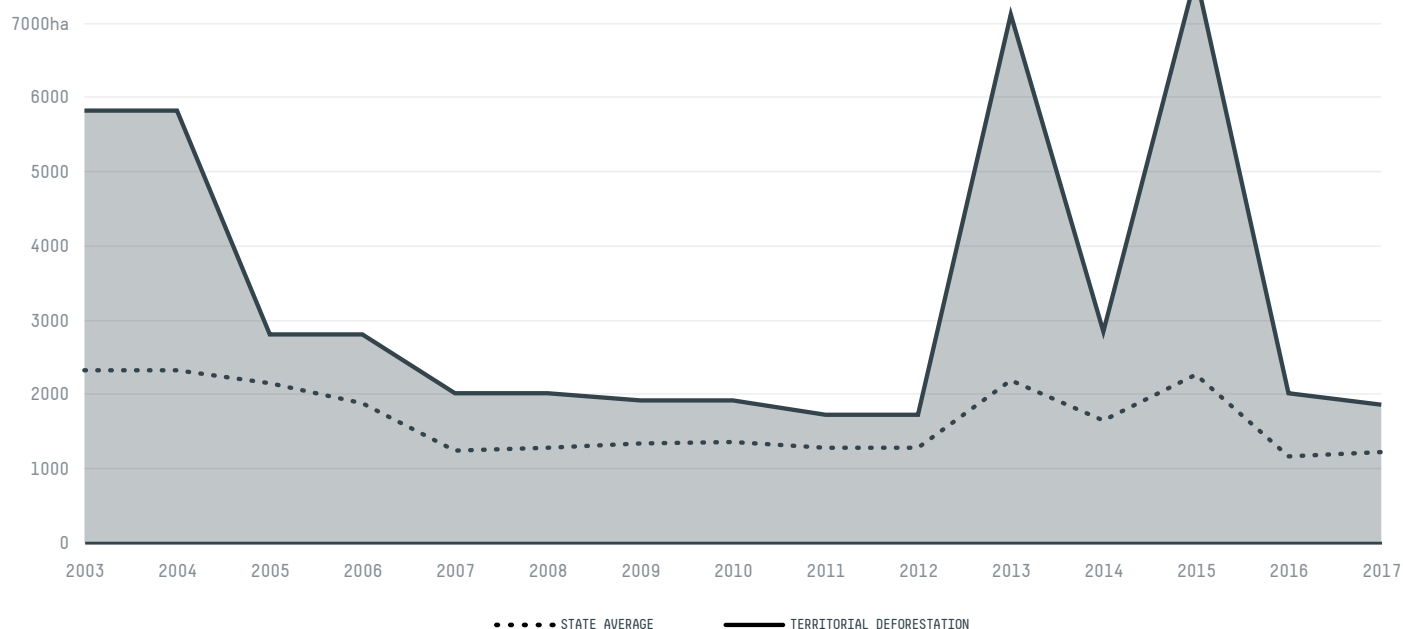

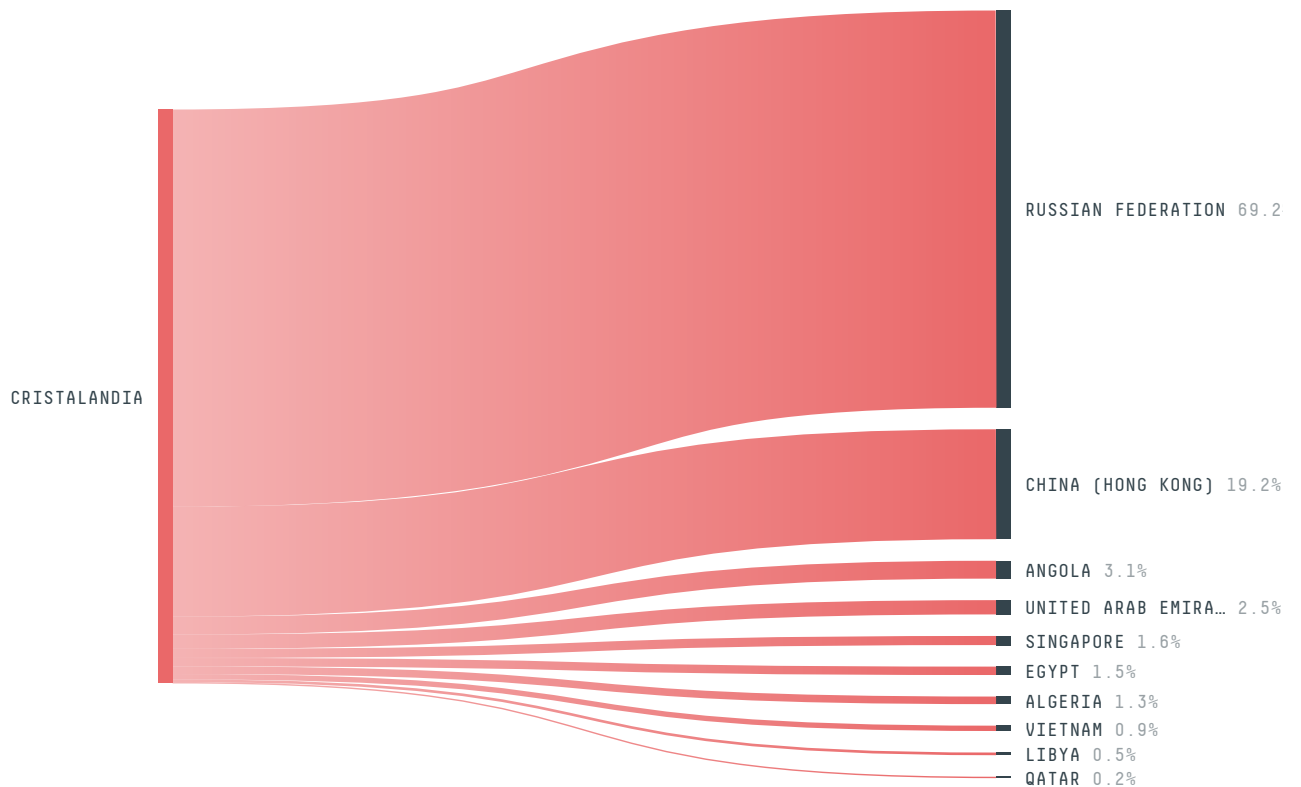
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CRISTALANDIA
