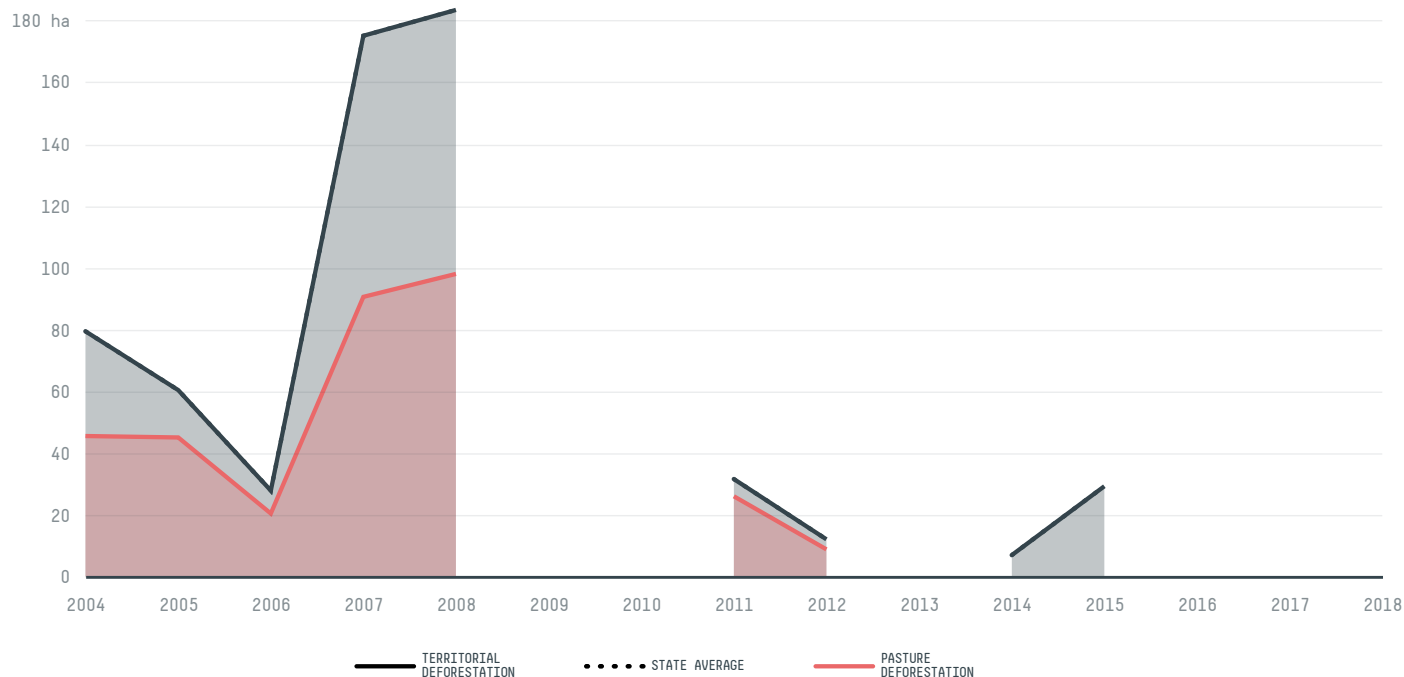

The largest exporter of beef in Carmolandia was Minerva, which accounted for 86.7% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

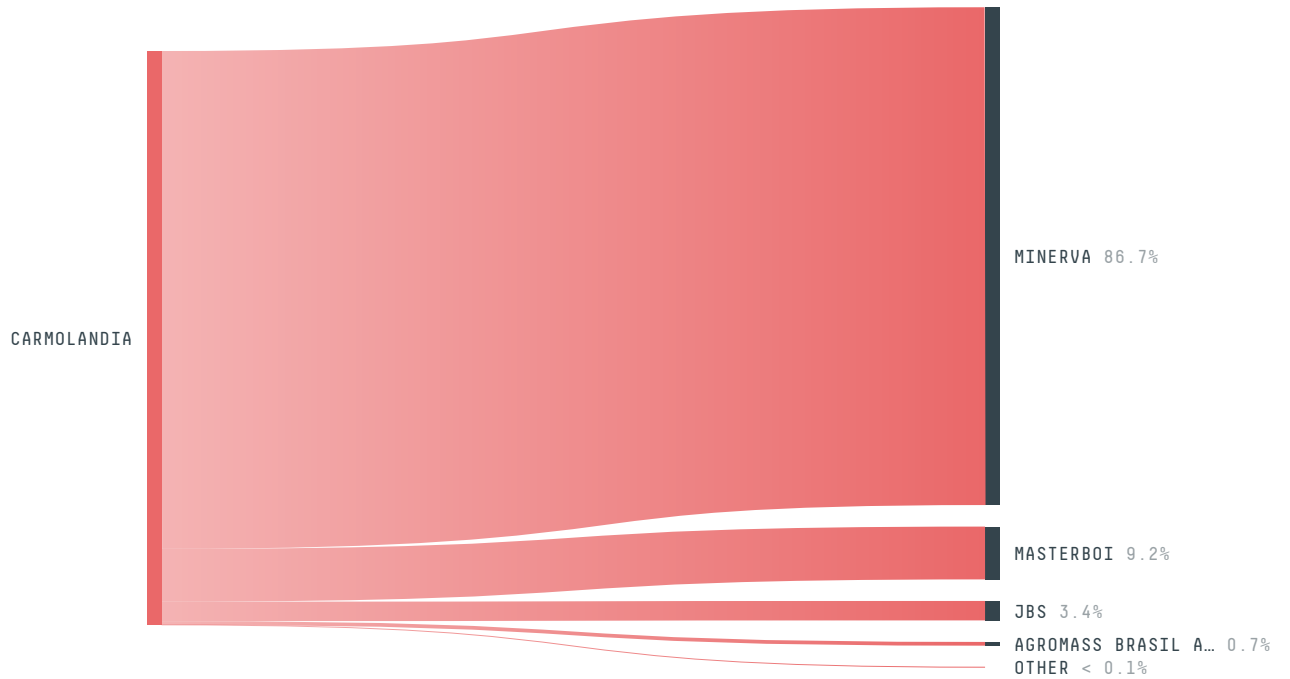

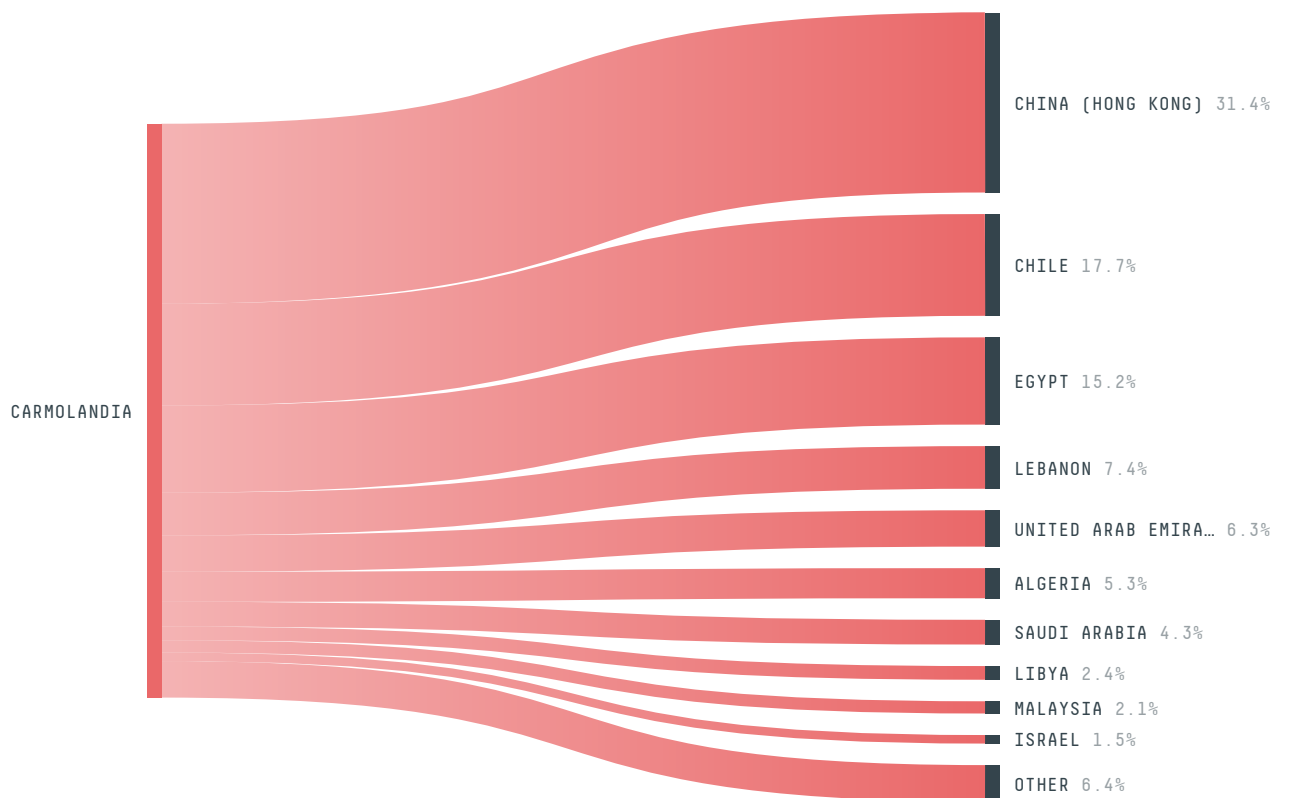
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CARMOLANDIA
