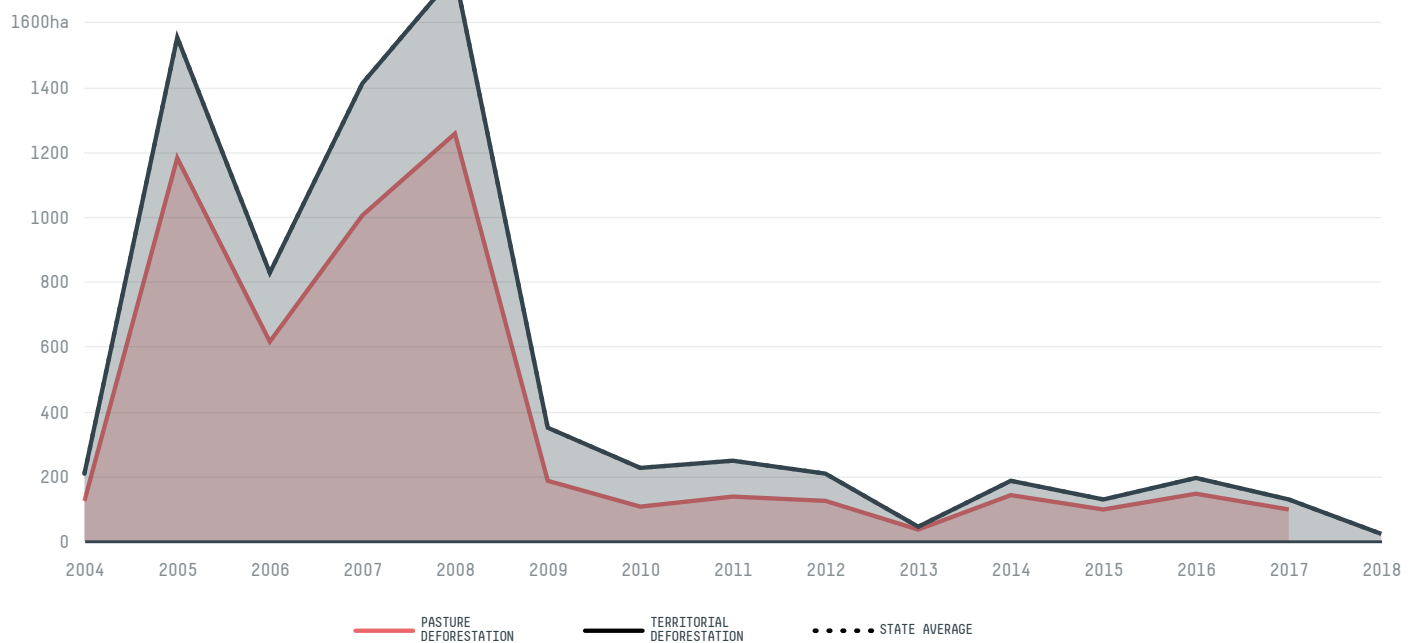

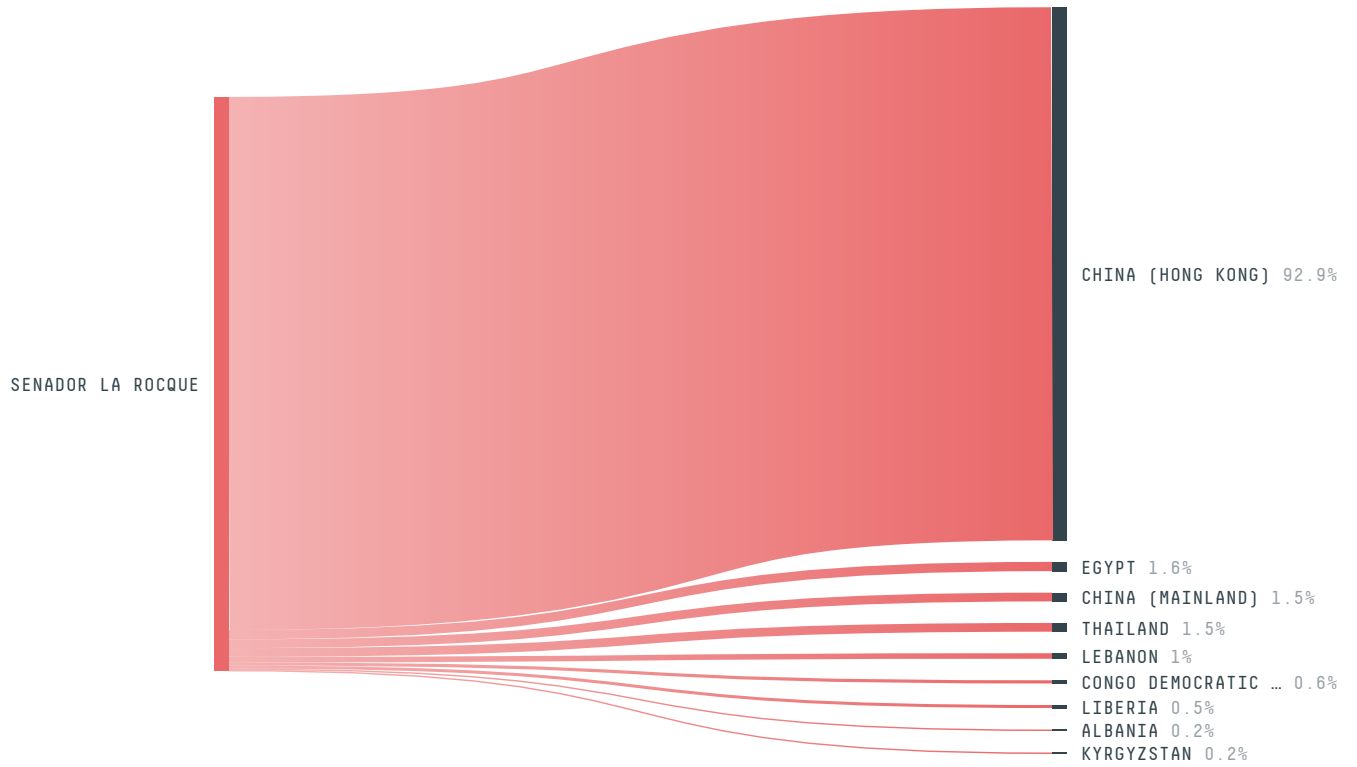

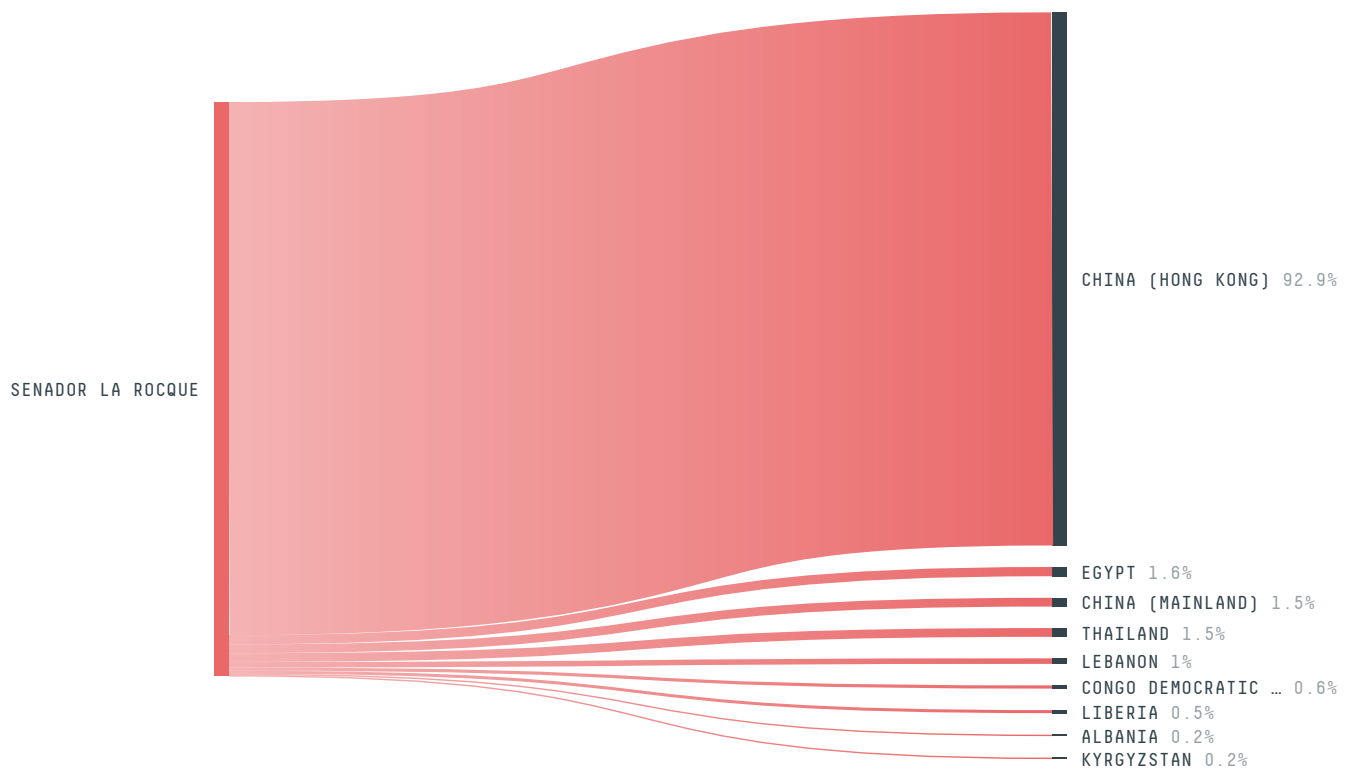
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SENADOR LA ROCQUE
