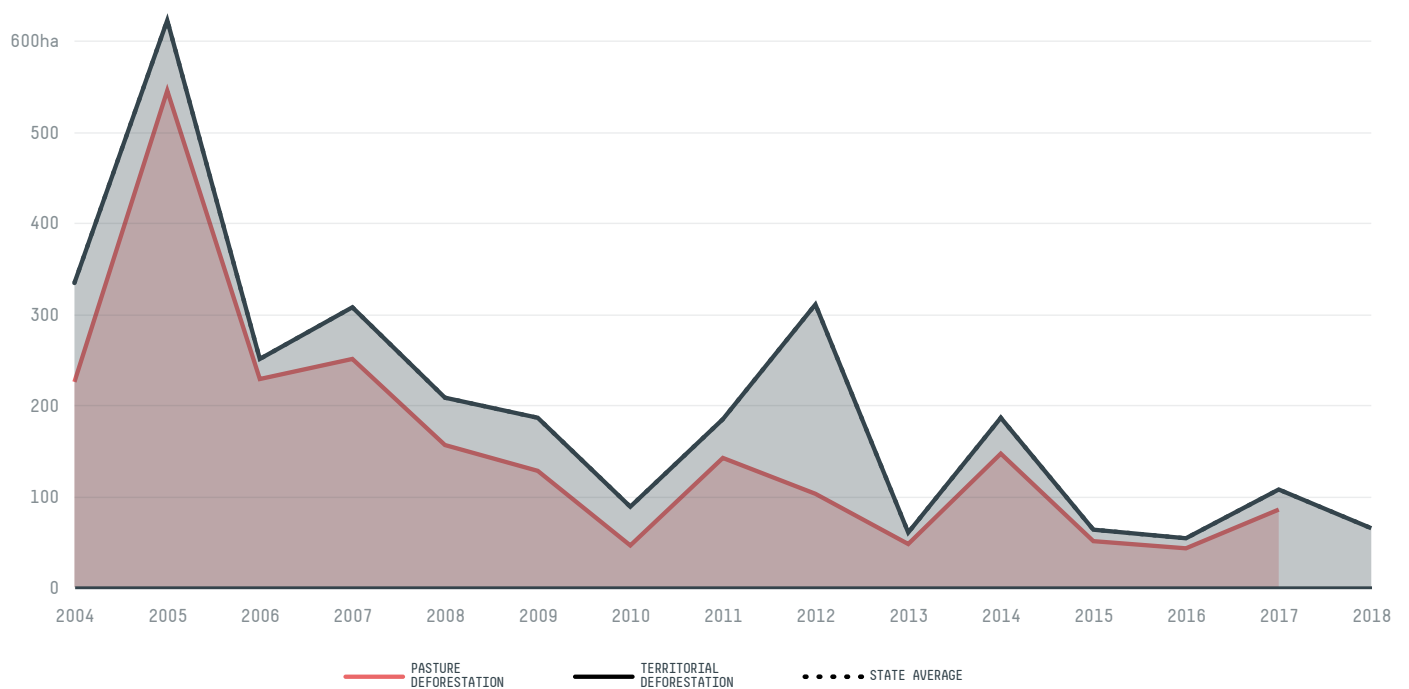

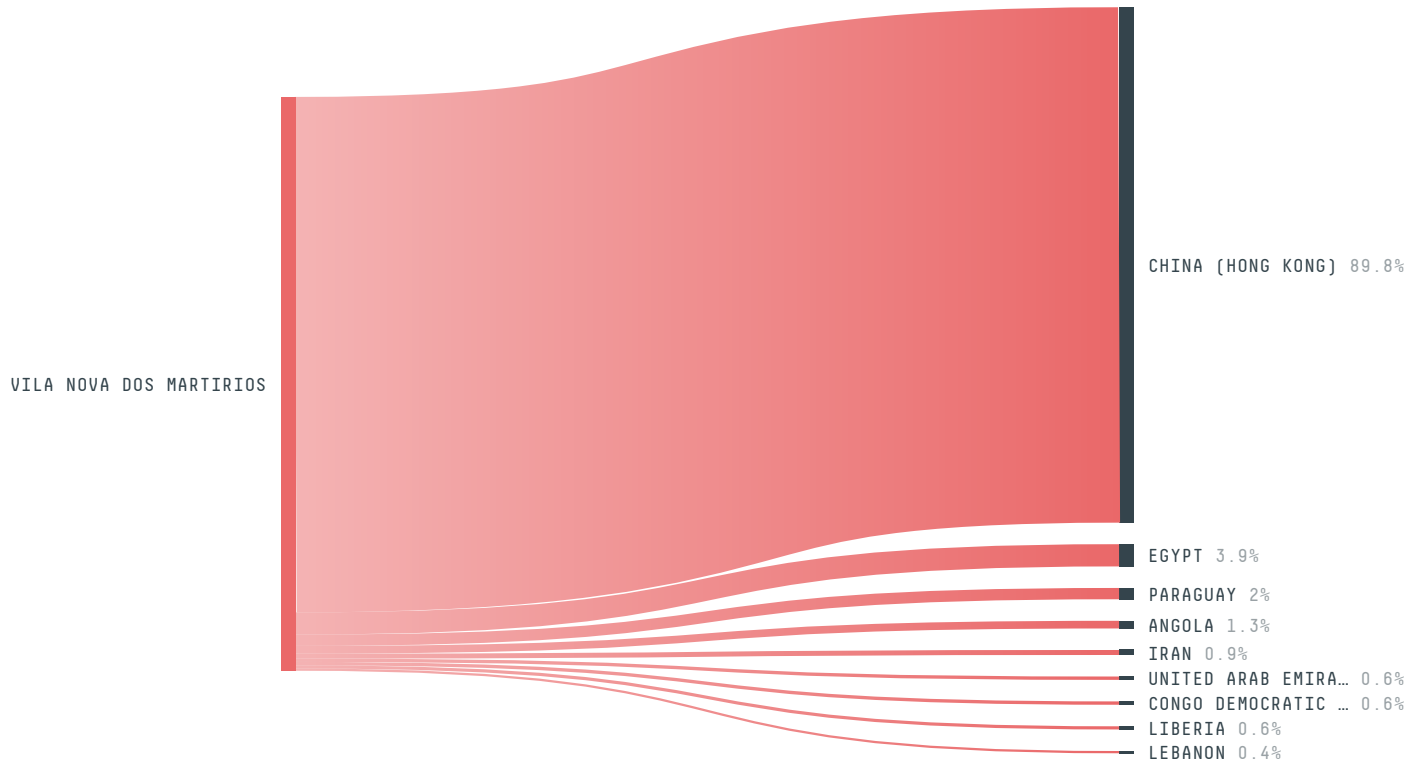

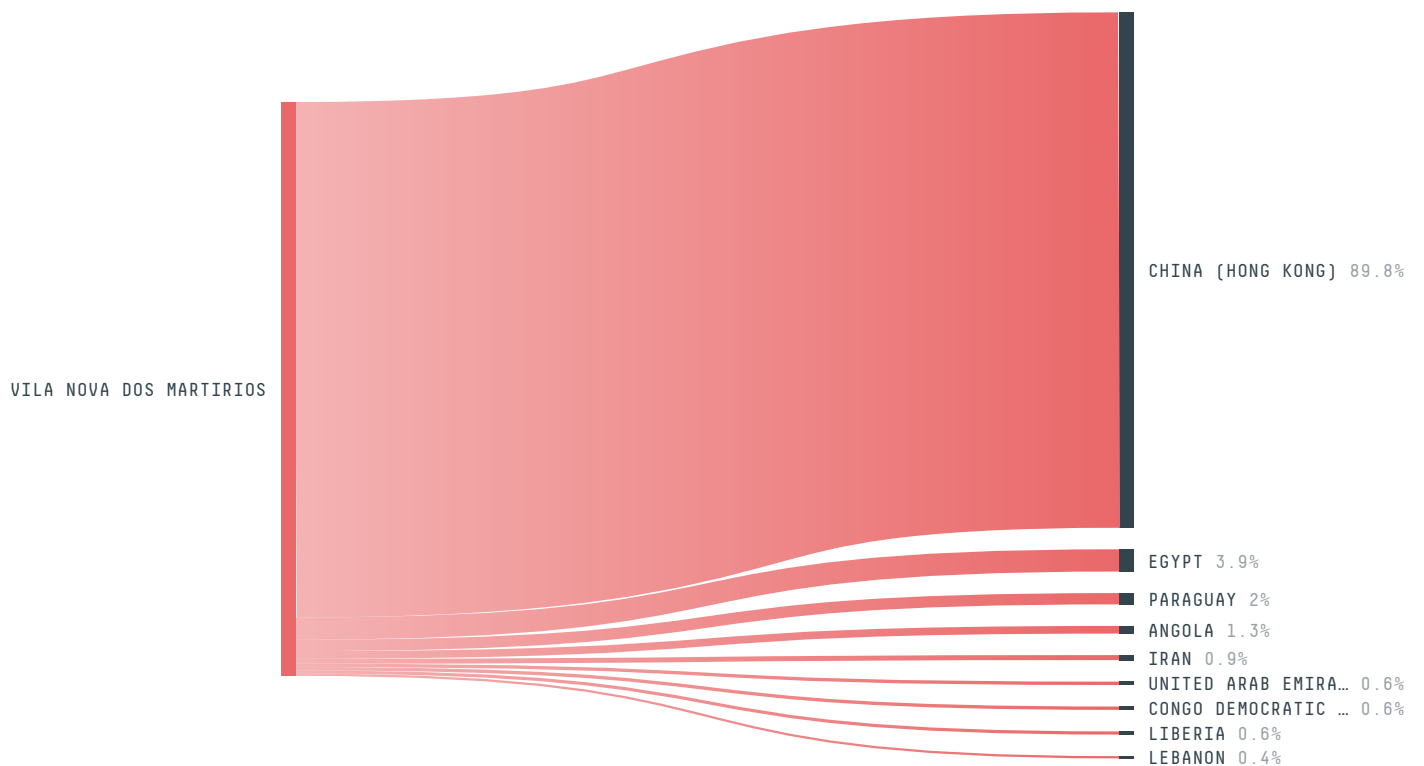
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF VILA NOVA DOS MARTIRIOS
