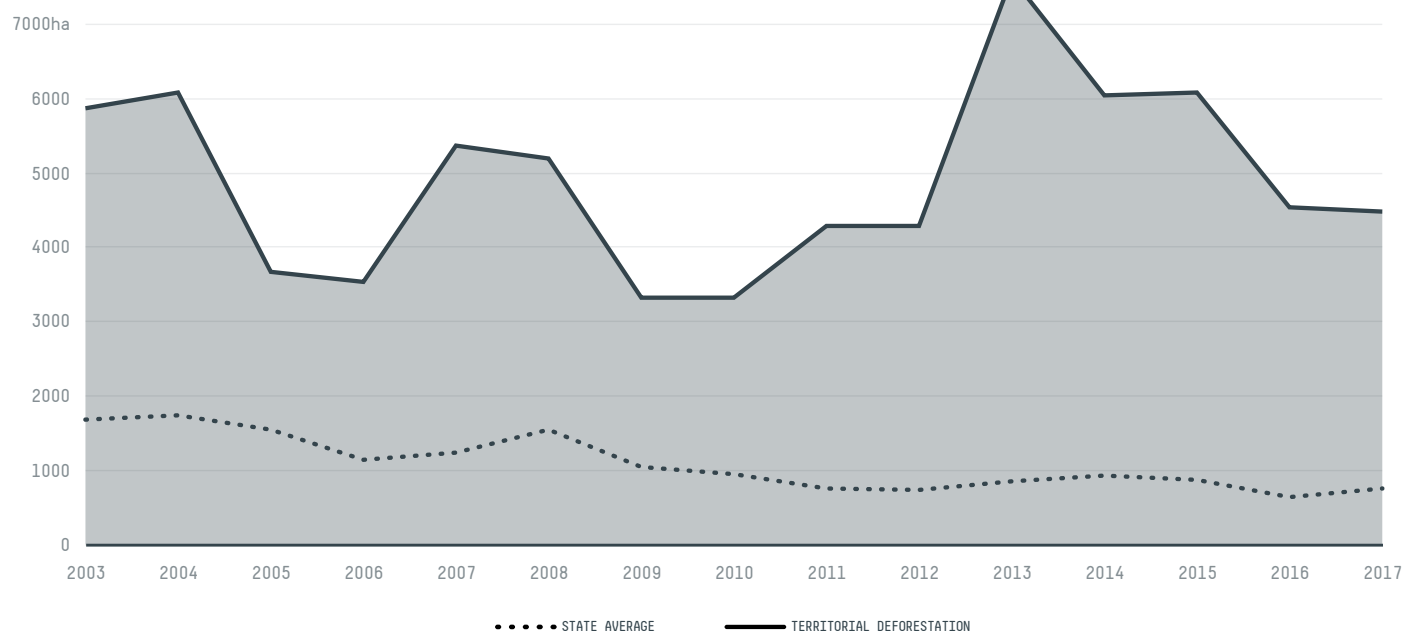

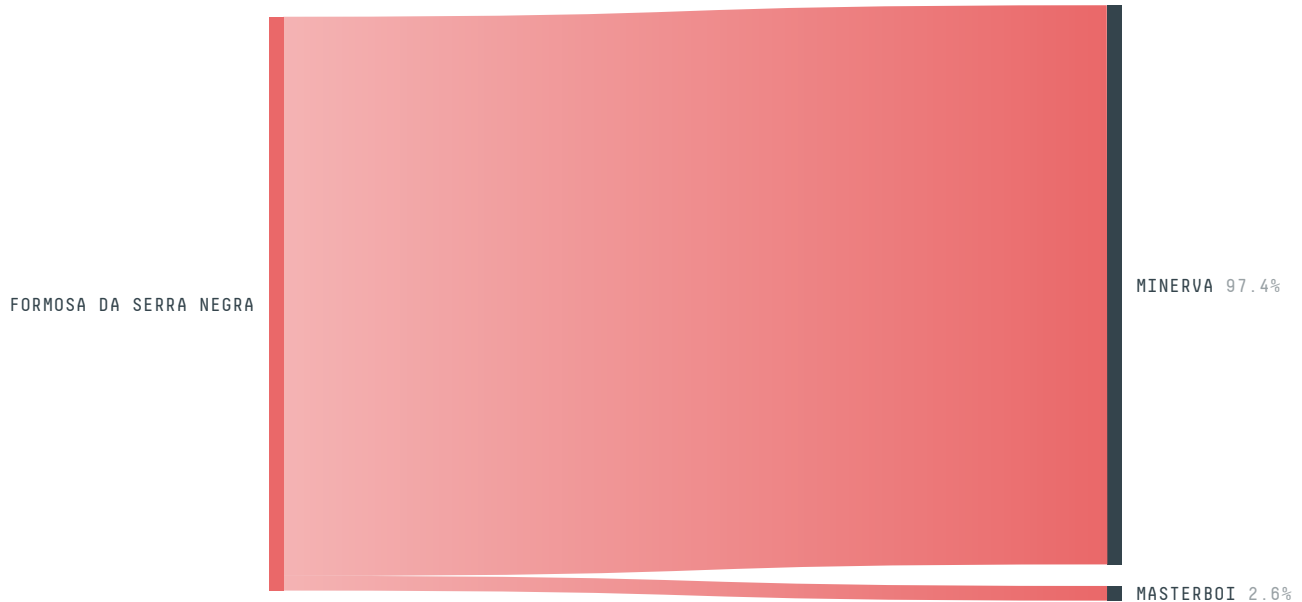

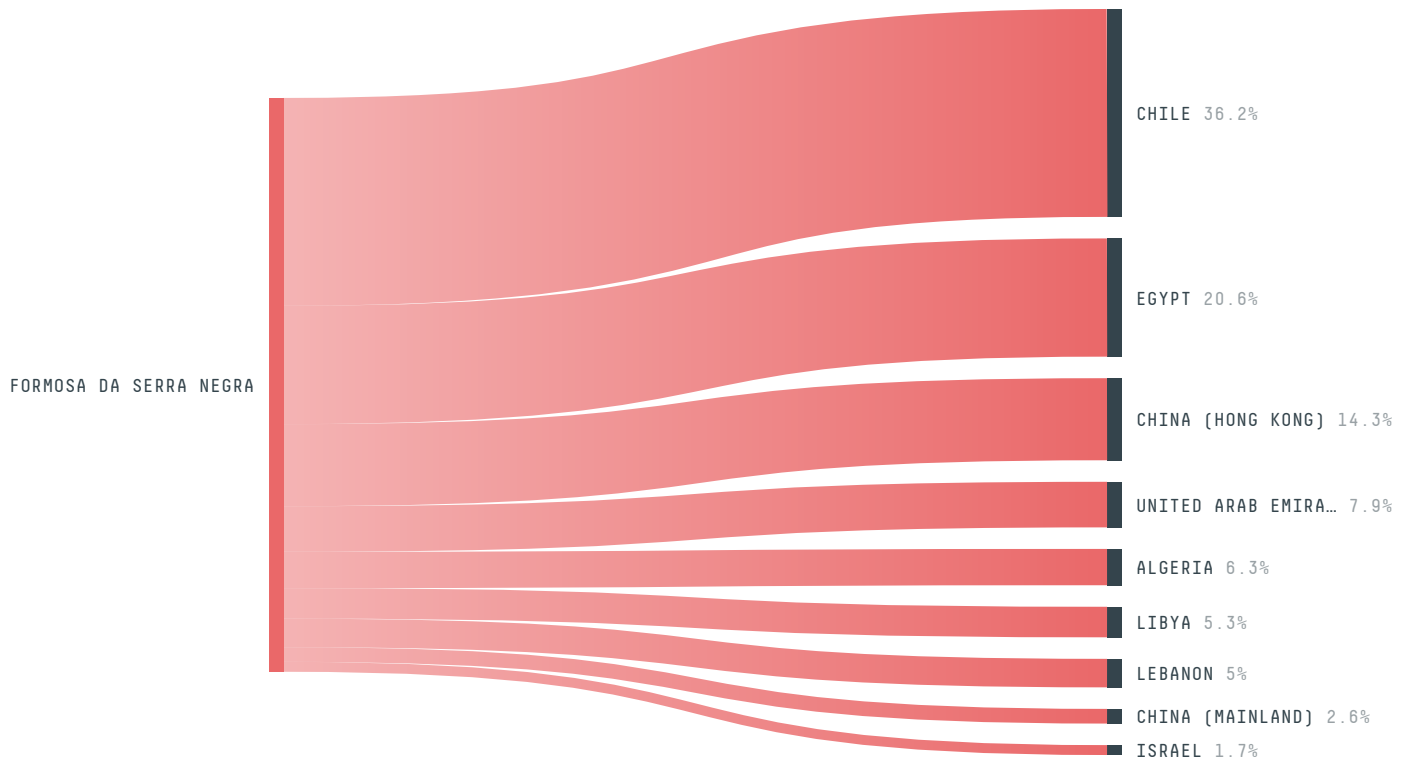
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF FORMOSA DA SERRA NEGRA
