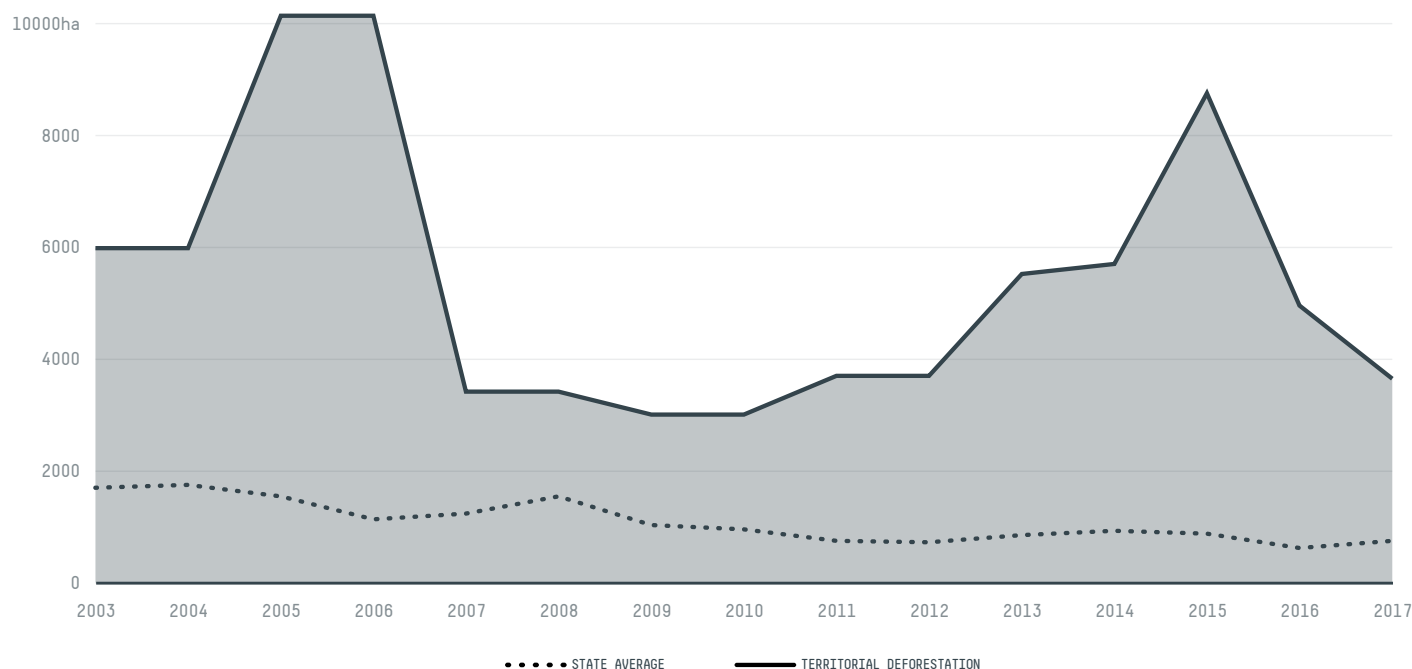

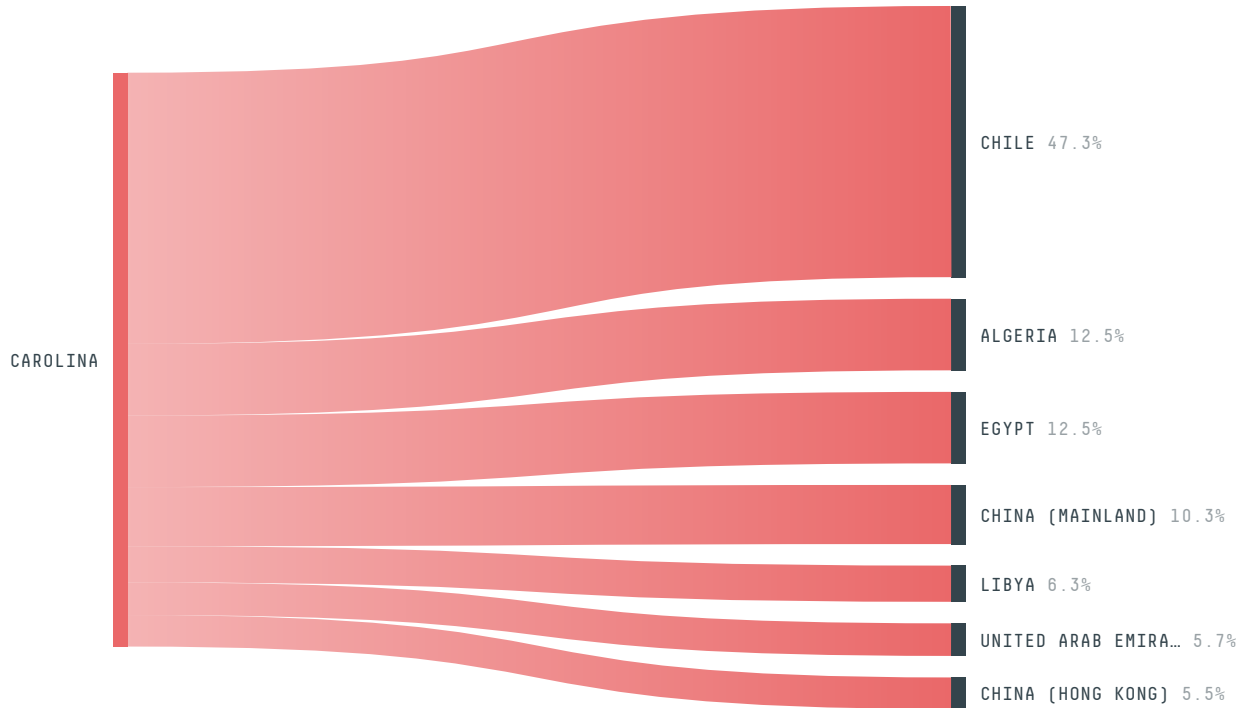
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CAROLINA
