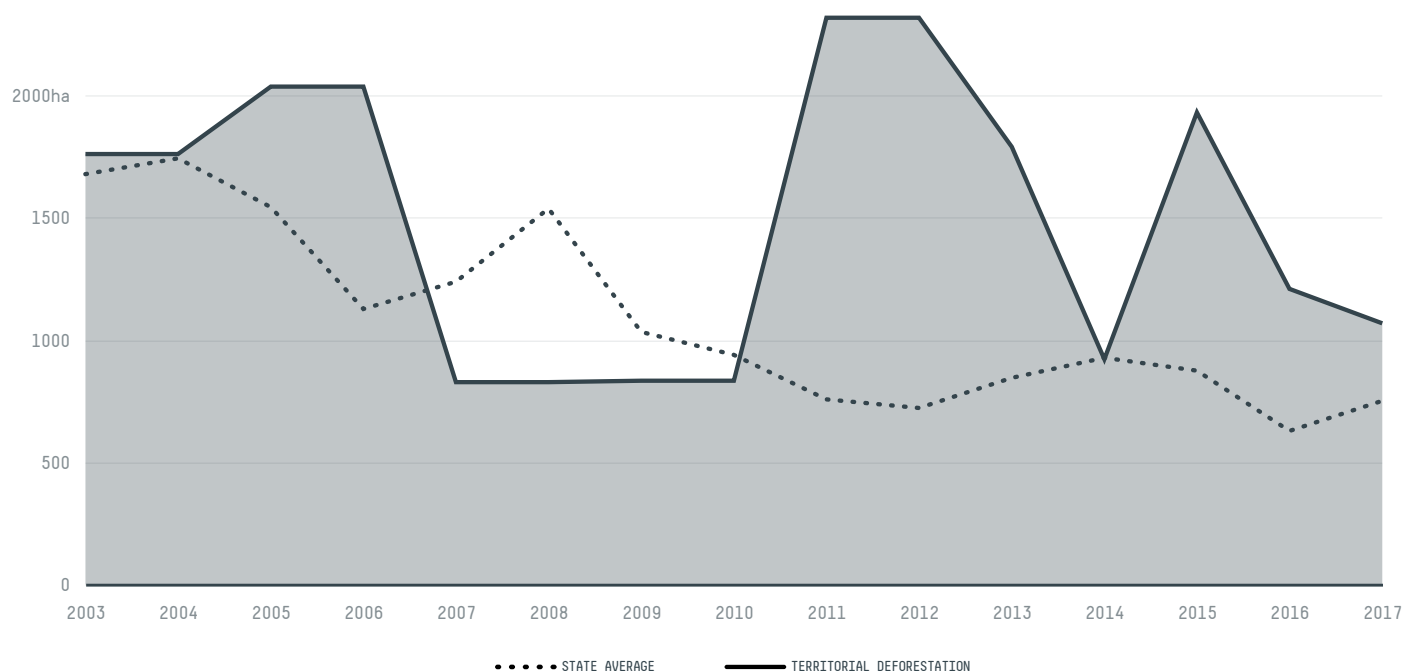

TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF BEEF FROM SAO PEDRO DOS CRENTES IN 2017



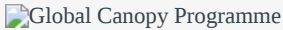


Deforestation alerts in São Pedro dos Crentes, Maranhão, Brazil
