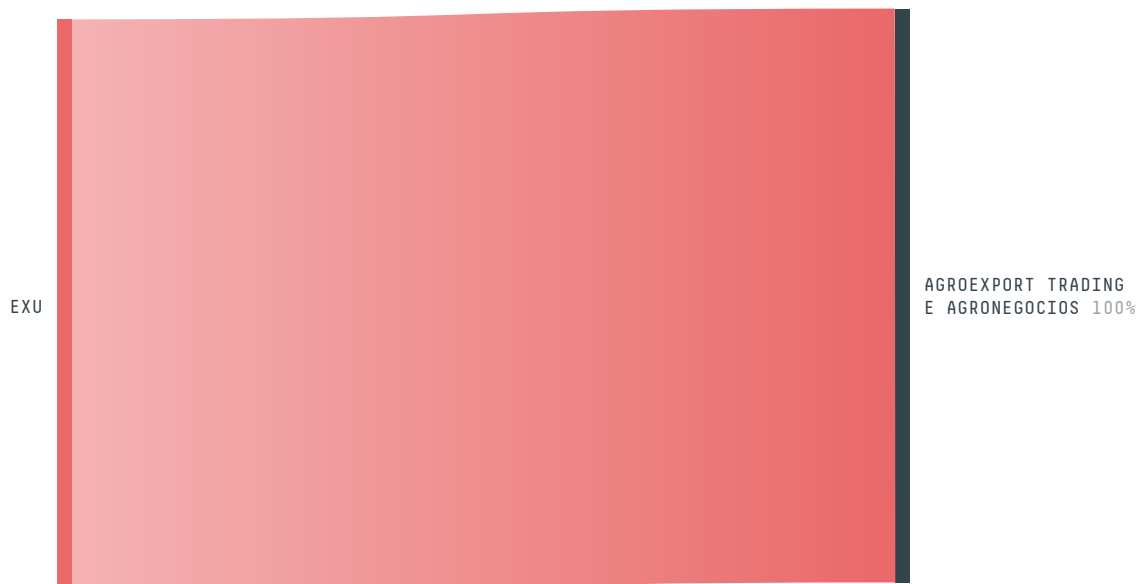
The largest exporter of beef in Exu was Agroexport Trading E Agronegocios, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Lebanon.

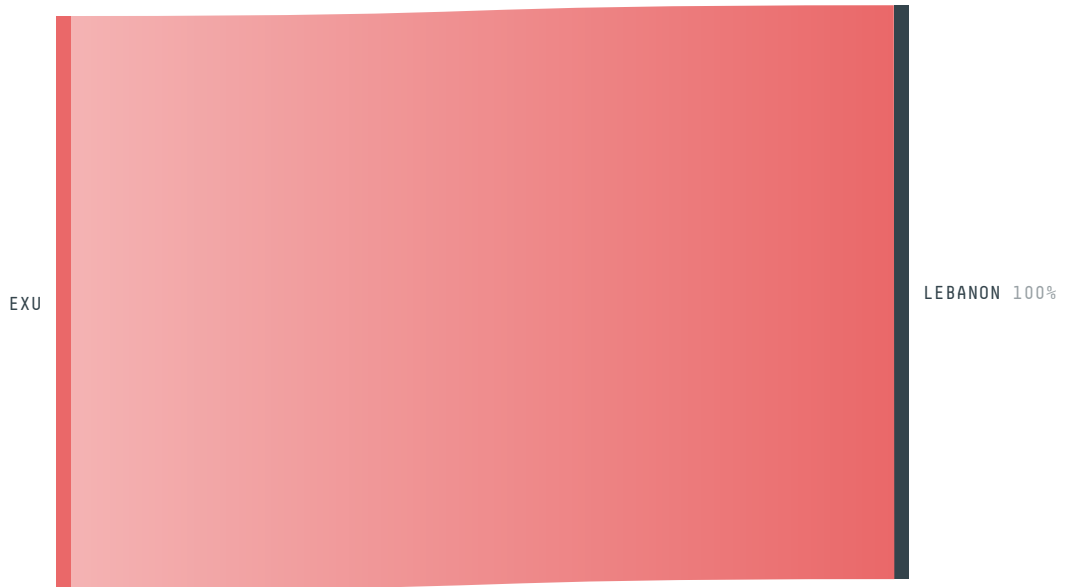
