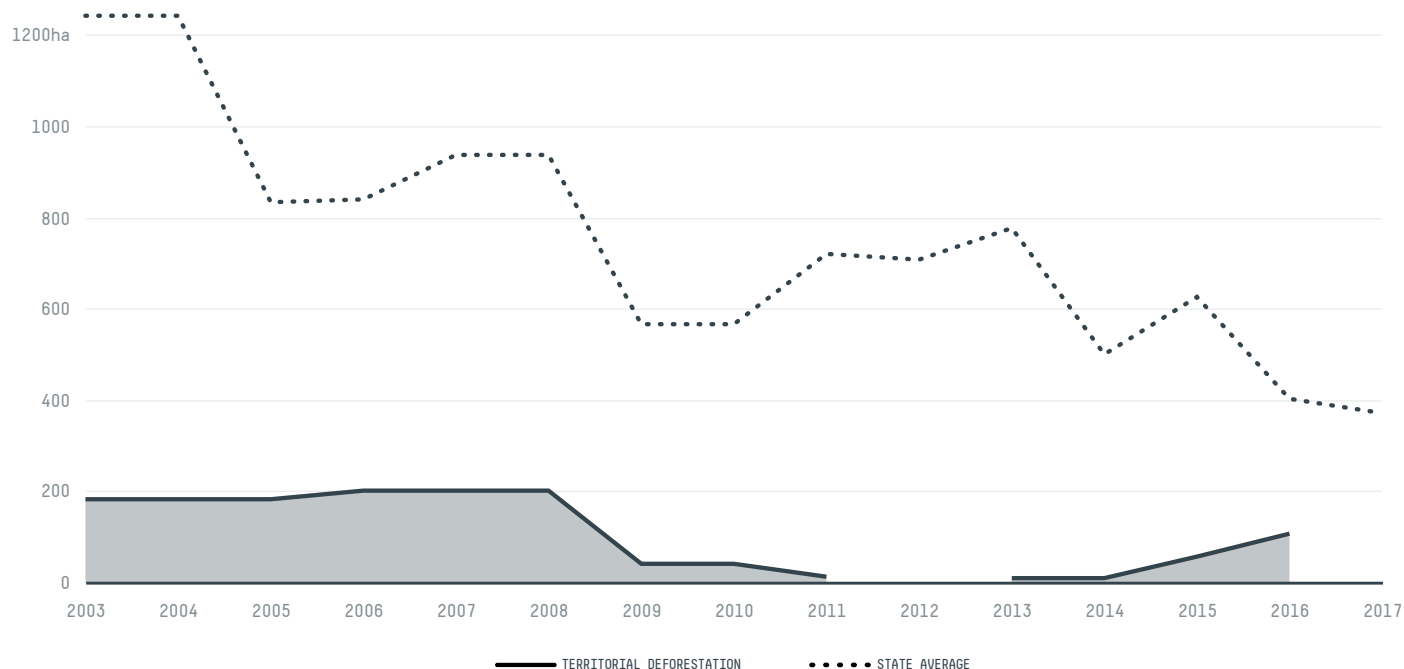

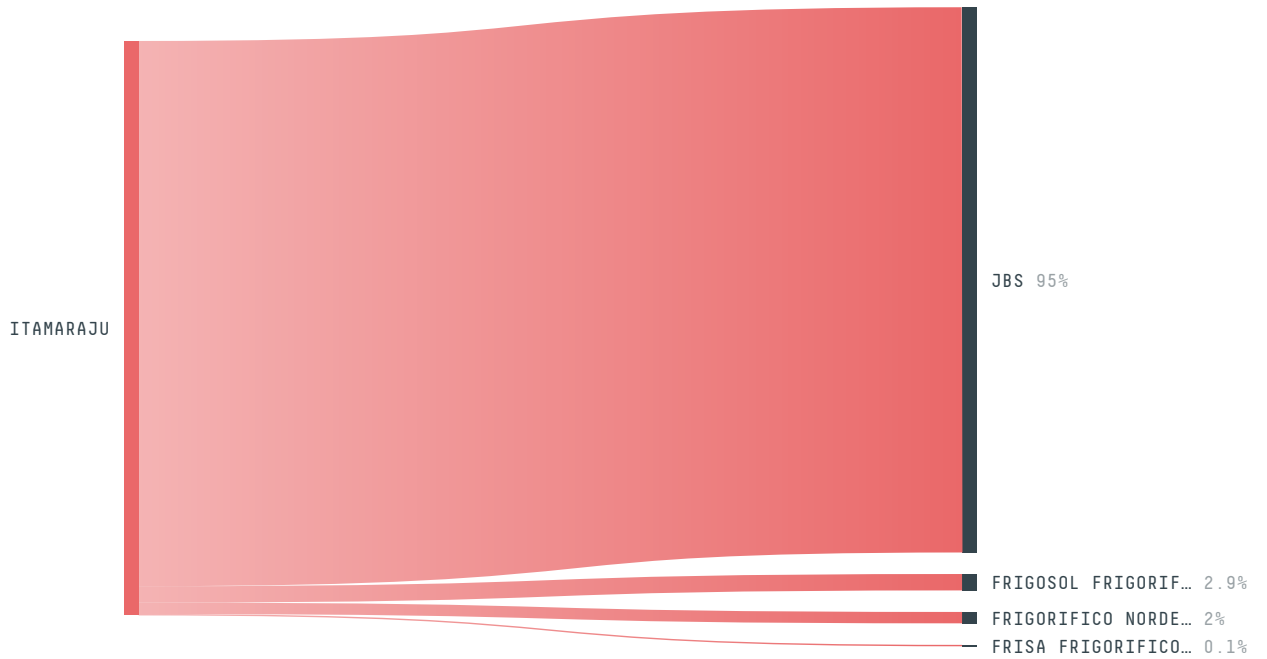

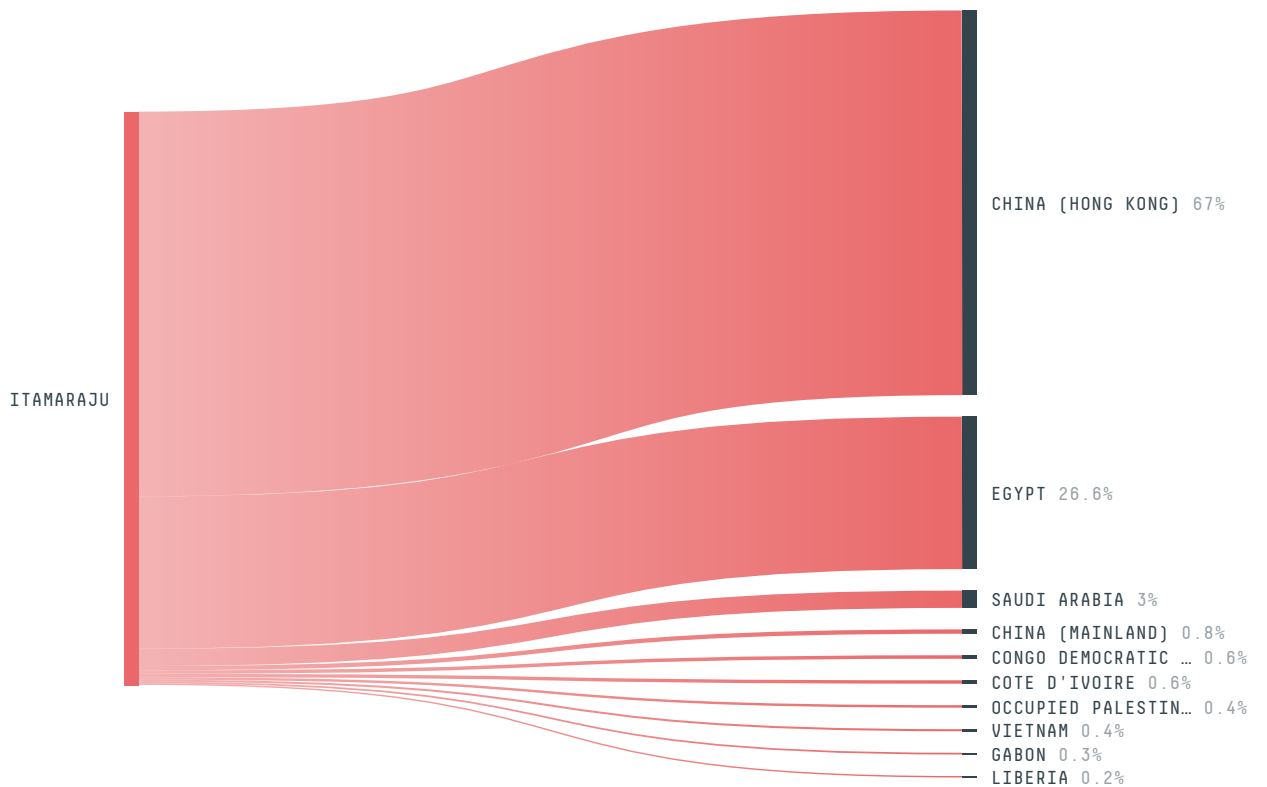
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ITAMARAJU
