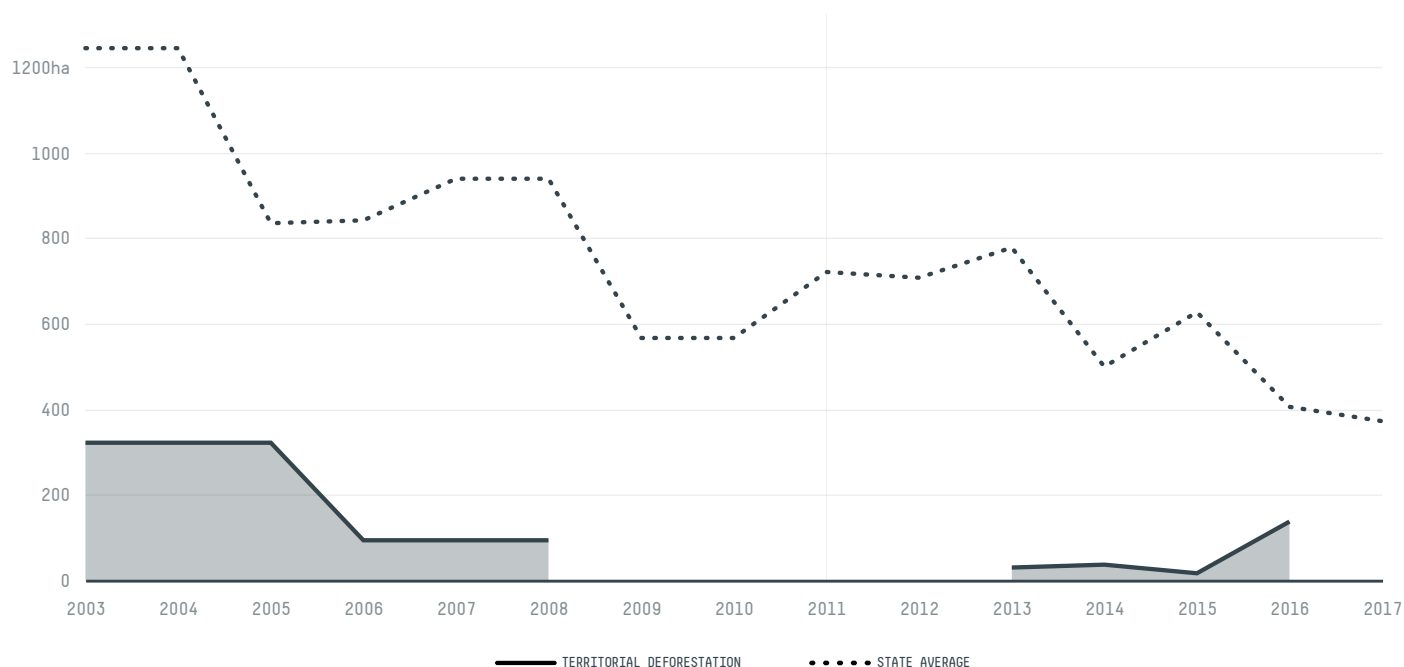

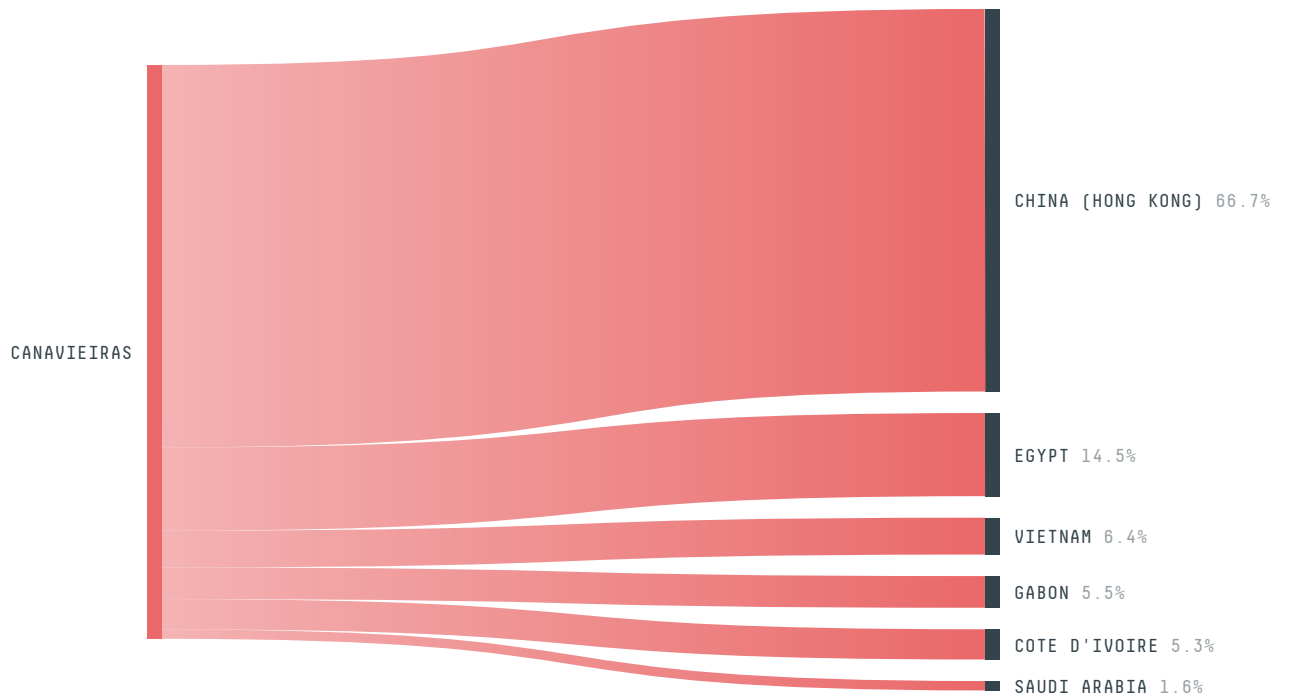
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CANAVIEIRAS
