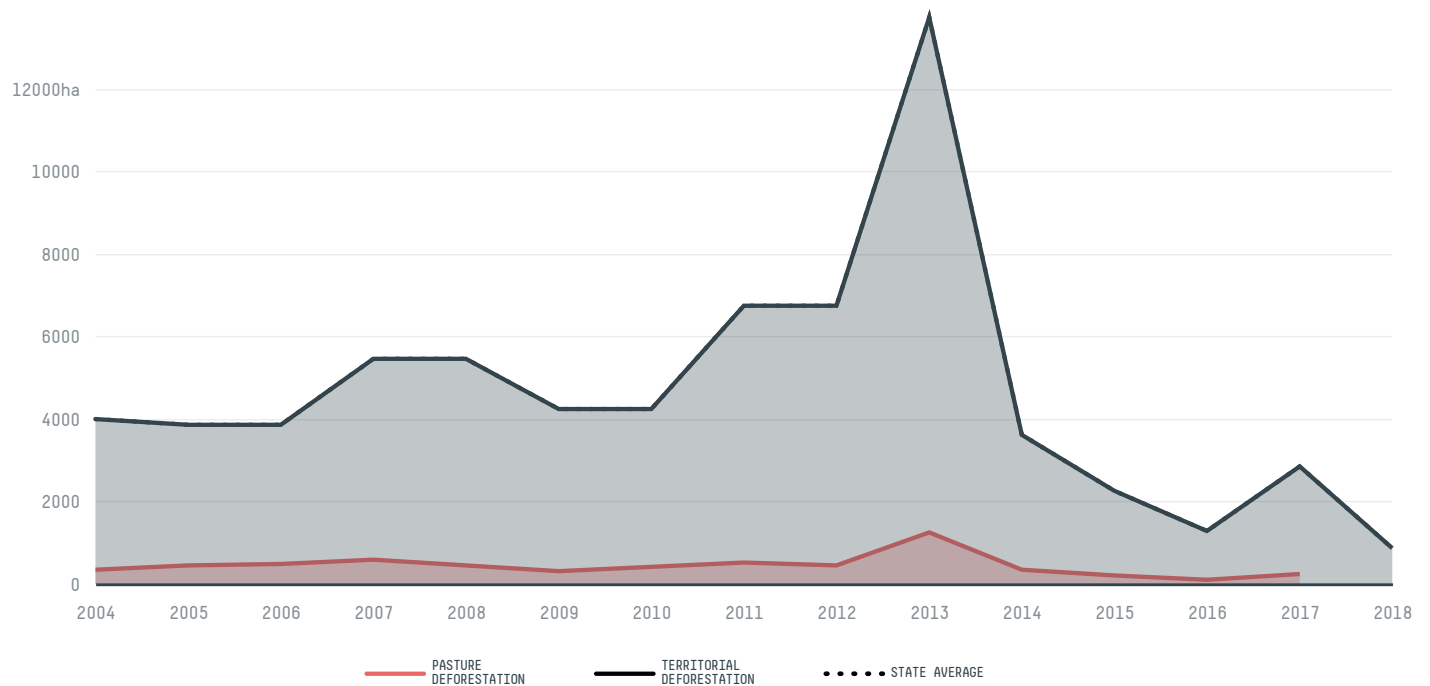

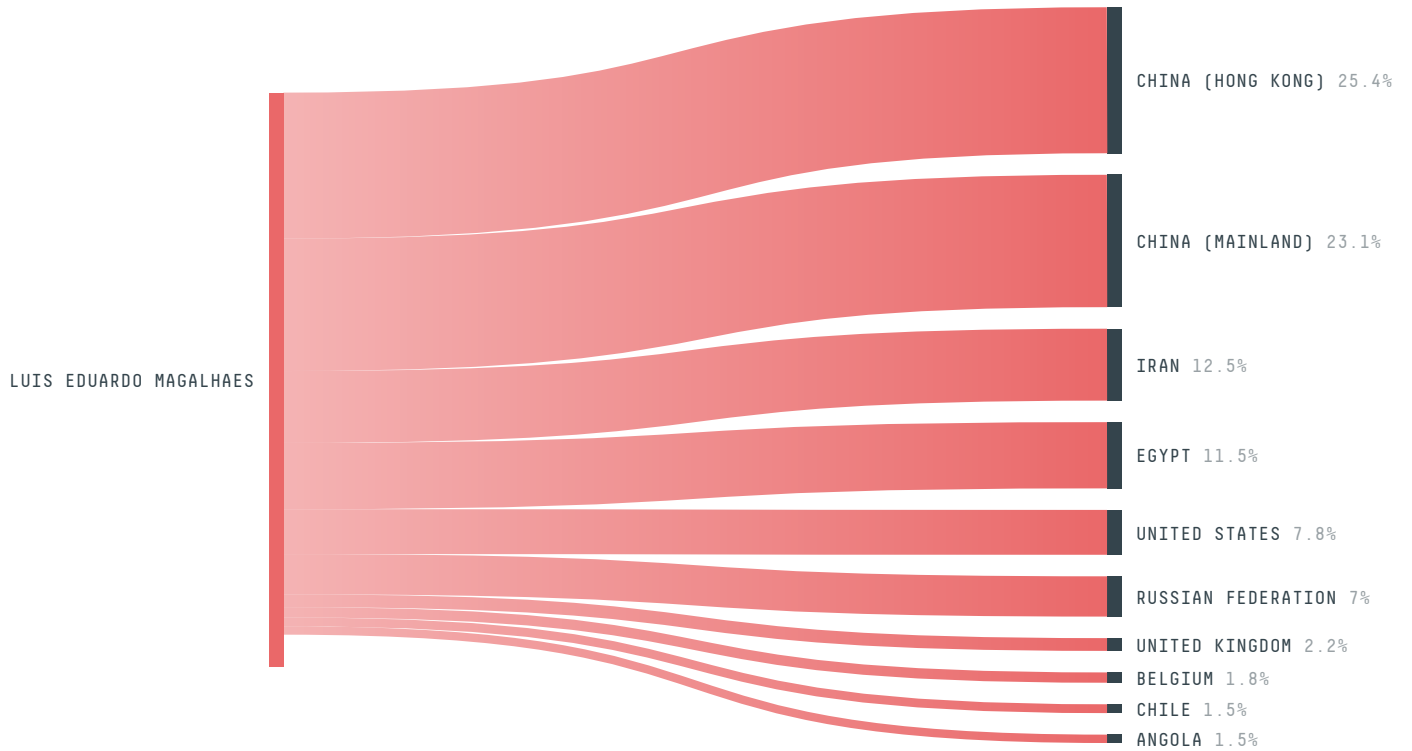

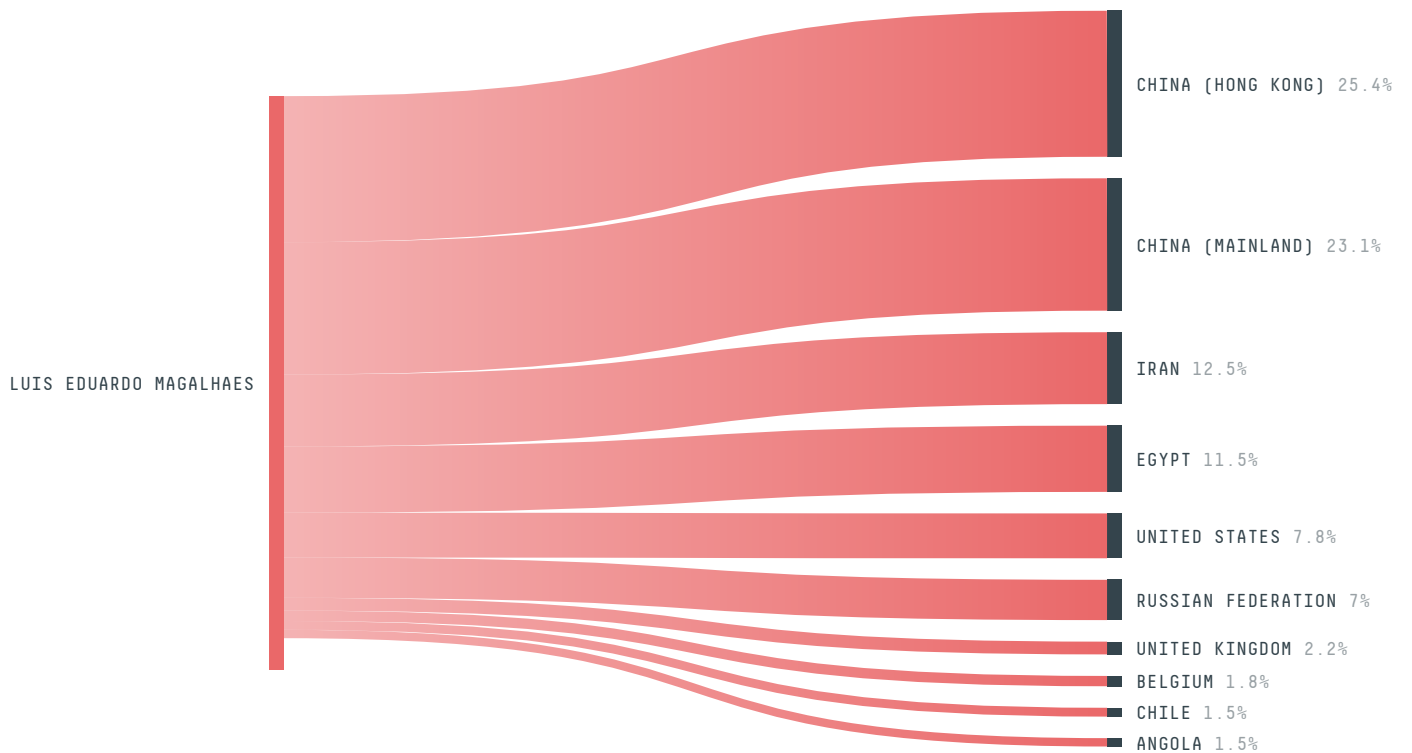
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF LUIS EDUARDO MAGALHAES
