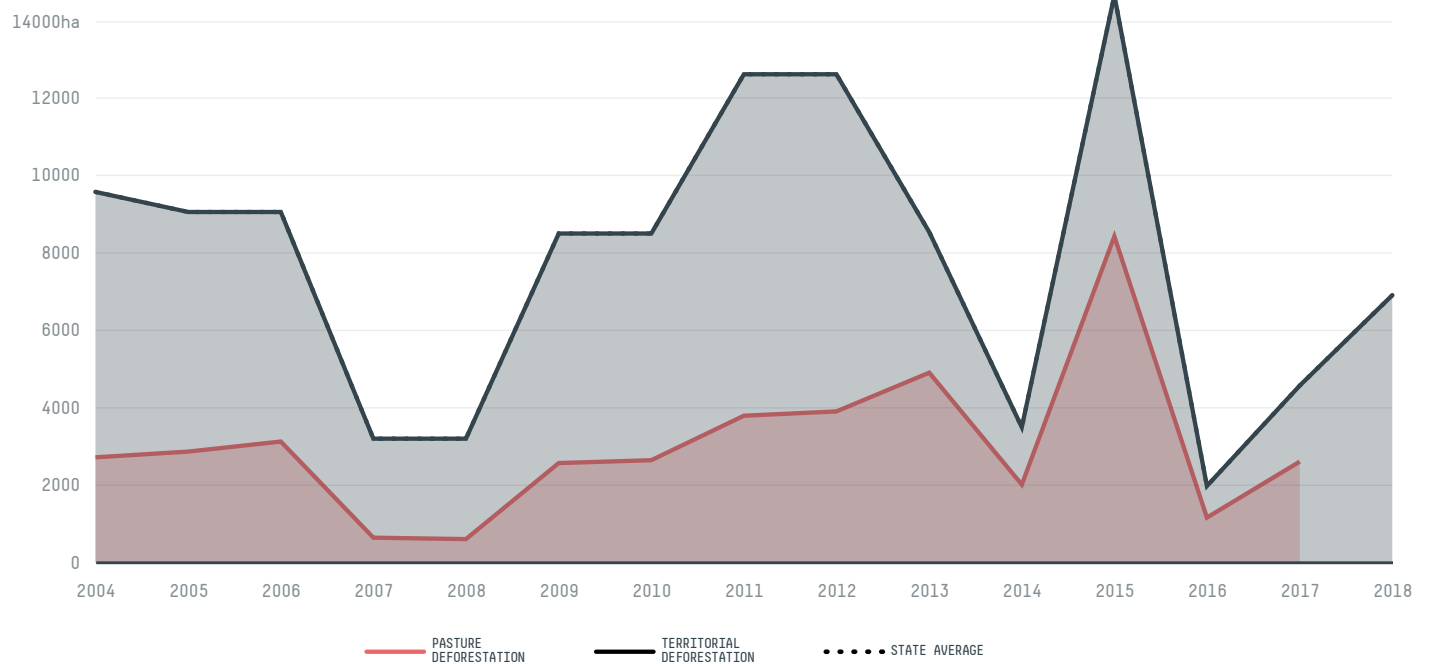

The largest exporter of beef in Cocos was Jbs, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

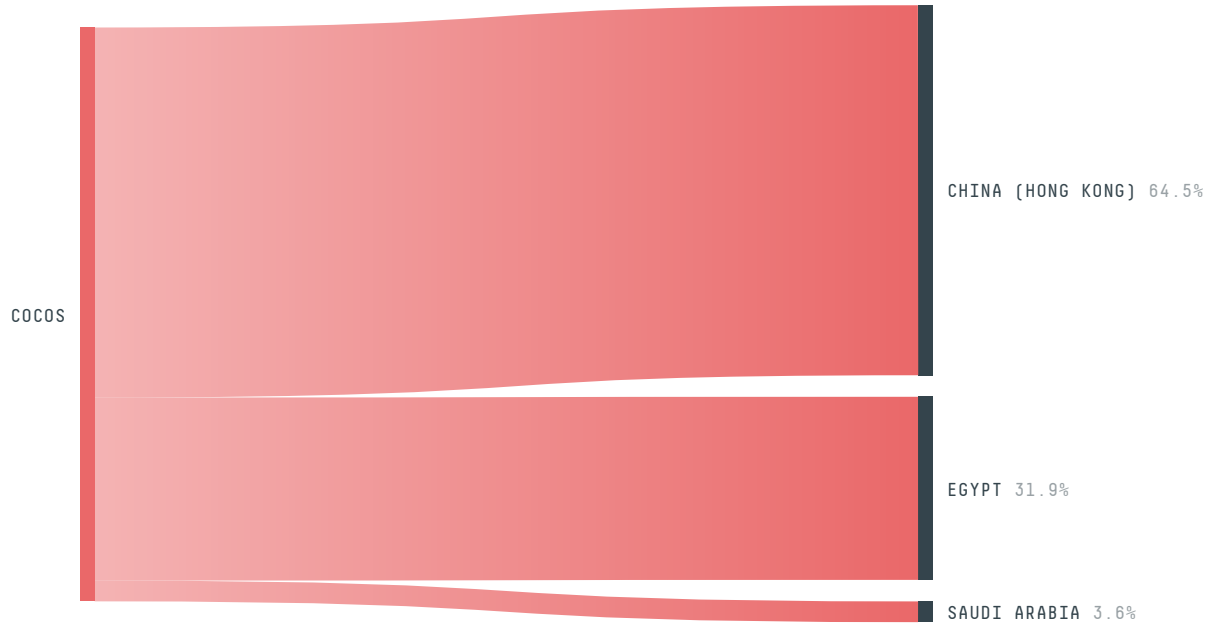

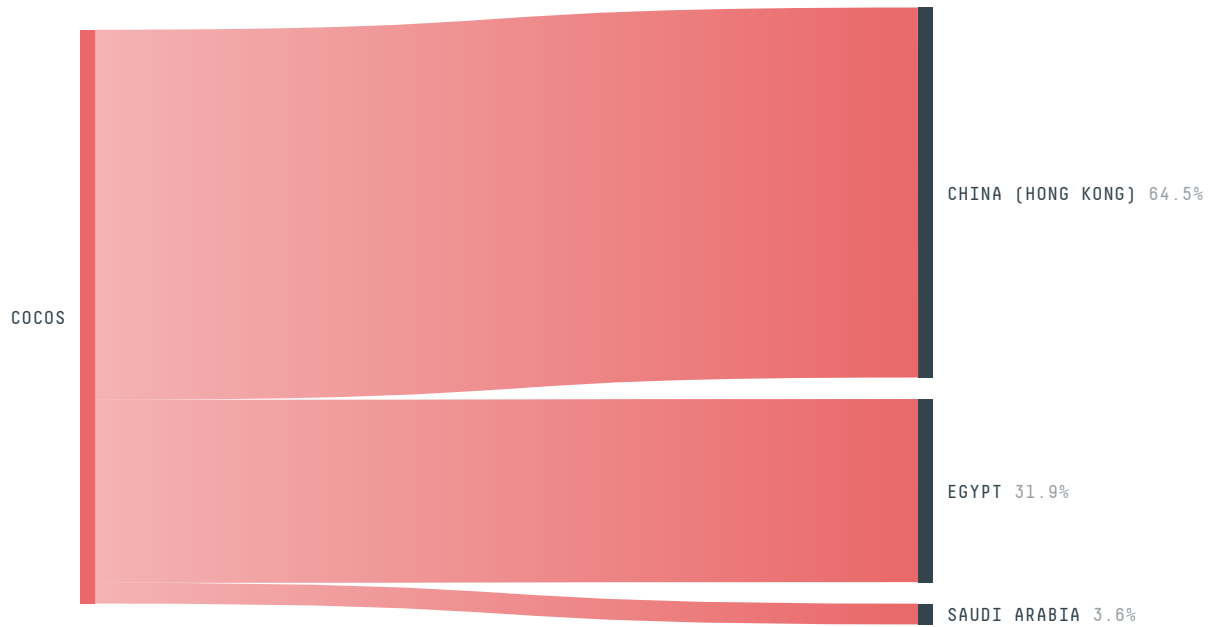
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF COCOS
