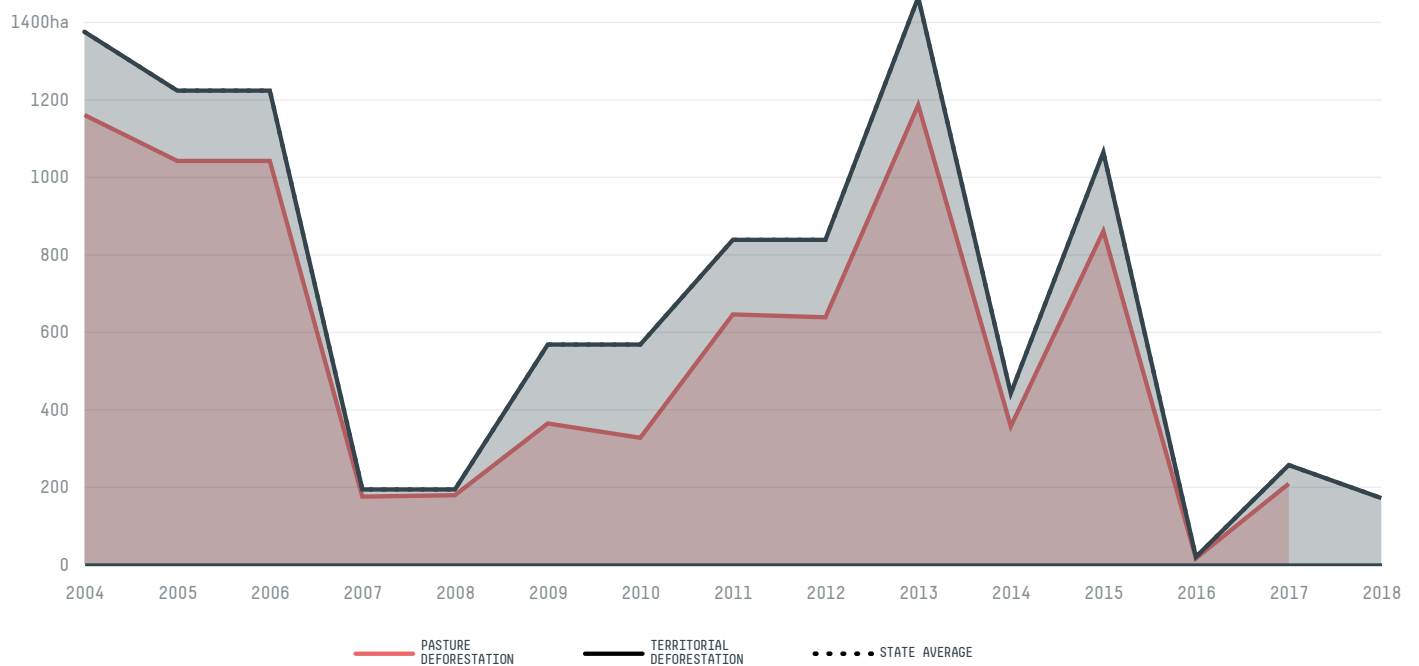

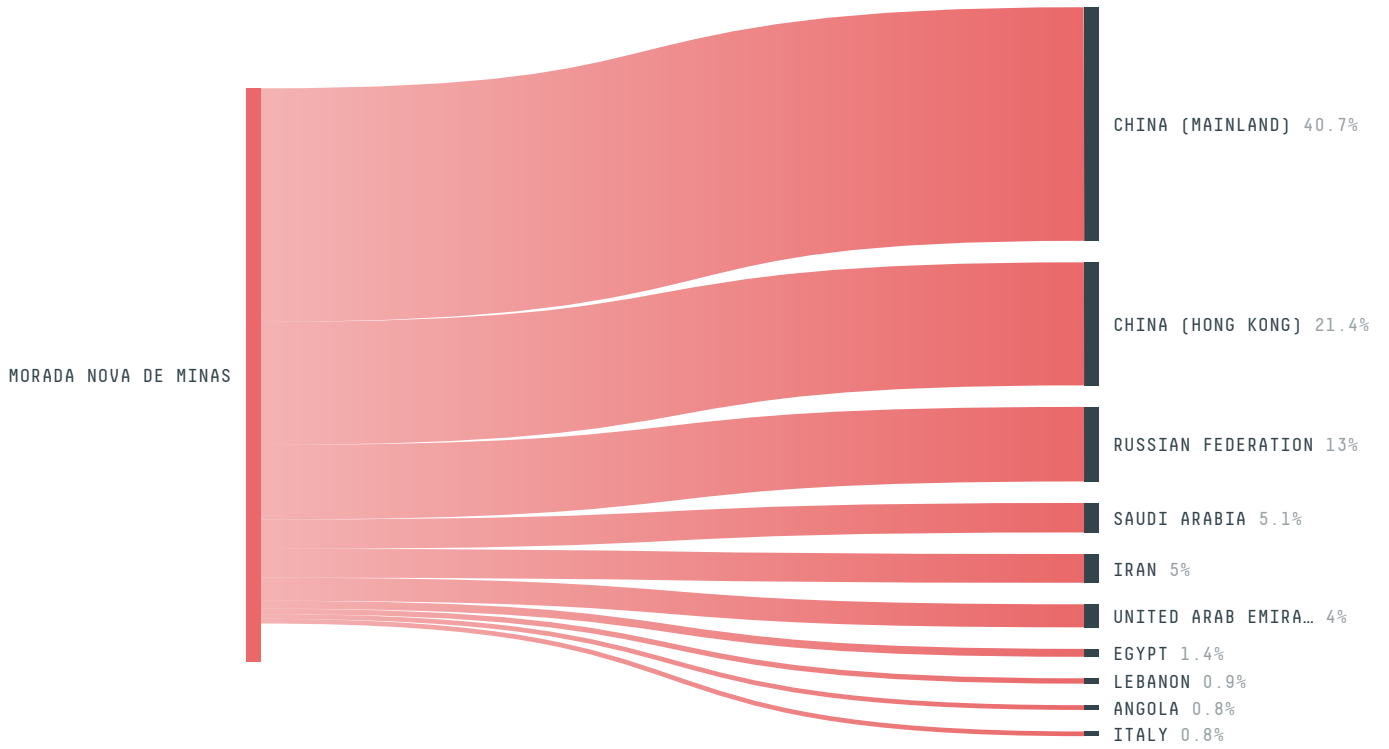

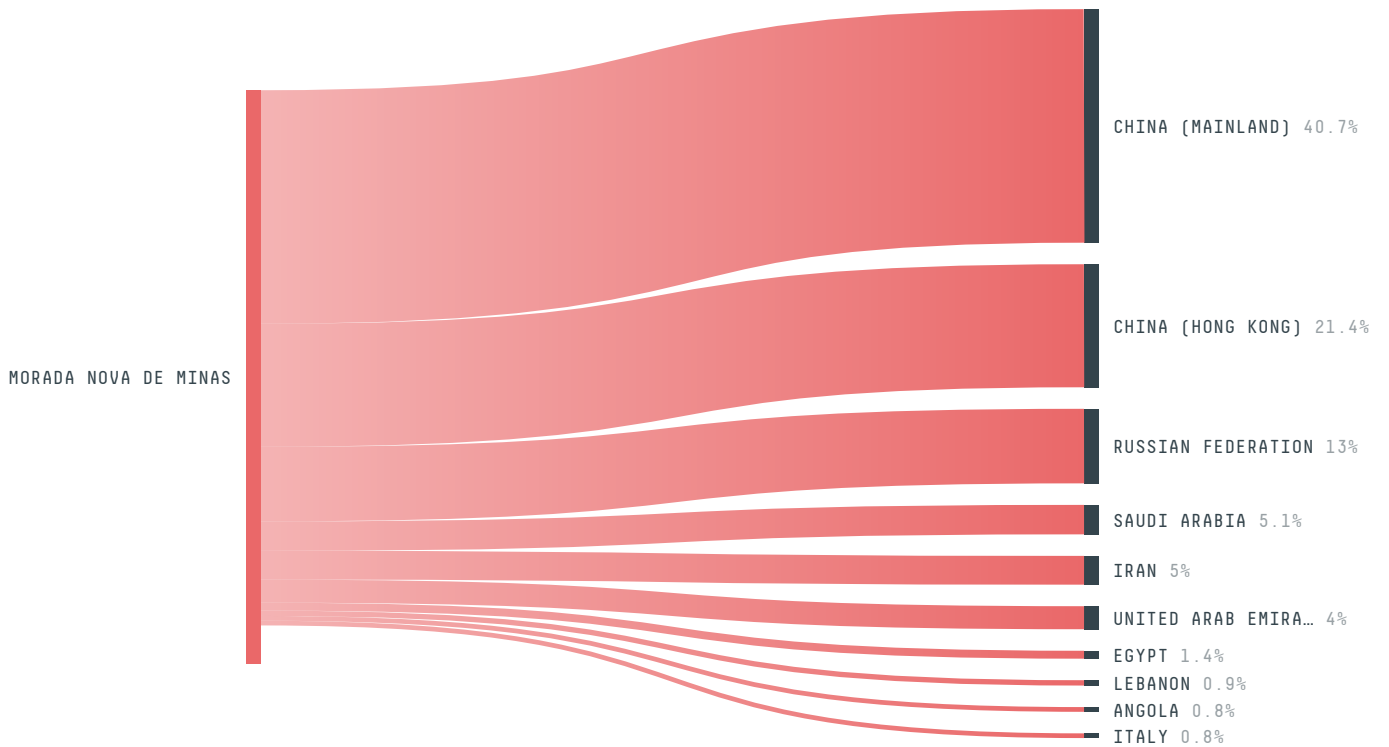
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MORADA NOVA DE MINAS
