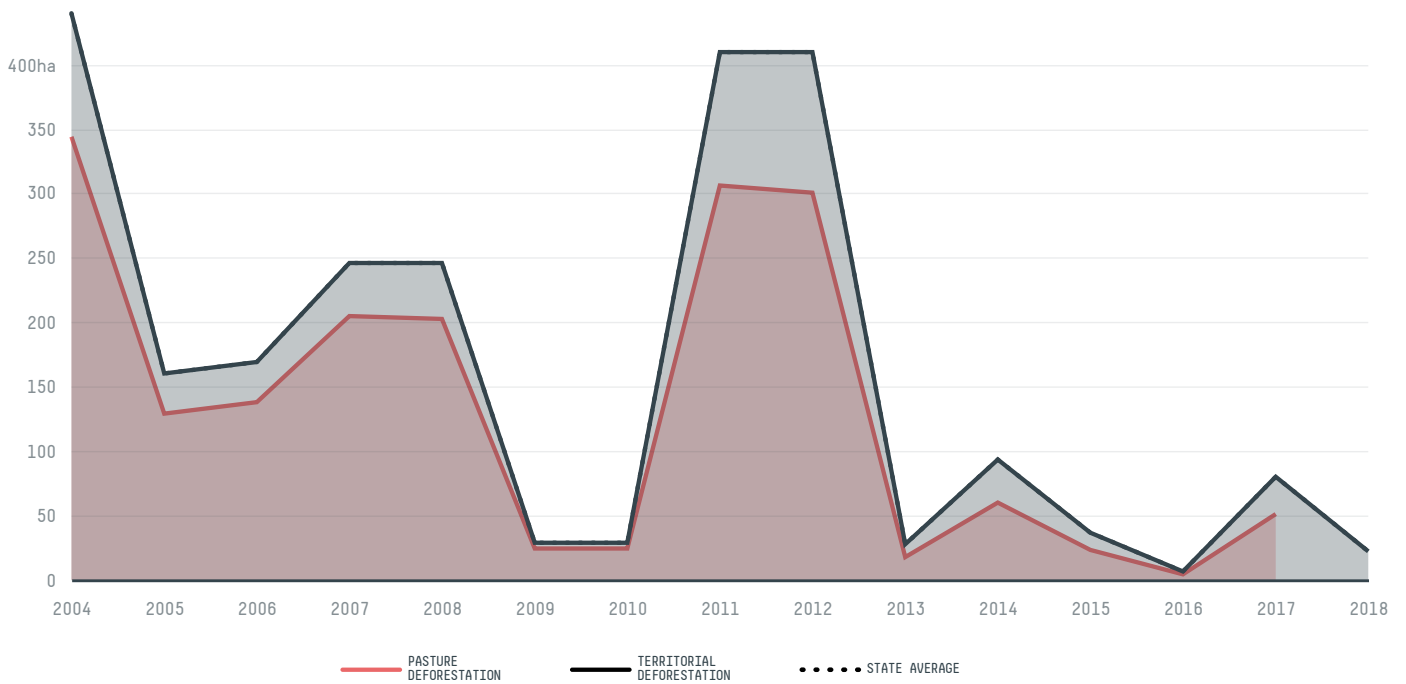

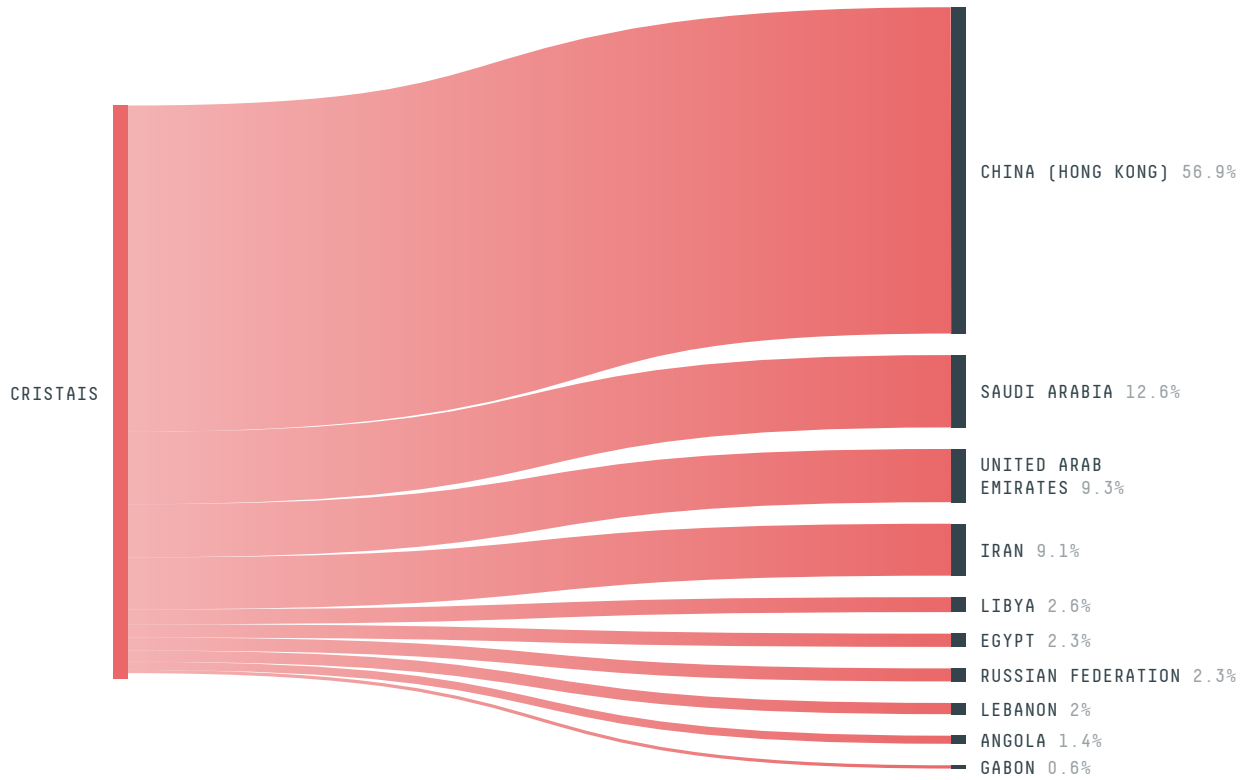

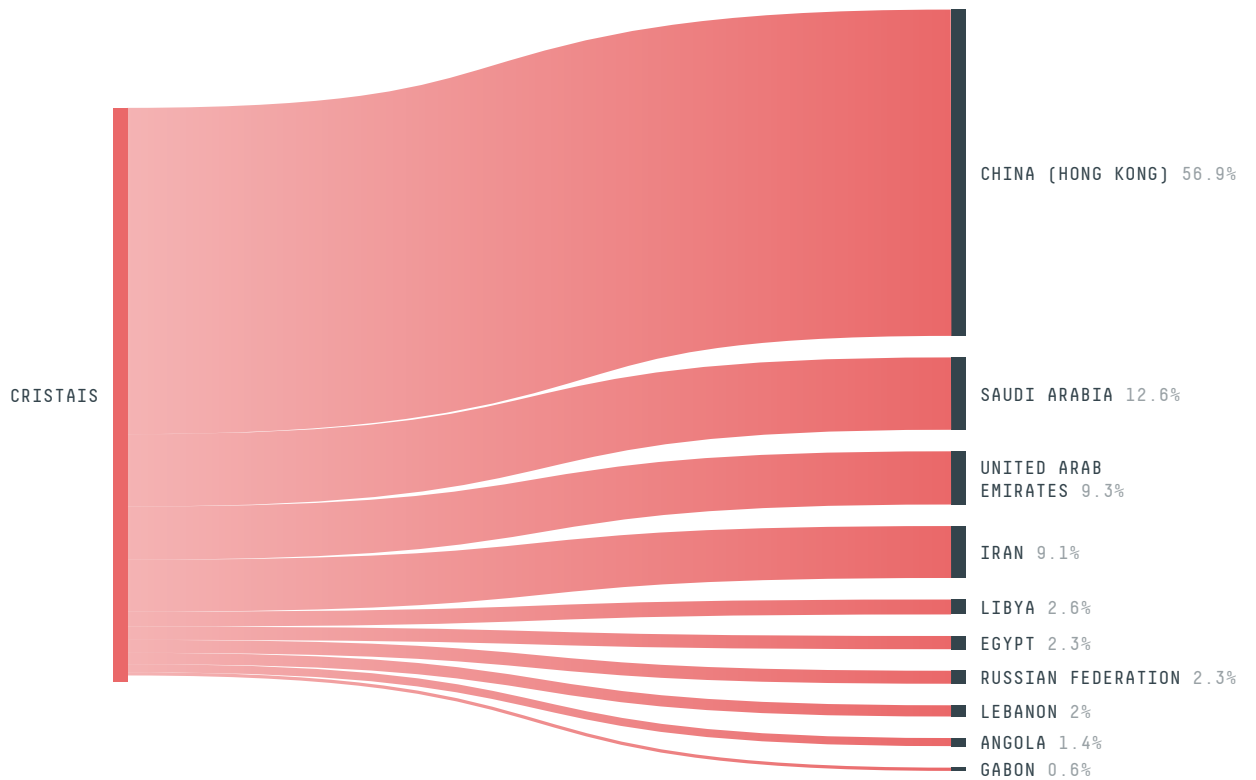
**DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CRISTAIS**
