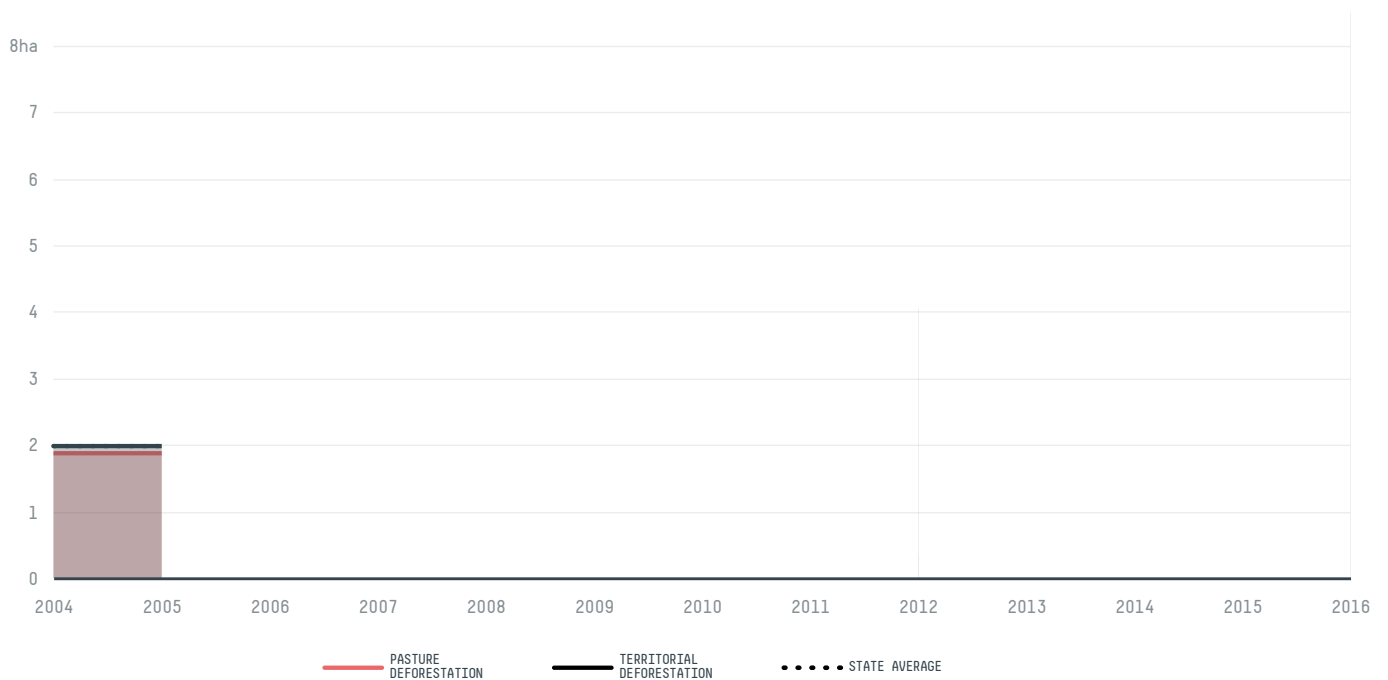

The largest exporter of beef in Ipanema was Frisa Frigorifico Rio Doce, which accounted for 98.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Israel.

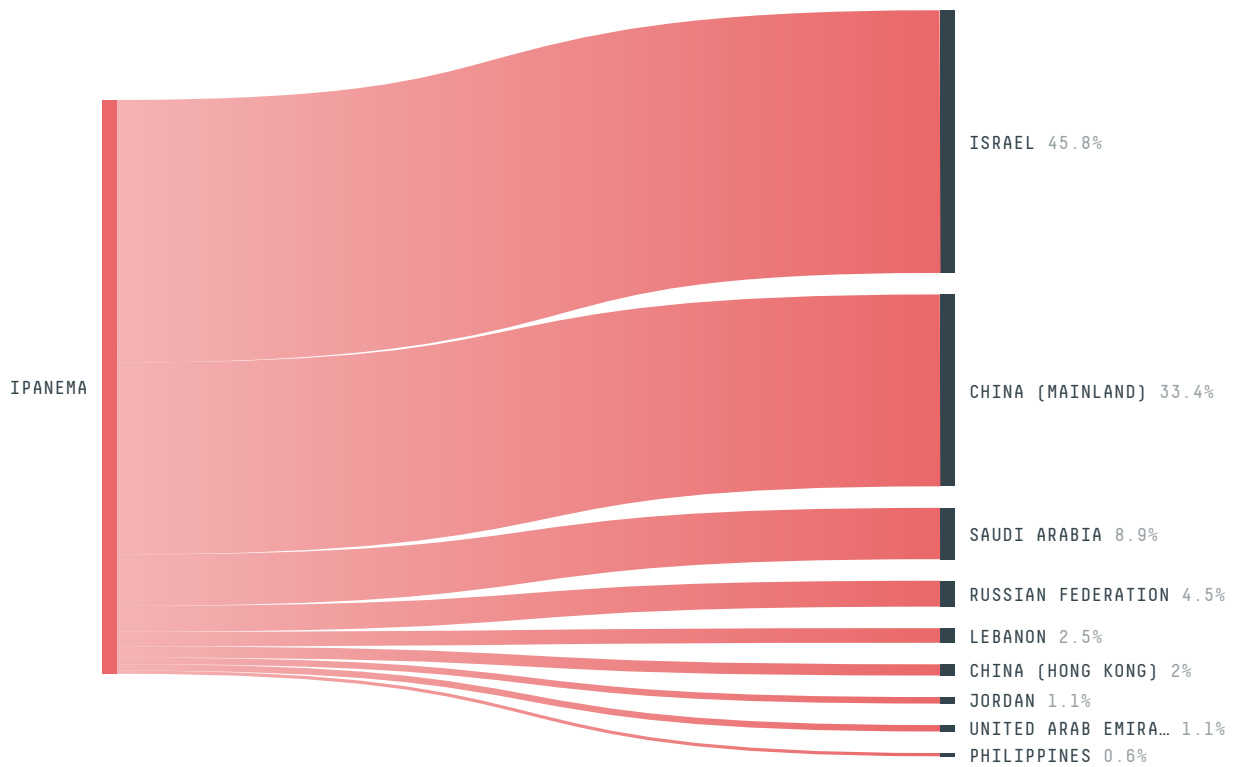

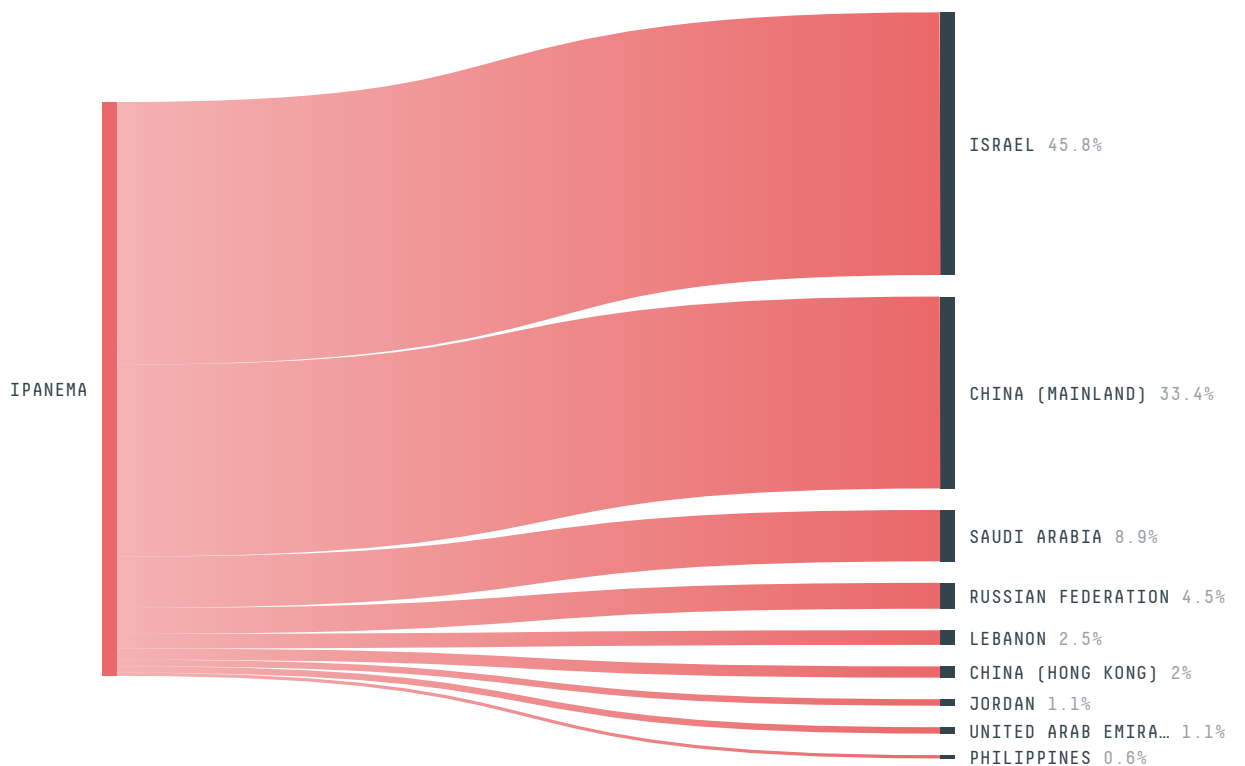
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF IPANEMA
