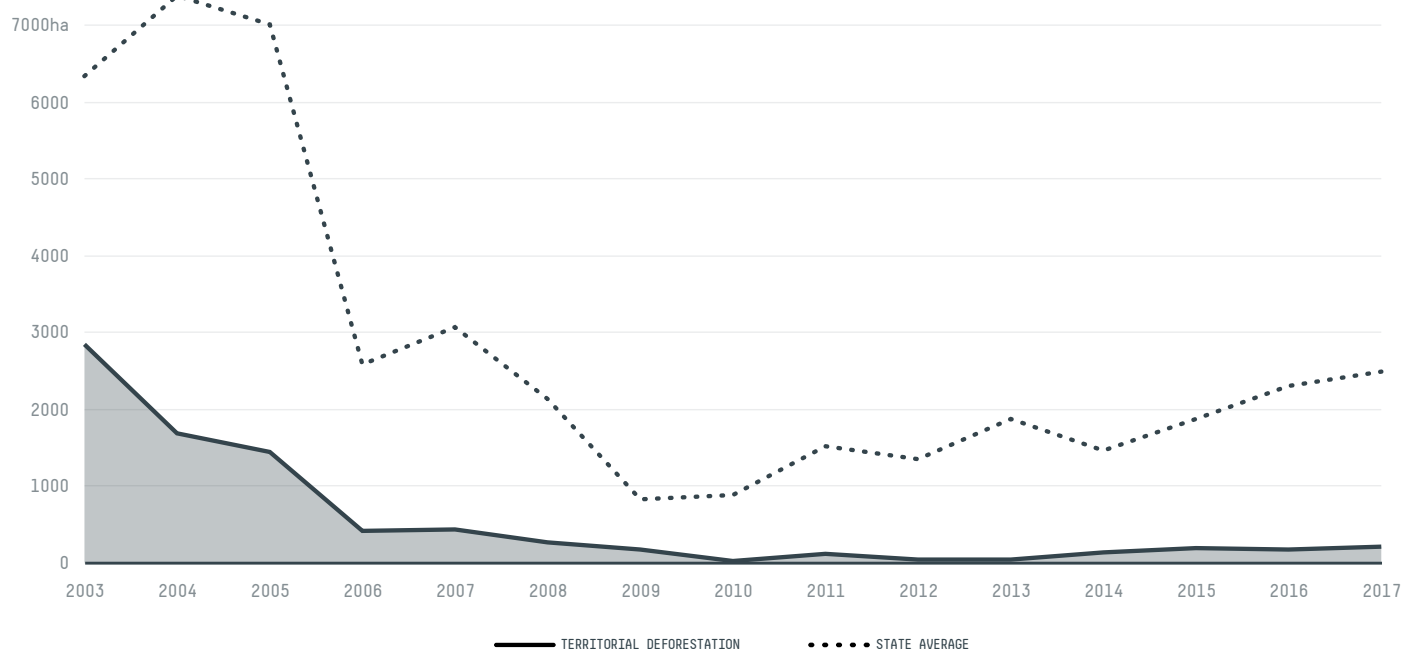

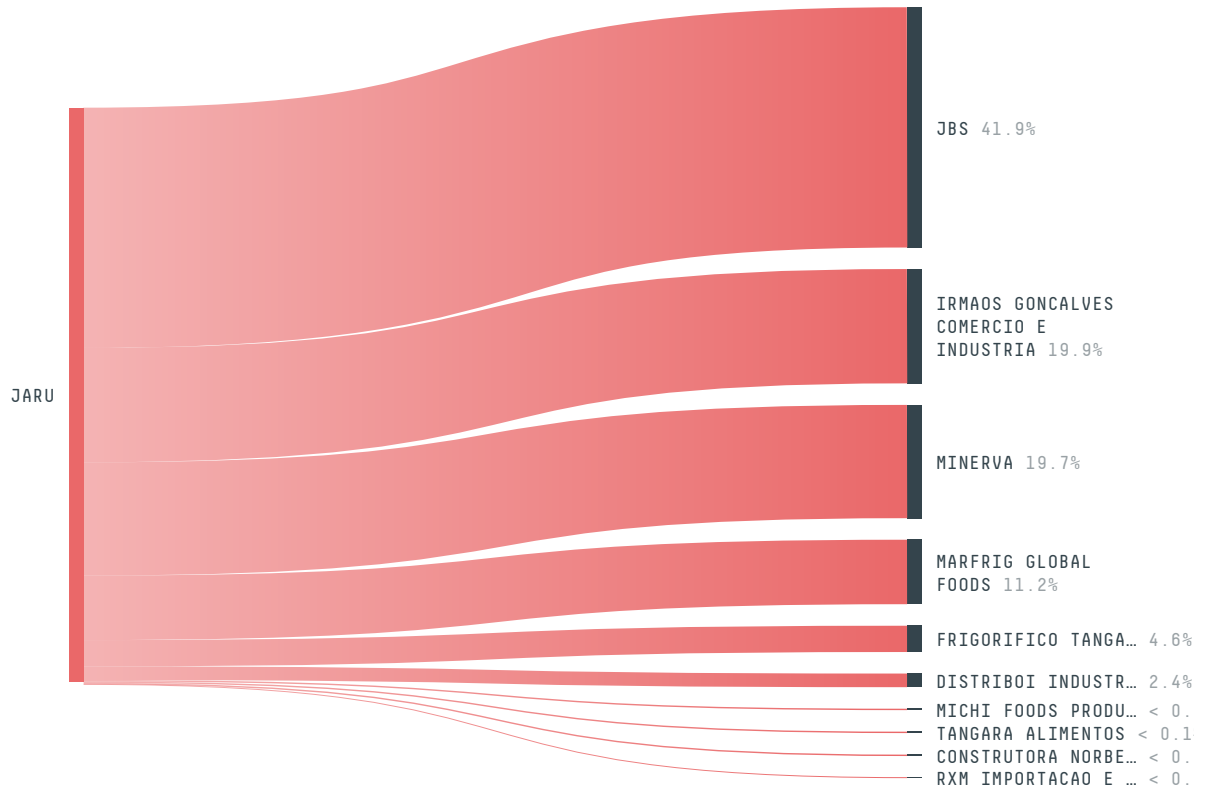

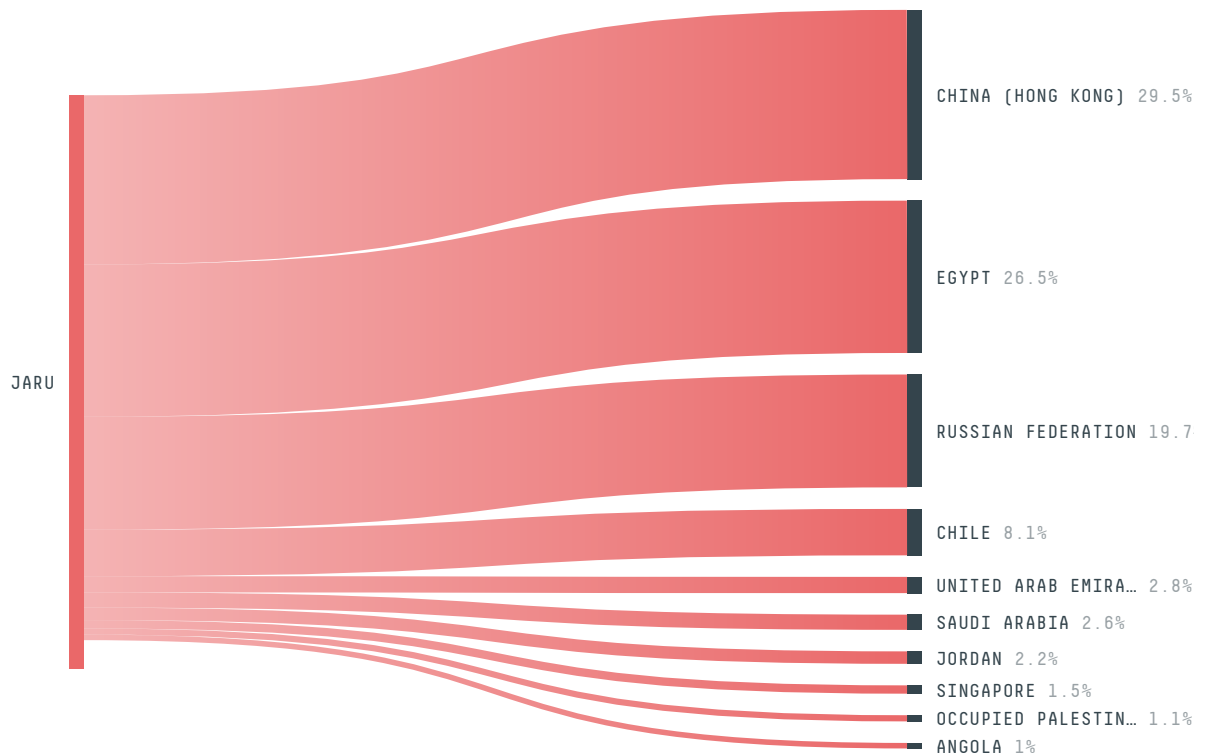
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF JARU
