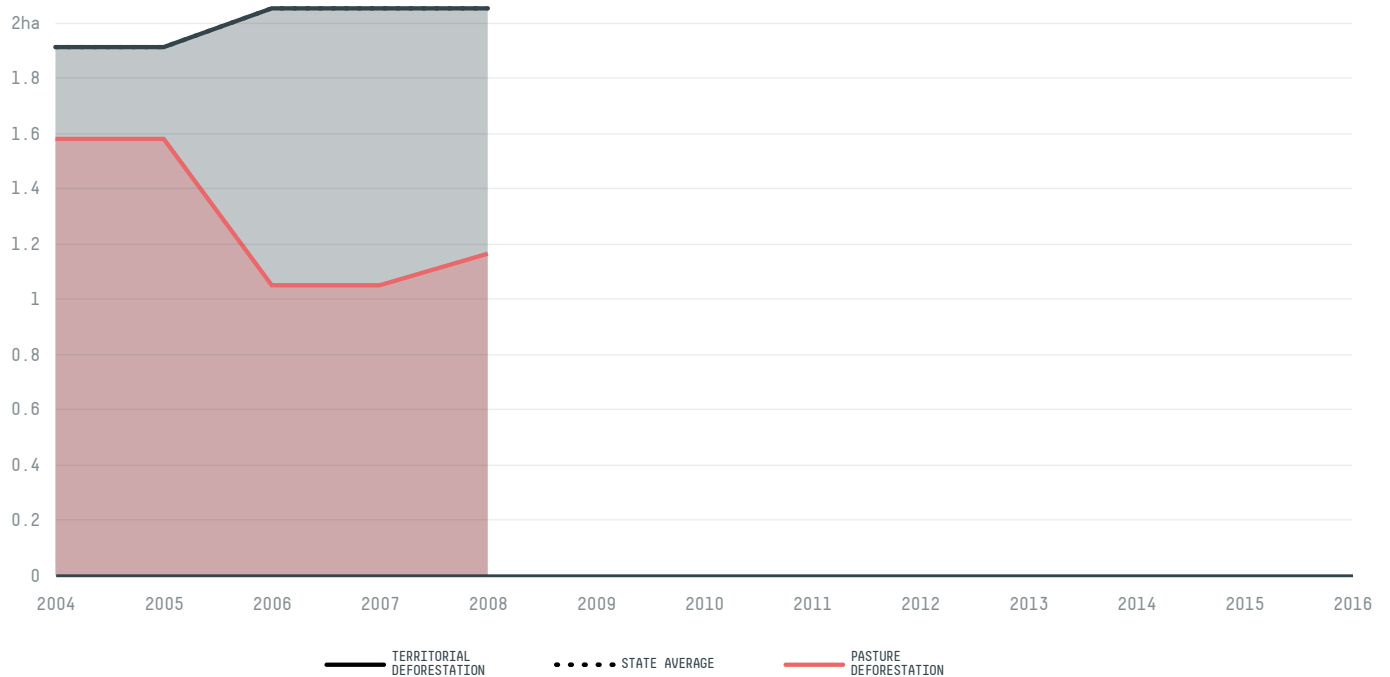

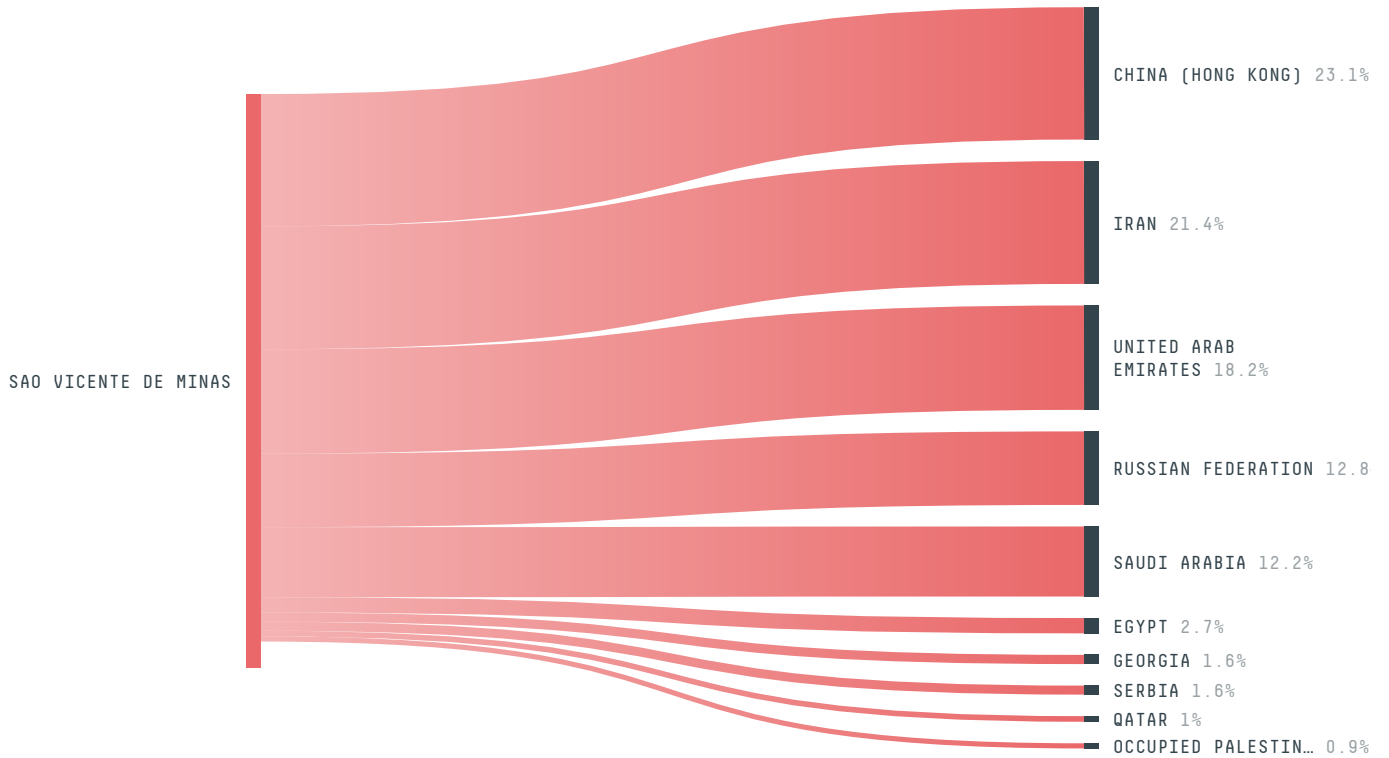

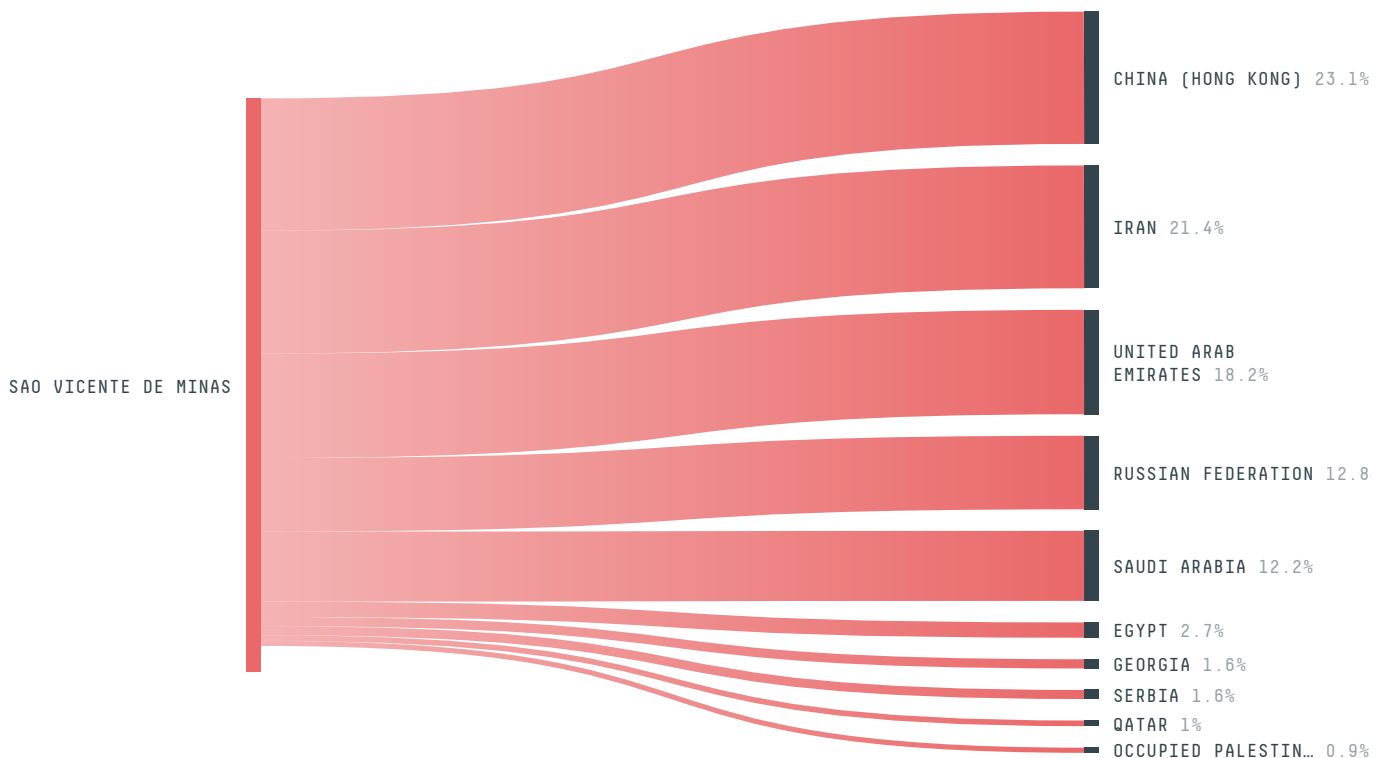
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SAO VICENTE DE MINAS
