The largest exporter of beef in Seringueiras was Jbs, which accounted for 41.7% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

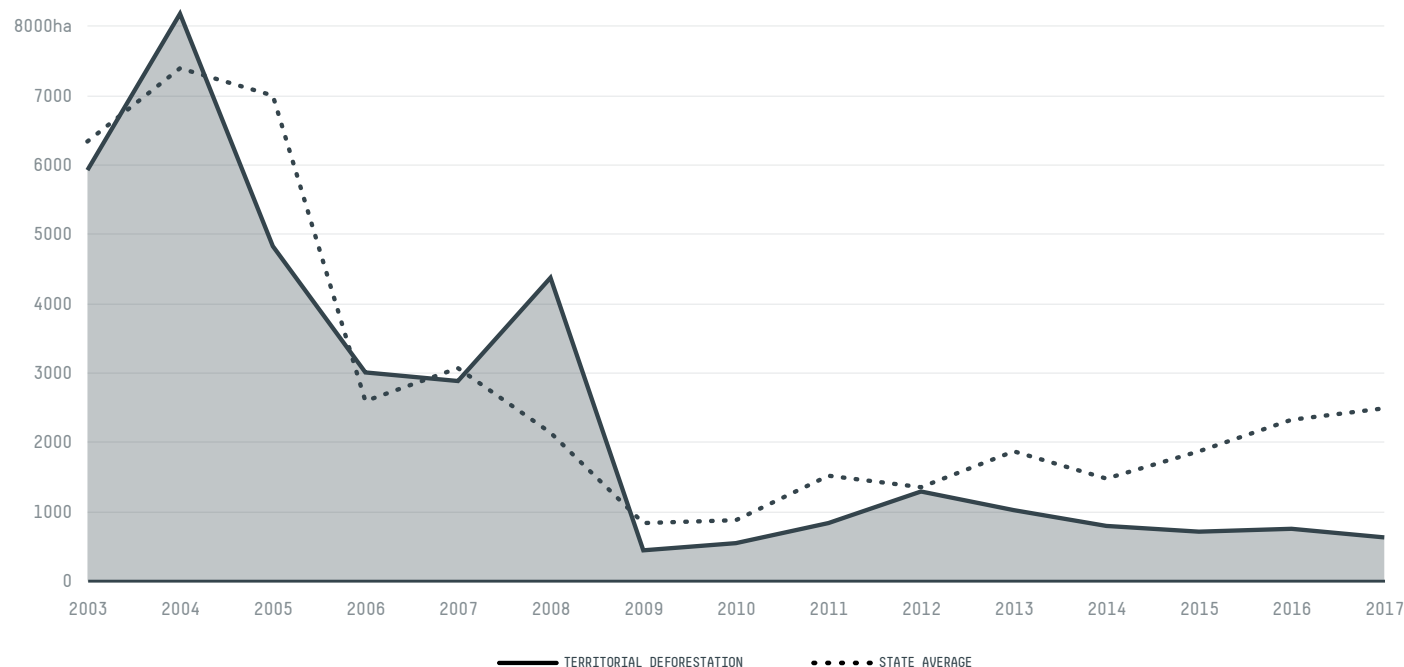

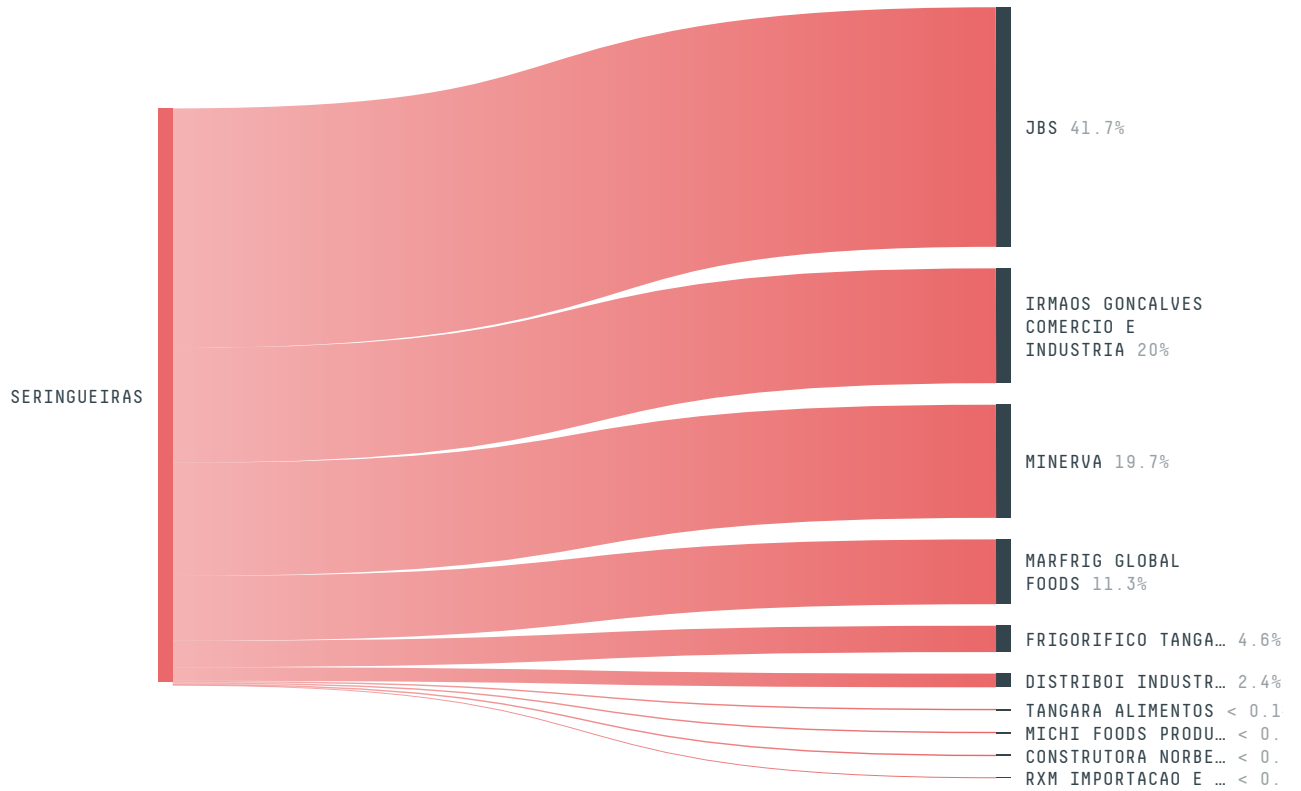

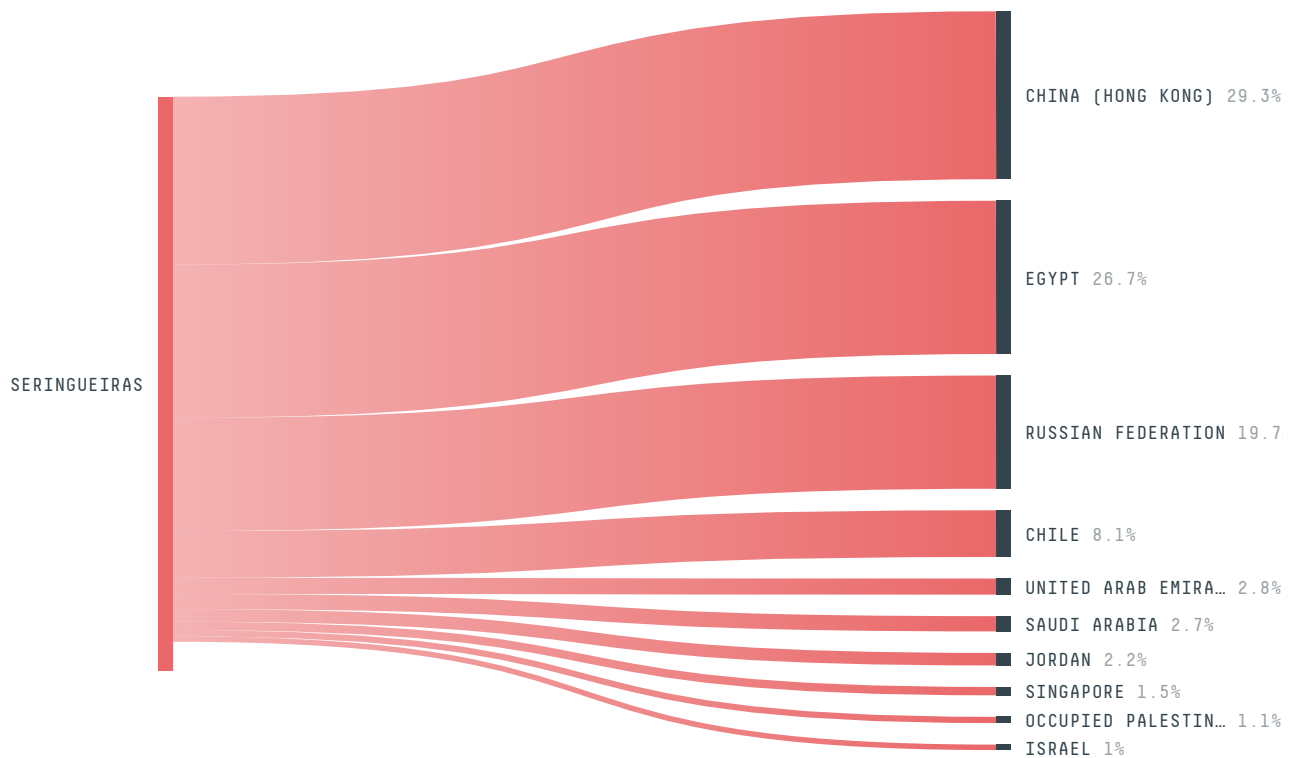
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SERINGUEIRAS



## TOP TRADERS OF BEEF IN SERINGUEIRAS IN 2017



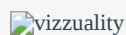
## TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF BEEF FROM SERINGUEIRAS IN 2017
