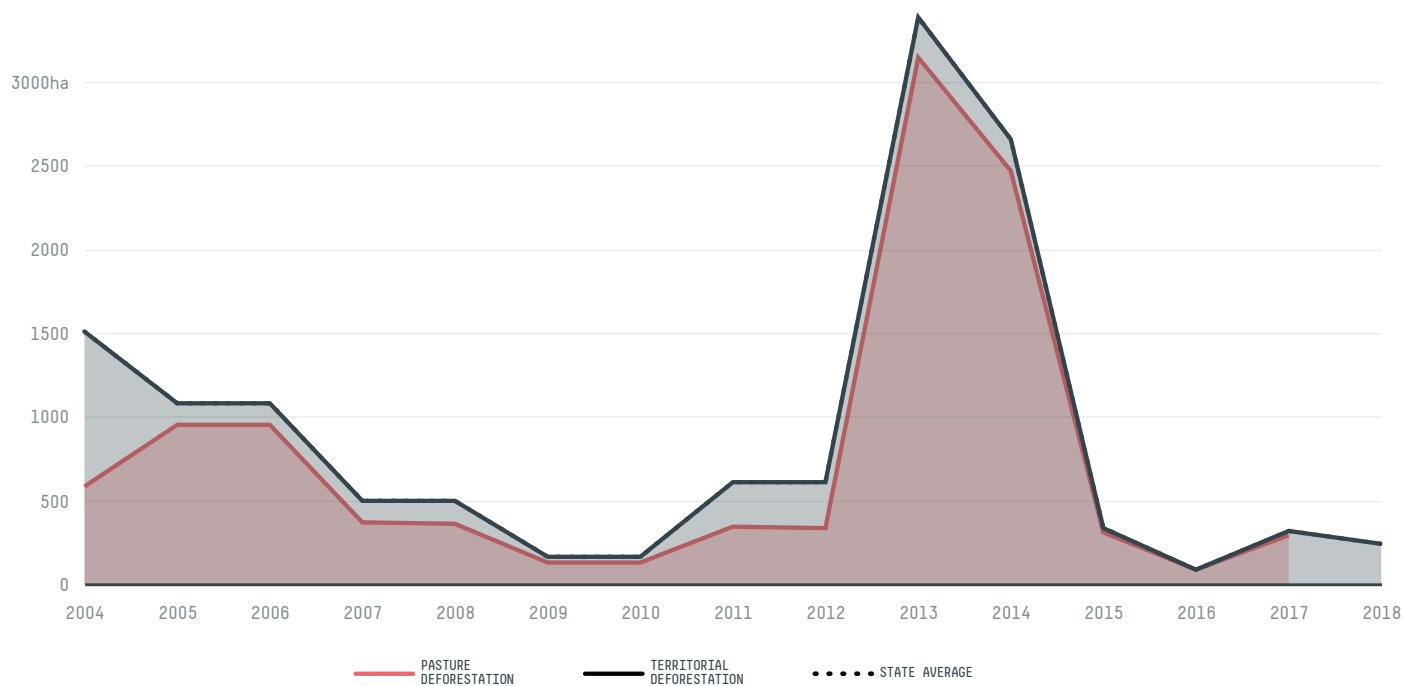

The largest exporter of beef in Cabeceira Grande was Jbs, which accounted for 34.9% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

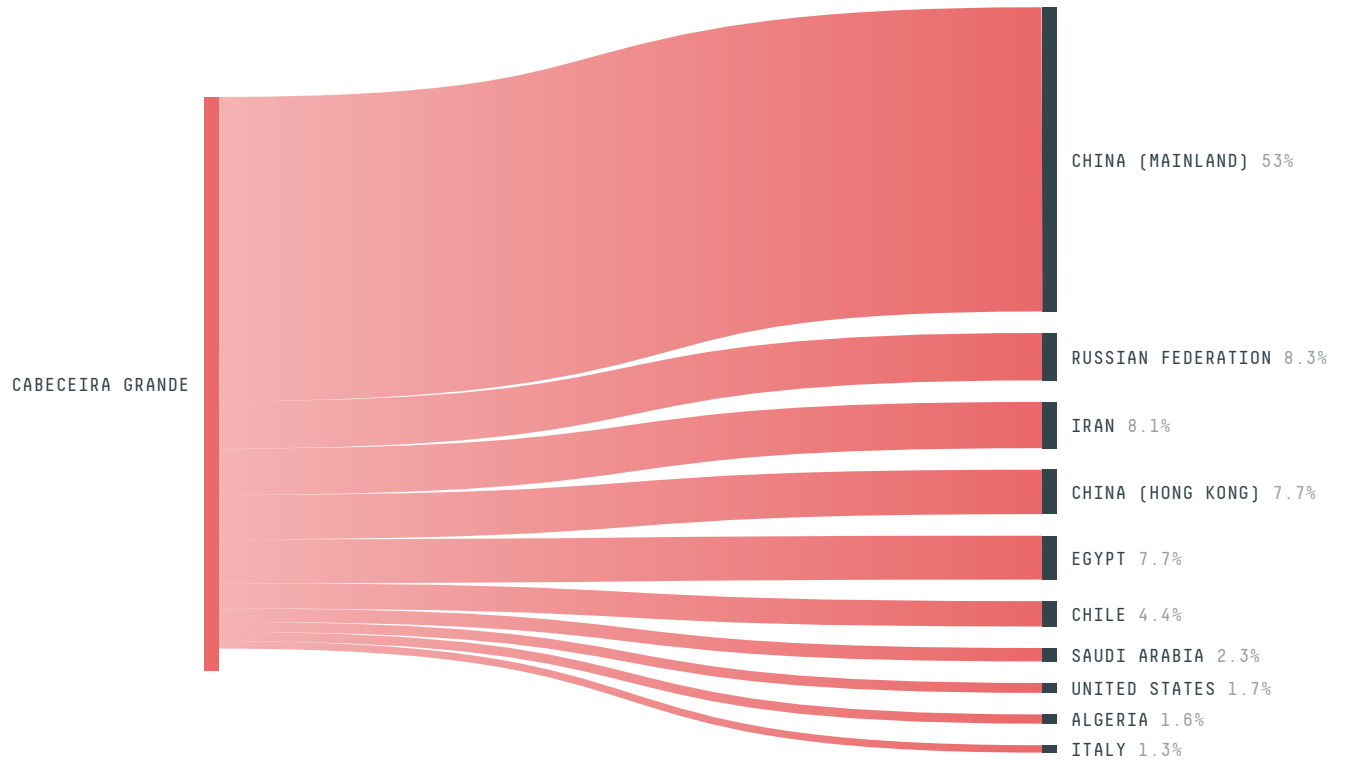

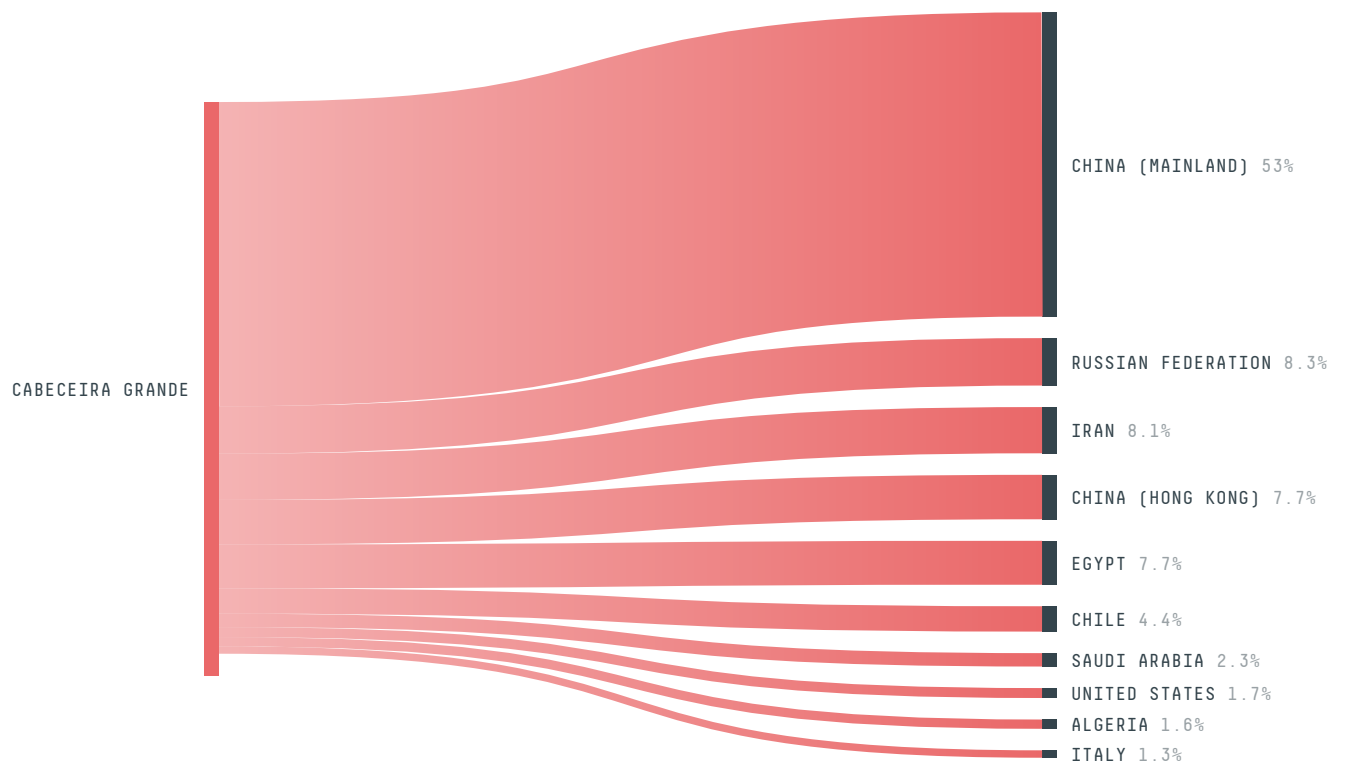
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CABECEIRA GRANDE
