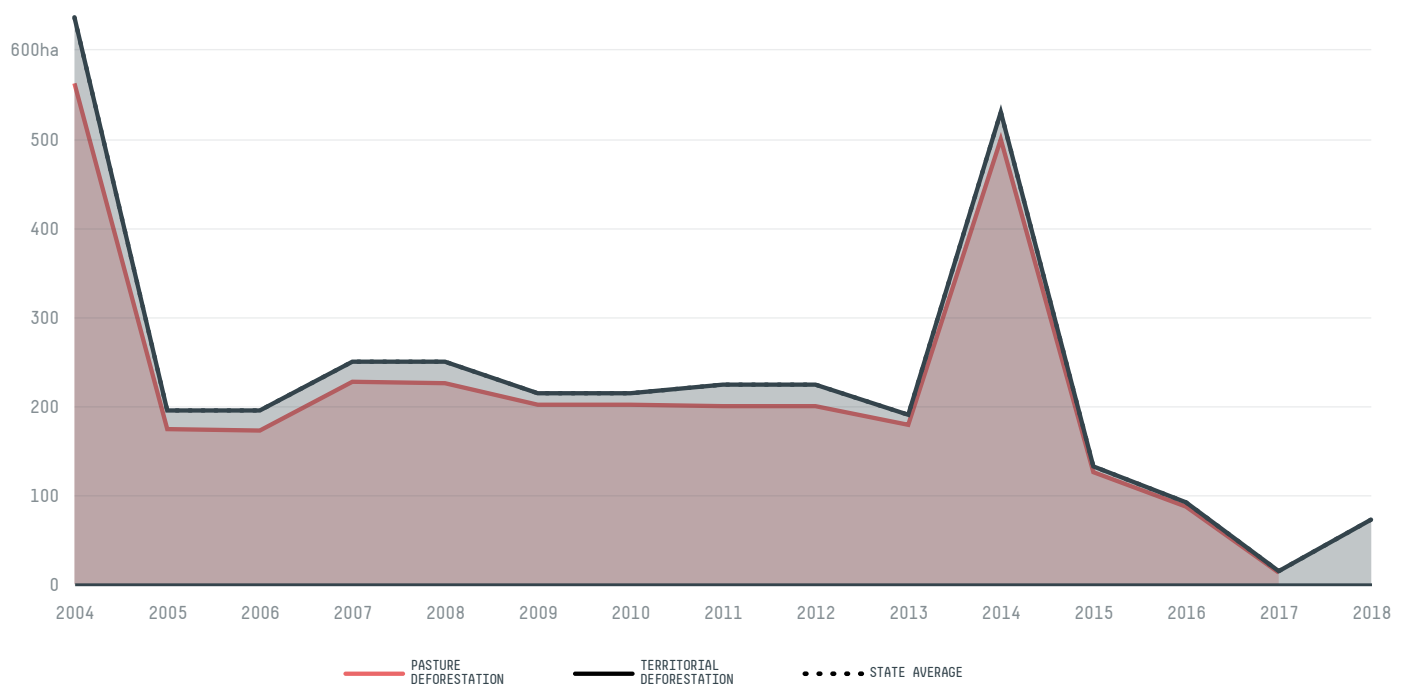

The largest exporter of beef in Natalandia was Minerva, which accounted for 68.8% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

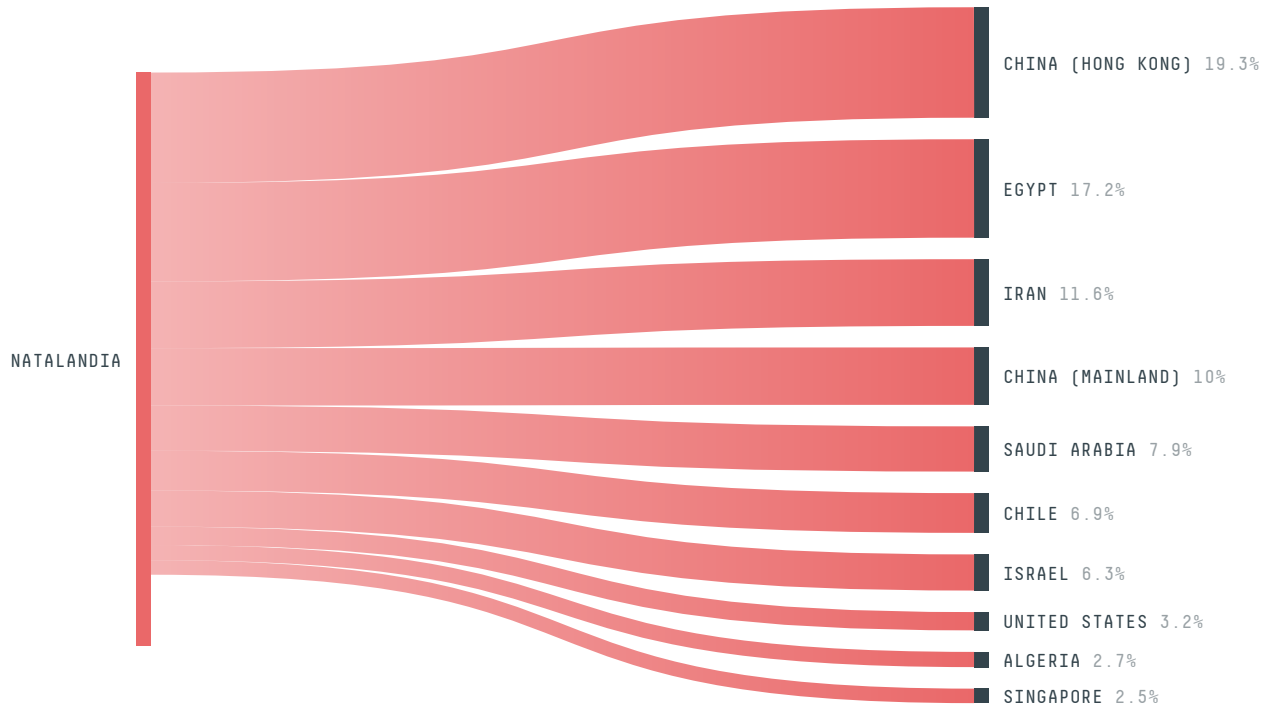

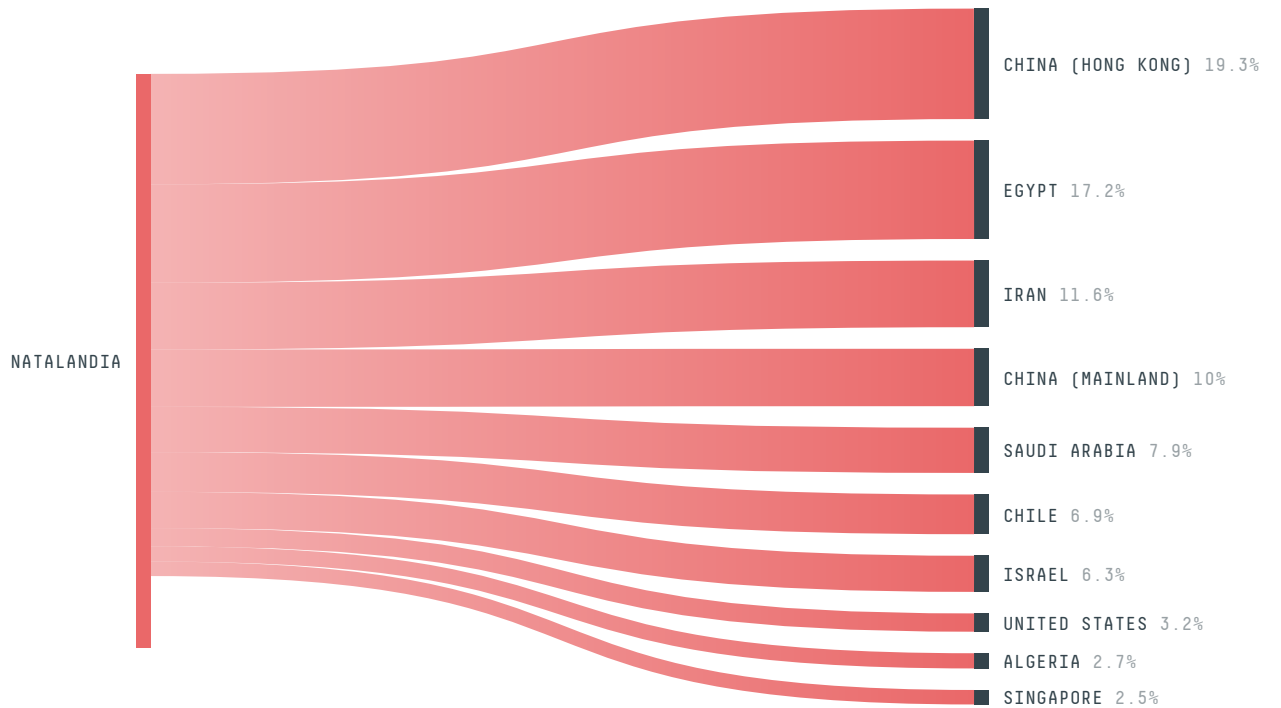
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NATALANDIA
