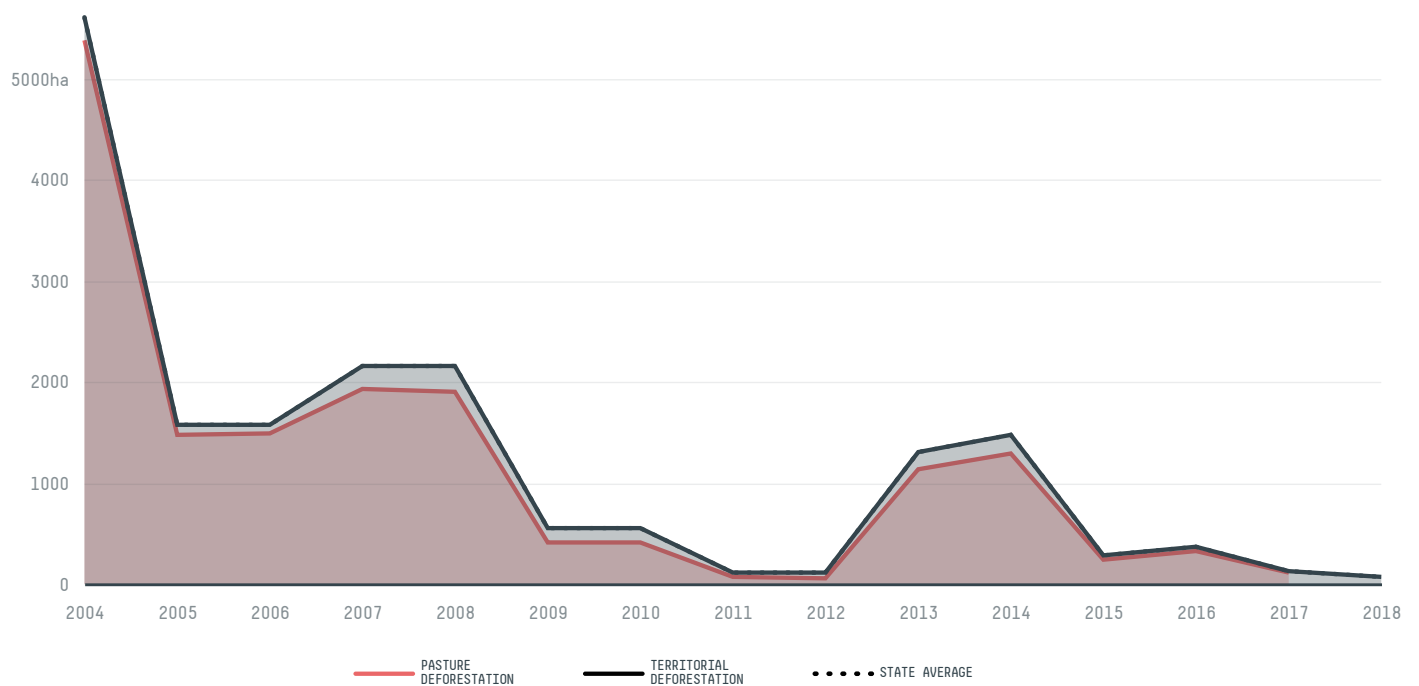

The largest exporter of beef in Augusto De Lima was Plena Alimentos, which accounted for 99.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

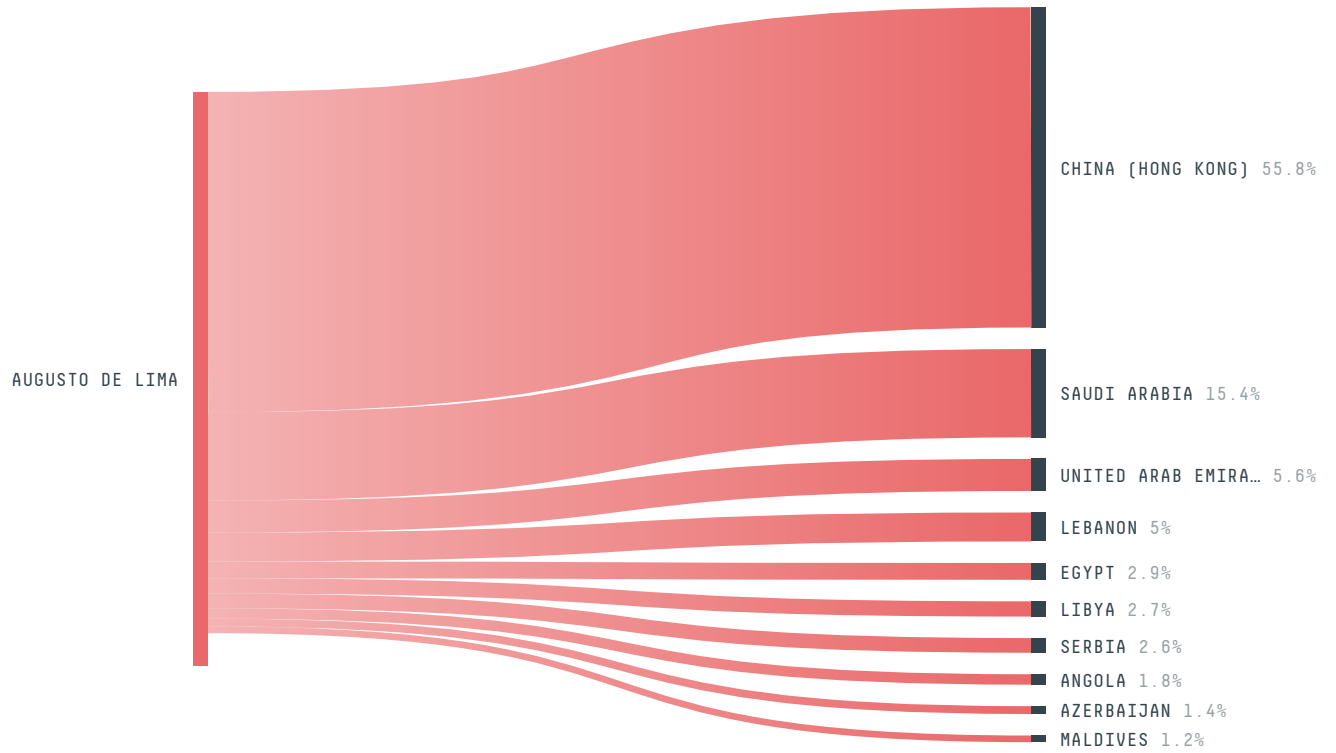

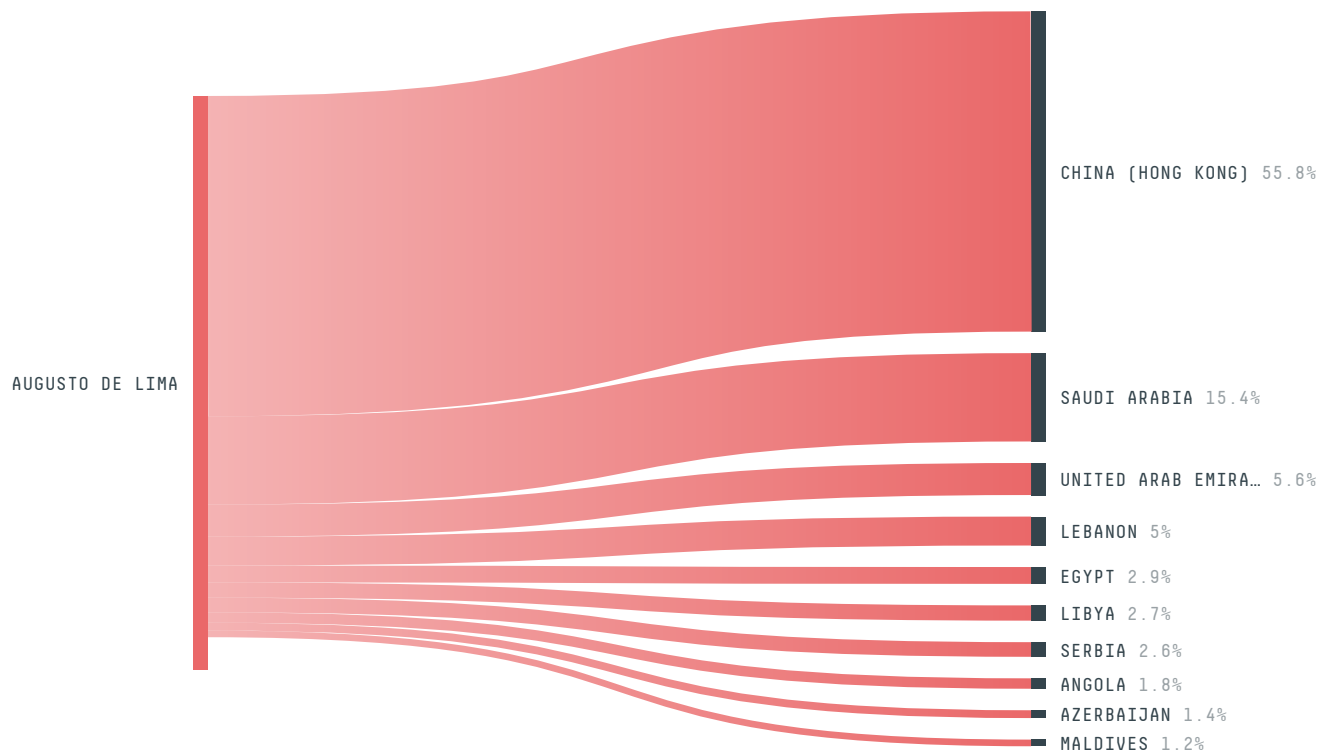
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF AUGUSTO DE LIMA
