The largest exporter of beef in Buenopolis was Plena Alimentos, which accounted for 95.3% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

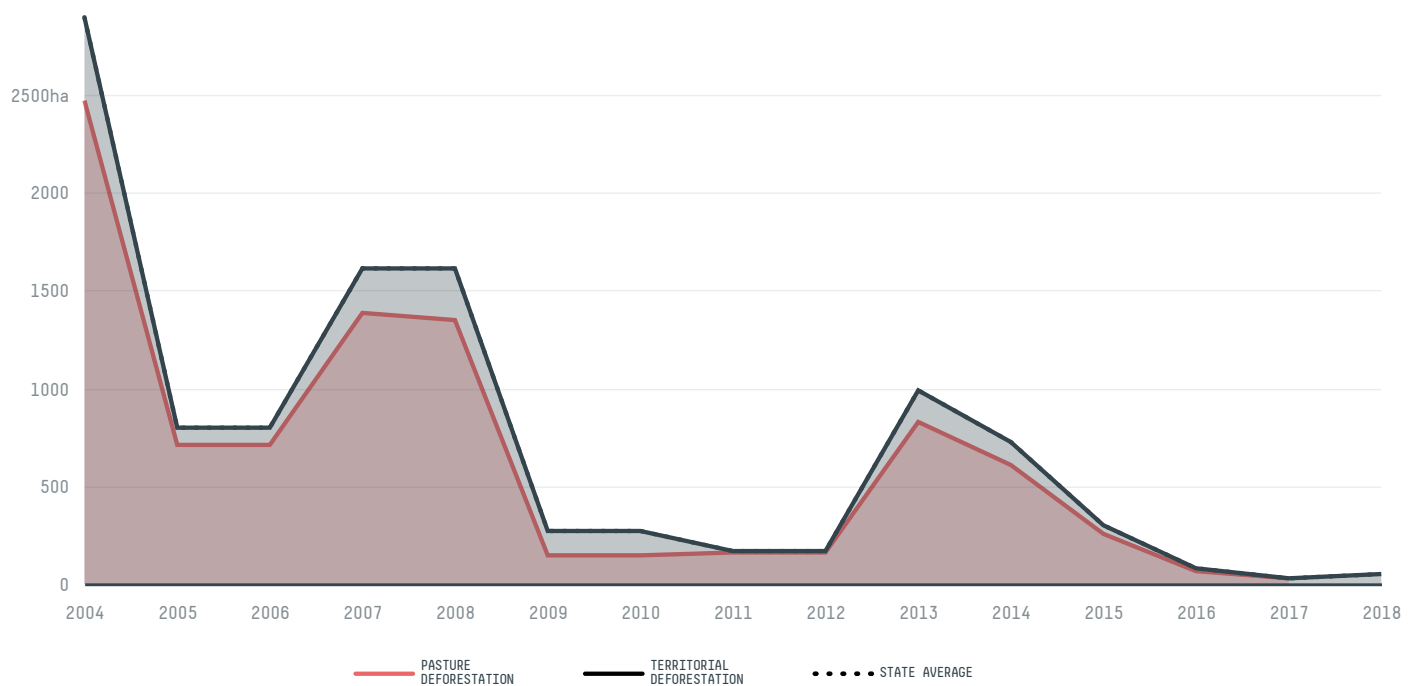

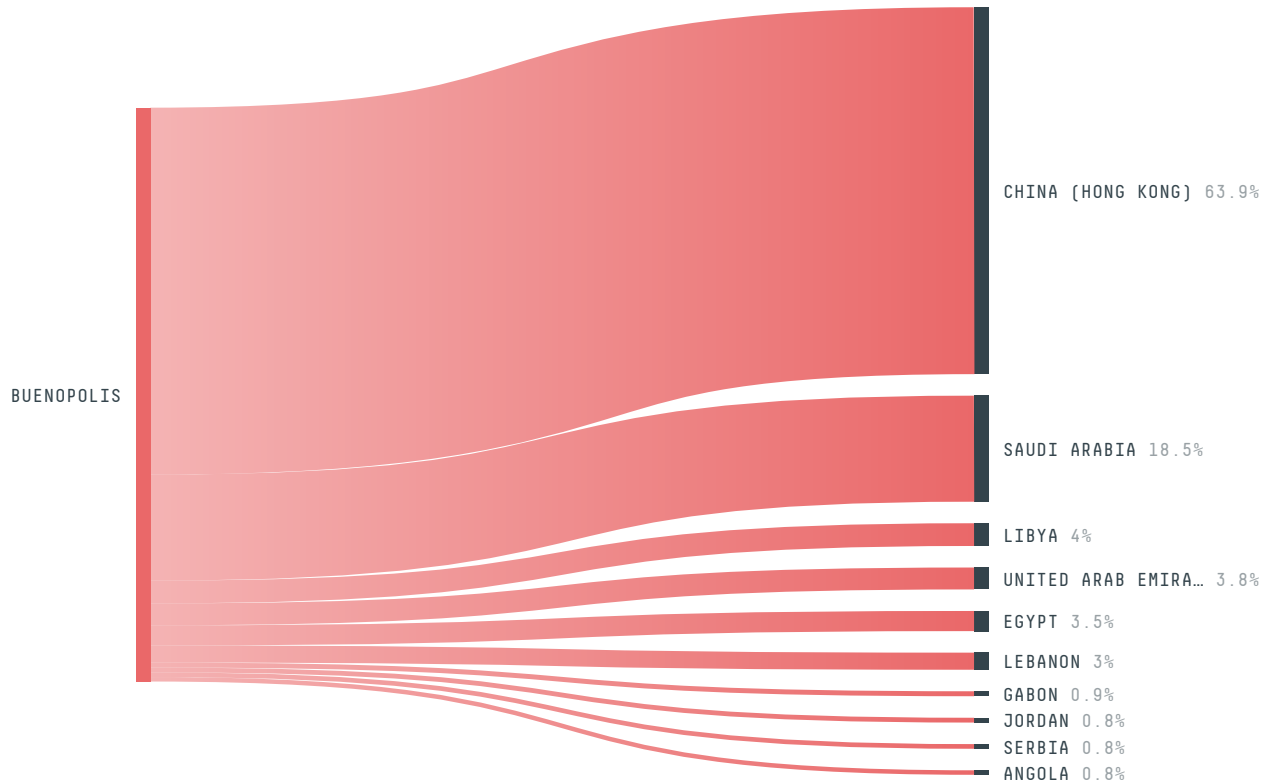

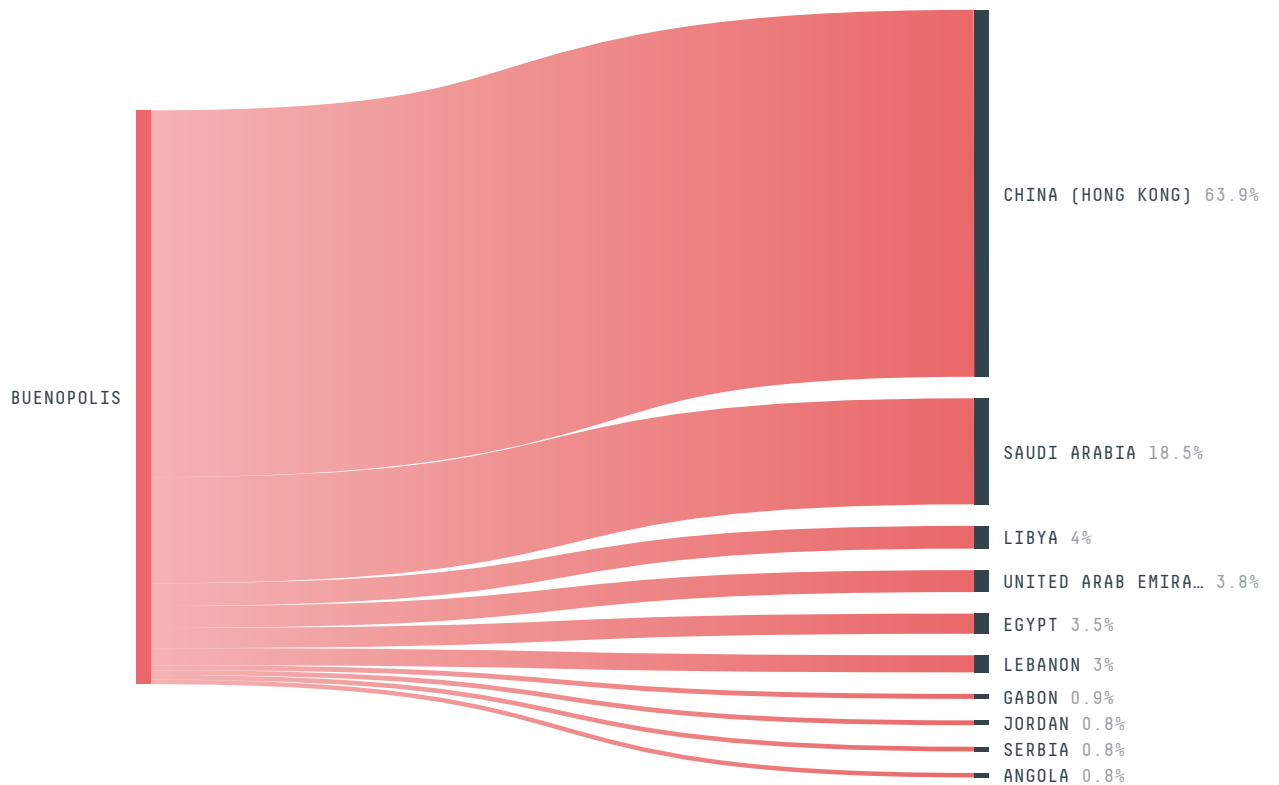
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BUENOPOLIS
