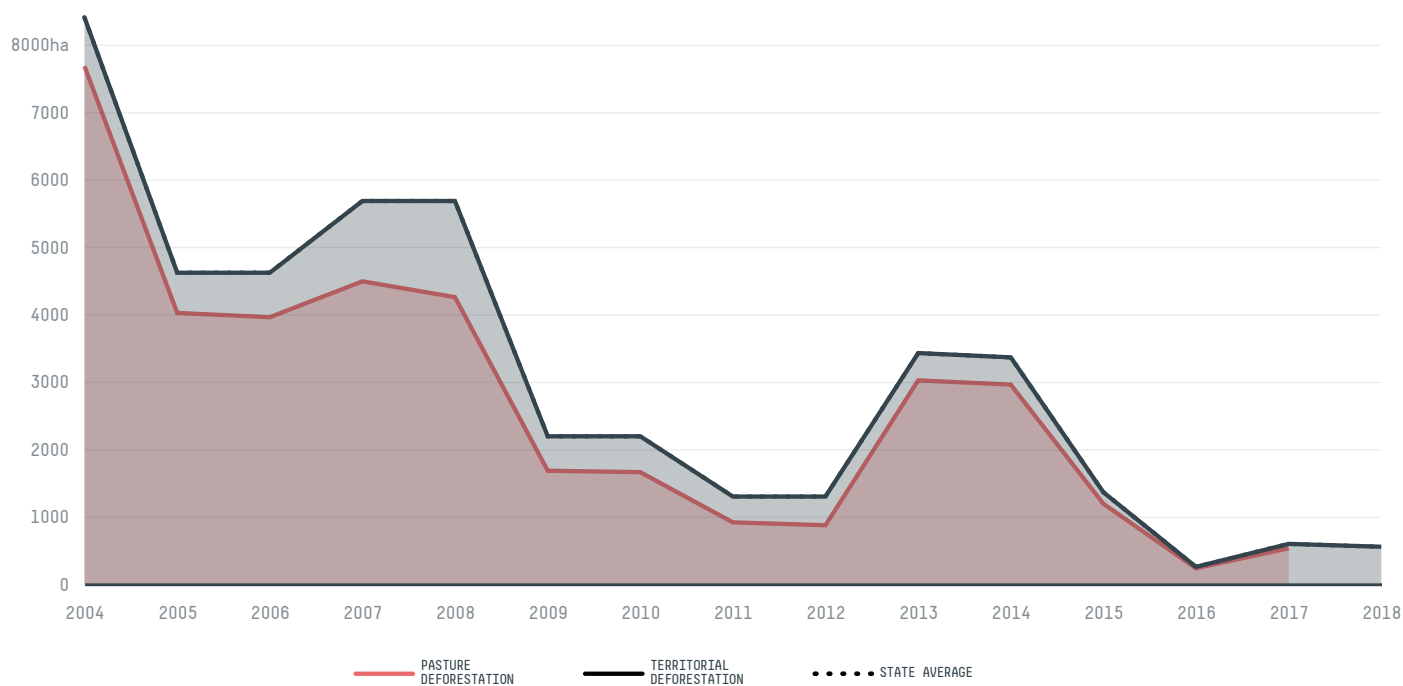

The largest exporter of beef in Corinto was Plena Alimentos, which accounted for 82.5% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

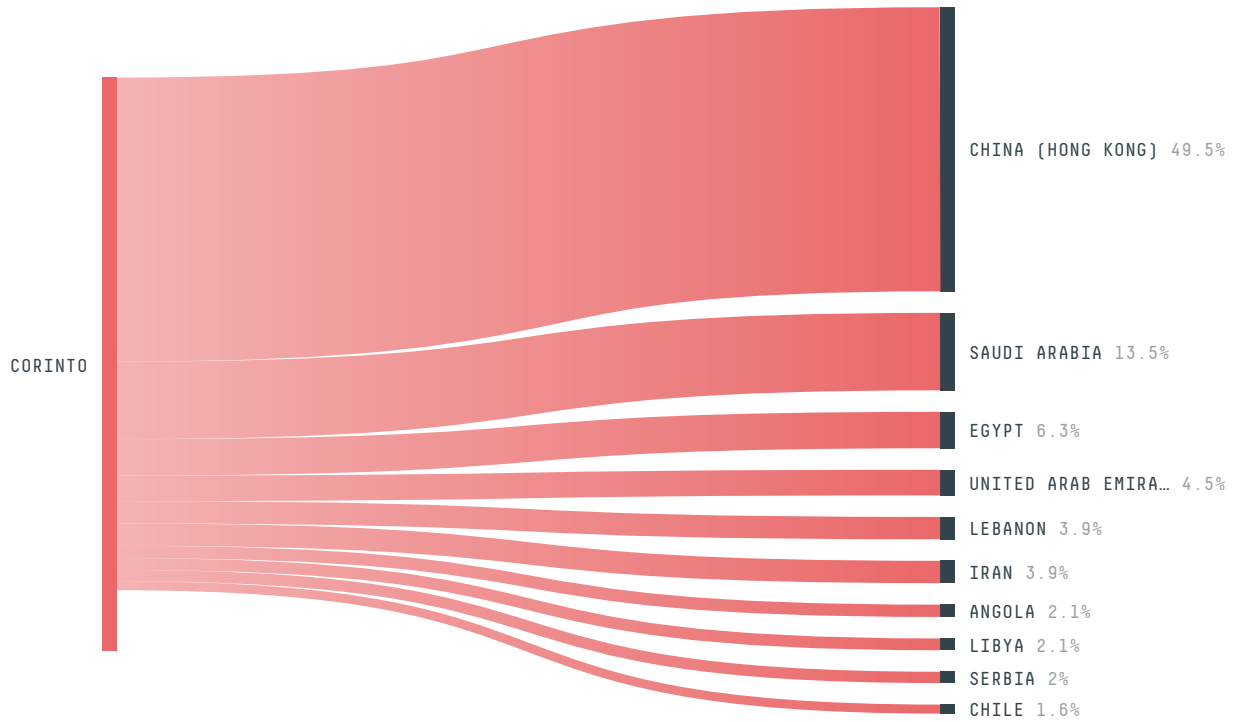

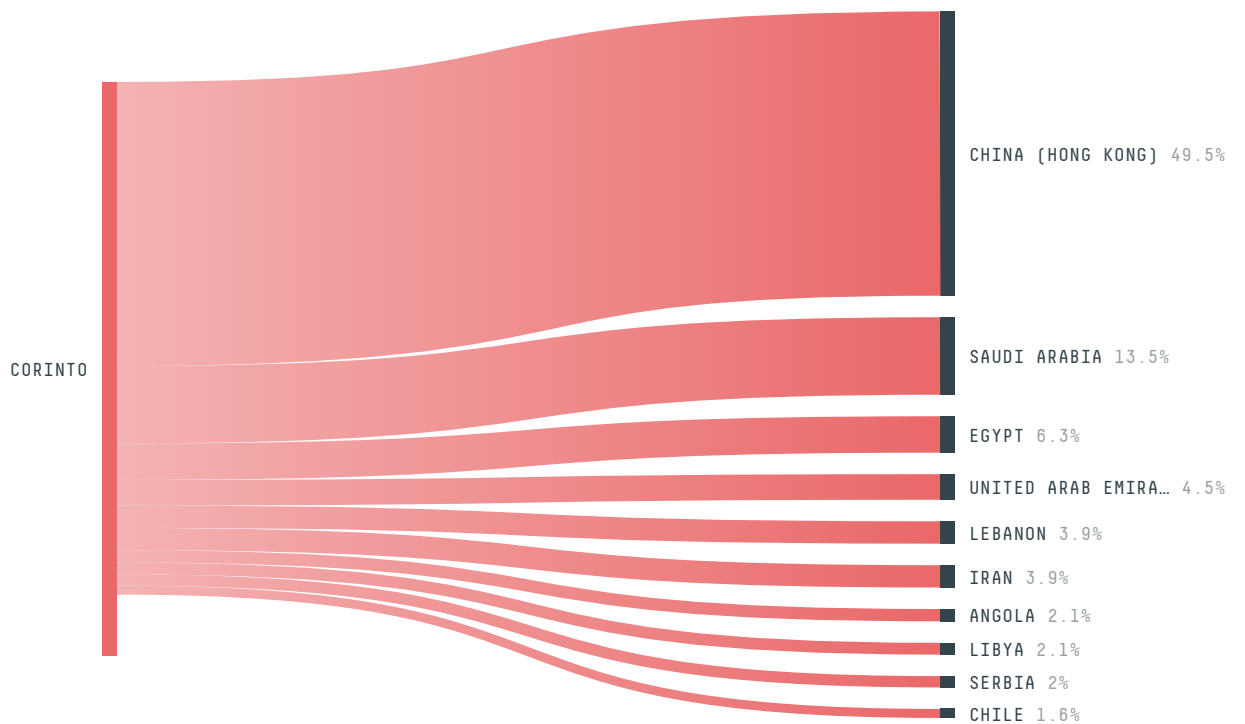
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CORINTO
